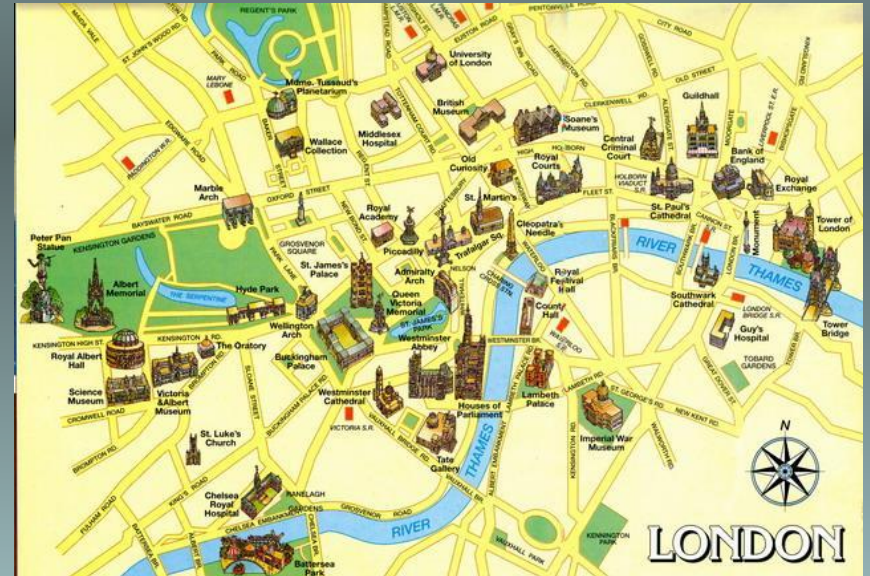
London is the capital of Great Britain.

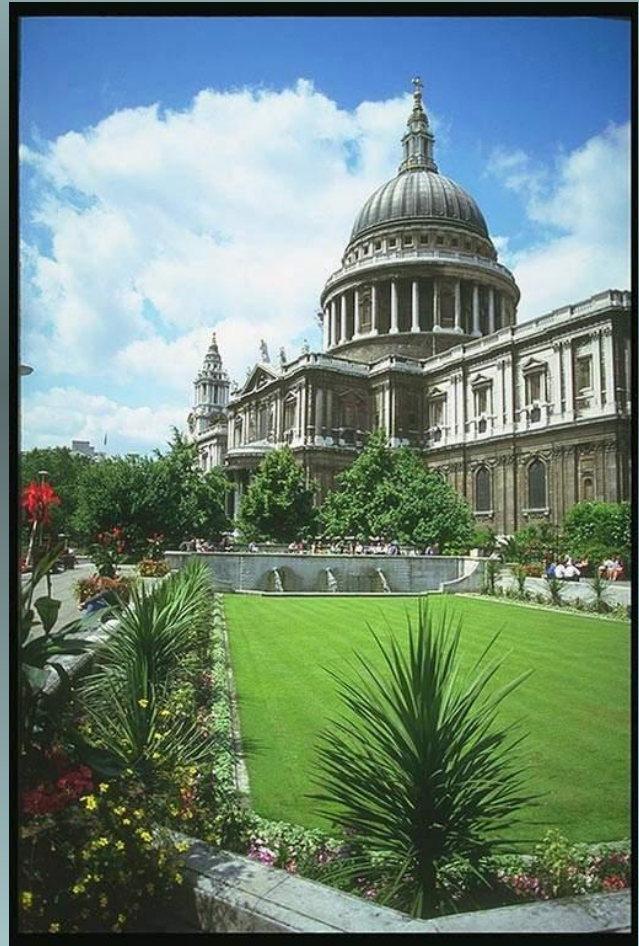


# St. Paul's Cathedral

# BUCKINGHAM PALACE

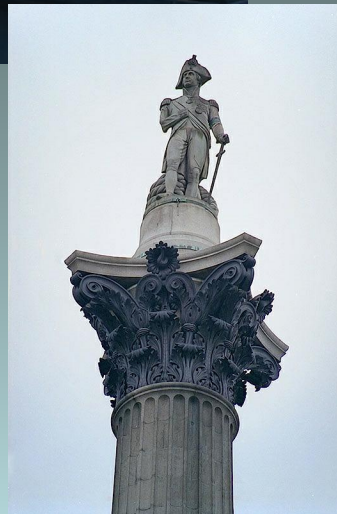


- was built in 1830. The Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh have a suite of about 12 rooms on the first floor.





# The National Gallery is in Trafalgar Square



- Trafalgar **Square** is the geographical centre of London.
- It was named in memory of Admiral Nelson's victory in the battle of Trafalgar in 1805.

The tall Nelson's Column stands in the middle of the **square**.

The National **Gallery** was founded in 1824.

It has a fine collection of European paintings.

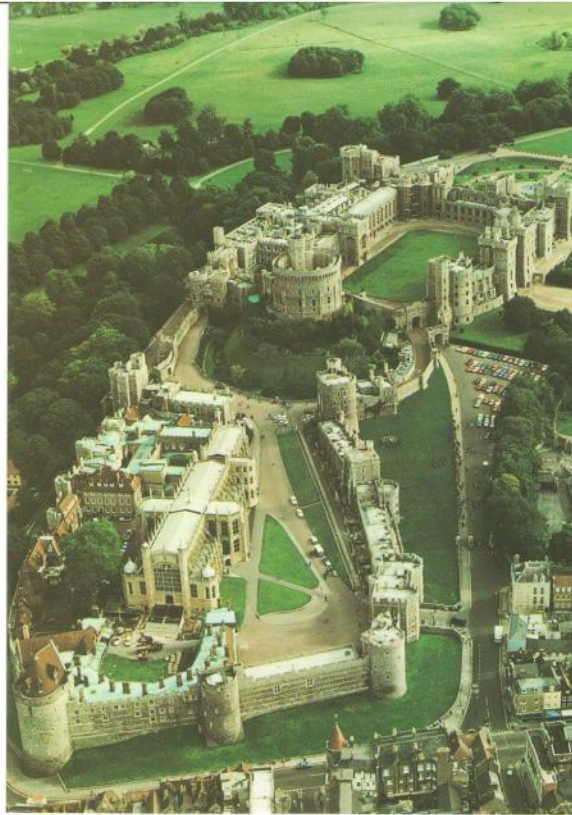


# WINDSOR CASTLE – an official residence of Her Majesty the Queen
