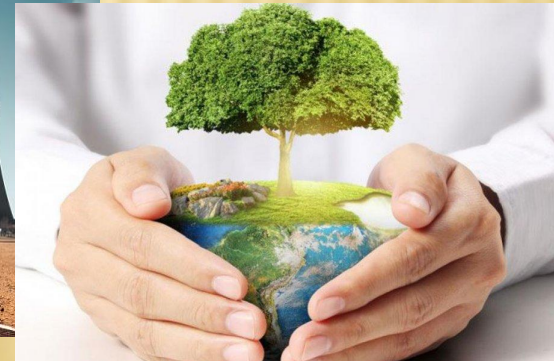

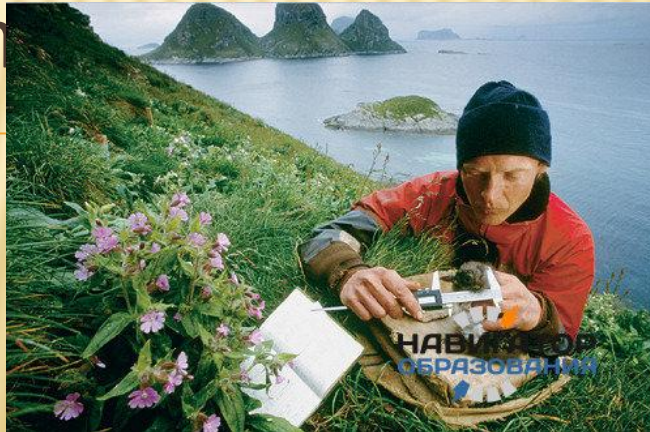
Use:
