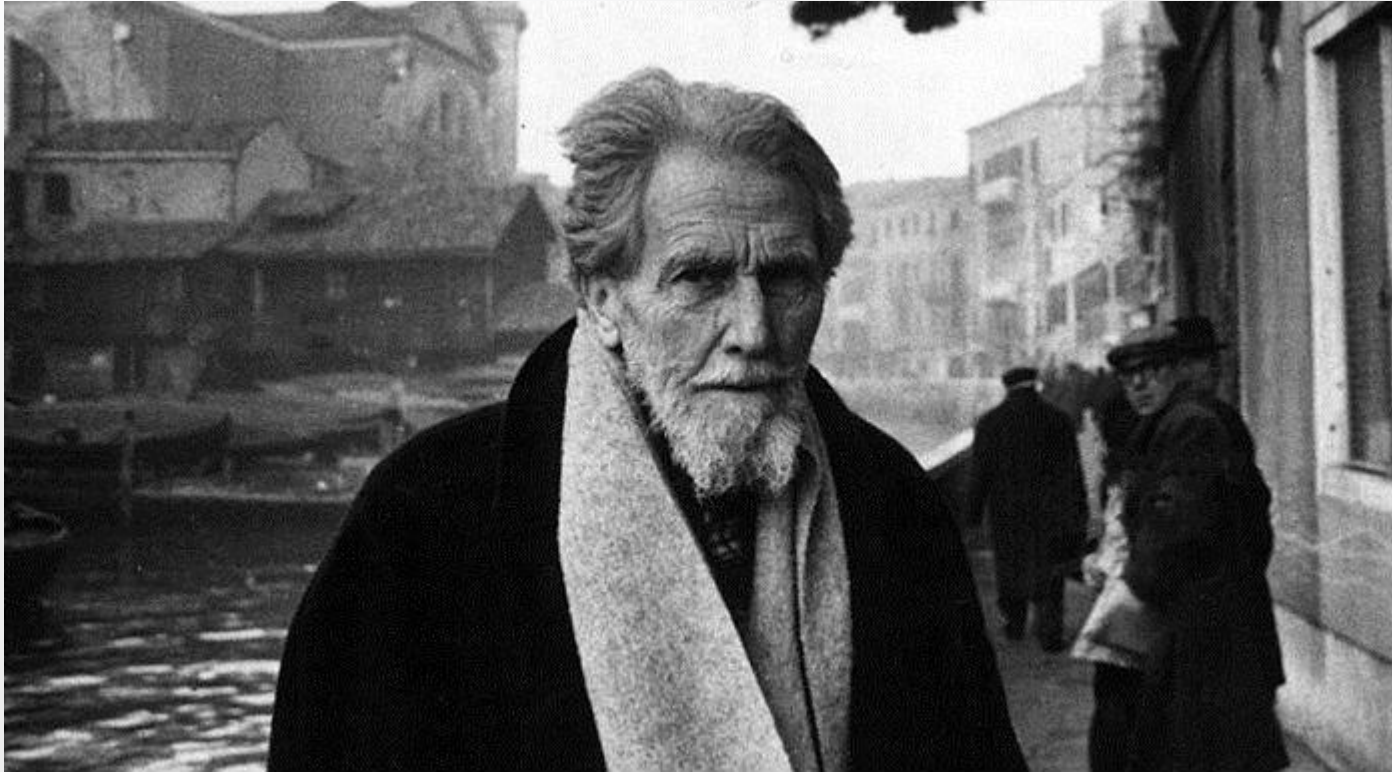

Founded by Wyndham Lewis



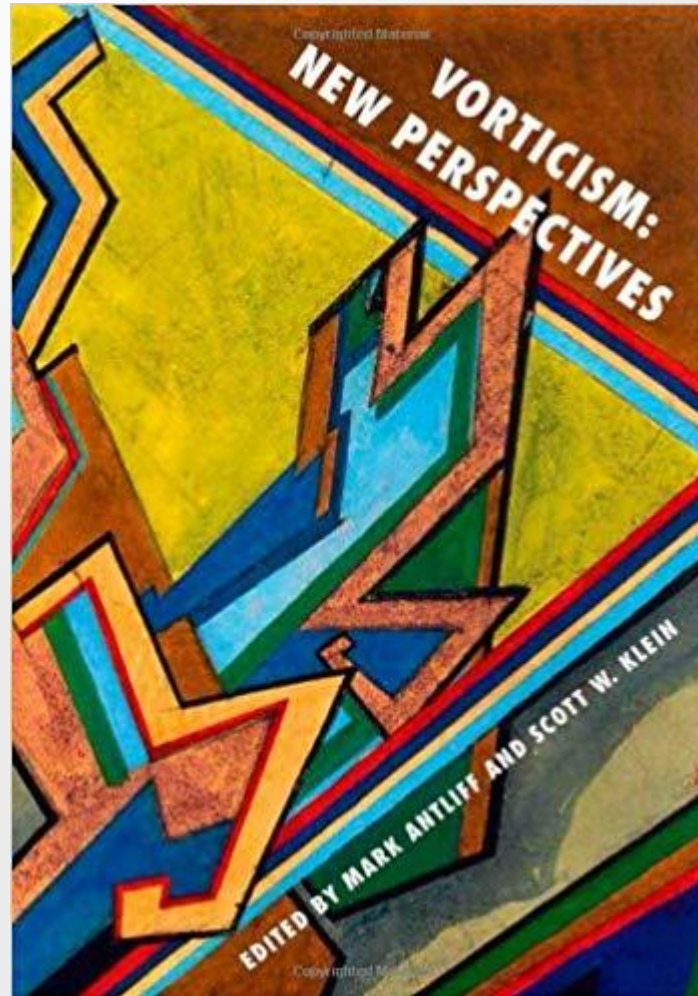

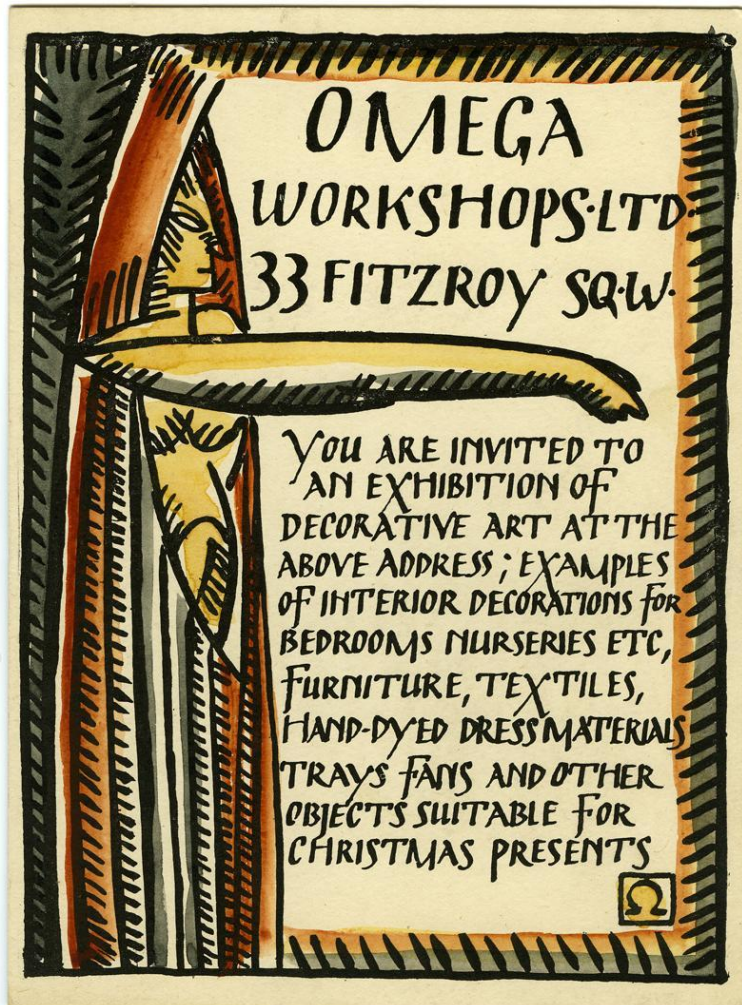

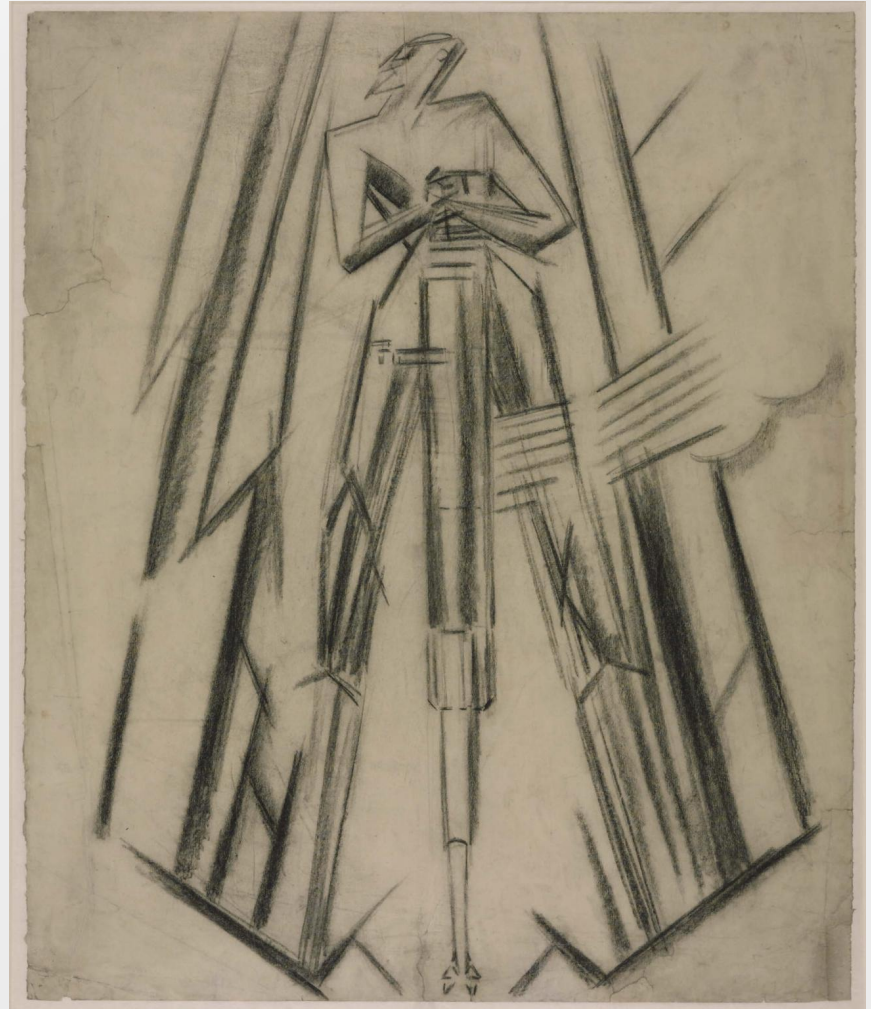



Wyndham Lewis tried to revive the movement with Group X




