

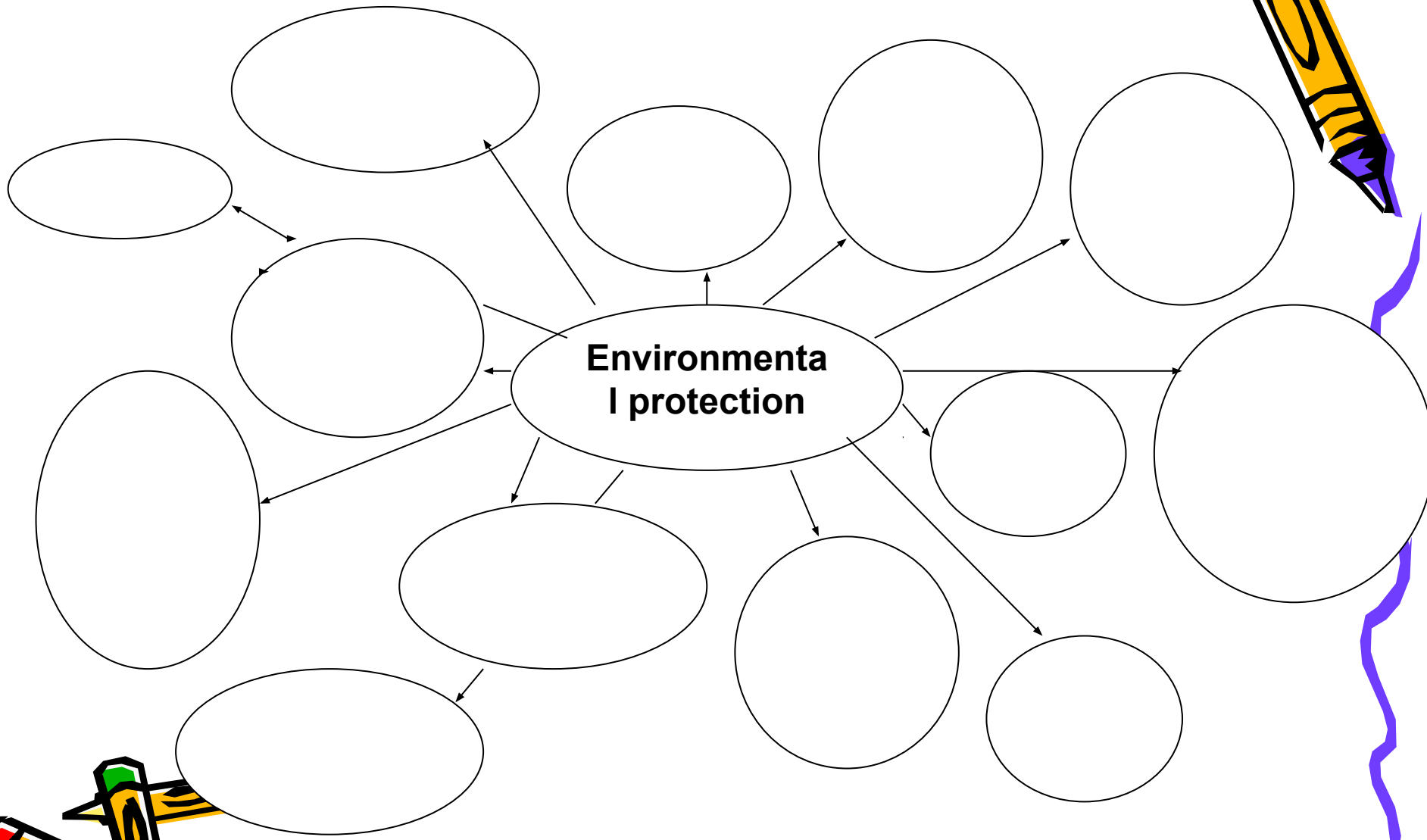


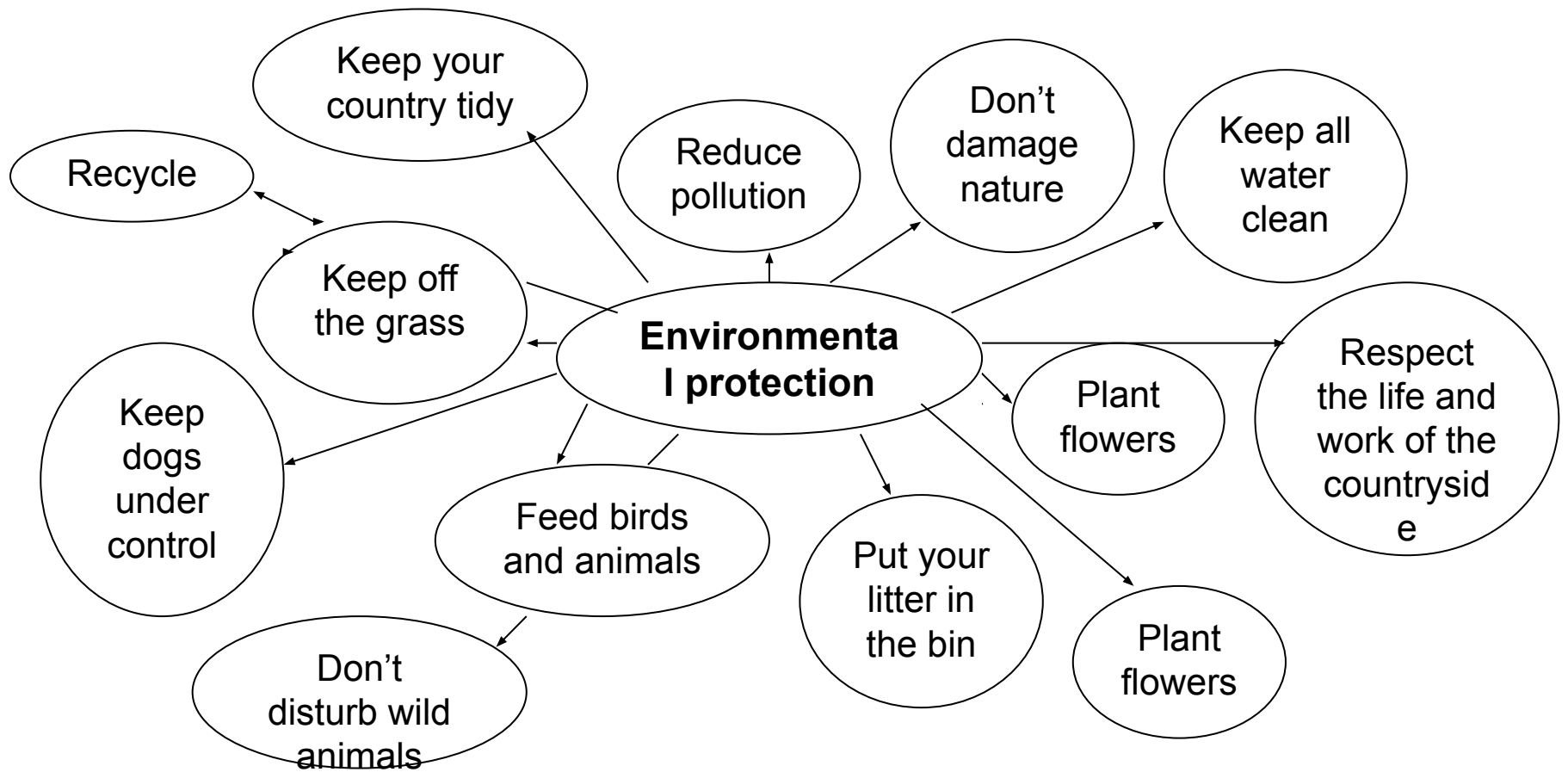

Environmental protection.

The poisoning of the world's land, **air** (8) and water is the fastest-spreading **disease** (4) of civilisation. It, like wars, **earthquakes** (6) and **floods** (12), is one of history's greatest dangers to **human** (11) life on earth.

Overpopulation, pollution and energy **consumption** (9) have created such planet-wide problems as acid **rains** (1) and the global warming.

The seas are in danger. They are filled with poison: industrial and nuclear **waste** (2). Every ten minutes one kind of animal, plant or **insect** (5) dies out for ever. If nothing is done about it, one million species that are **alive** (10) today will have become **extinct** (7) twenty years from now.

Air **pollution** (3) is also a very serious problem.
