

Khabarovsk Territory







Khabarovsk - the subject of the Russian Federation, located in the Far East of Russia, is part of the Far East Federal District.

Khabarovsk was founded October 20, 1938 decree of the Presidium of the Supreme Soviet of the USSR "On the division of the Far Eastern Territory in Khabarovsk and Primorsky Krai."

Region occupies an area of 787,633 km² - 4 th place among the subjects of the Russian Federation.

Population of the region according to the National Census 2010 - 1.3442 million people.

Administrative center - the city of Khabarovsk, the population of 577.7 thousand people





Culture and Art

In Khabarovsk, working museums, such as Khabarovsk Krai Museum of Grodekov, Far Eastern Art Museum, Geological Museum, and so on. Also in the city has several theaters, such as Khabarovsk Krai puppet theater, musical theater Khabarovsk Krai, Khabarovsk Krai Youth Theater. Since 1978, the city has a centralized system of public libraries, including the city's central library, named after Peter Komarov.









Transport

Khabarovsk - a large site at the junction of water, air, rail and road communications with the north and west of the country, Primorye, Sakhalin and the Khabarovsk Krai ports of international, national and regional importance. By the volume of rail, river and road transport

city ranks first in the region







Rail transport

Passes through the town Trans-Siberian railway and a railway line in Komsomolsk-on-Amur, Trans-Siberian Railway connects with the Baikal-Amur Railway. In Khabarovsk, the Far East is control of the railway.

Within the city there are 4 railway stations. In 2009, completed the reconstruction of the bridge across the Amur River, which resulted in the bridge was not only double-track rail, and road



Automobile transport

The city is a junction point of the federal highways. In 1983 he commissioned the bus station at 500 passengers per hour. Intercity bus routes connect the city with central and eastern regions of the edge cities of Primorye and the Jewish Autonomous Region



Airlift

Air freight carried through the New and Small airports are located 10 km from the city center. It also deployed aircraft base maintenance of vessels. Through the zone of responsibility of Air Traffic Controllers Khabarovsk pass routes flights Japan - Europe.

Sights

The original monument created by sculptor Alexander Opekushin - author of the Pushkin monument in Moscow, was built in 1891. Work on its reconstruction performed Petersburg sculptor LV Aristov. Recreated the monument was unveiled May 30, 1992, the day the city. In 2006 his picture appeared on the new bill is 5,000 rubles.

The unofficial symbol of Komsomolsk-on-Amur is considered a "house with a spike," which was built in 1955, near Lenin Square.
