Bully (x 2), abused, bullying, threatened, steals, defend, pick on, hurt, blackmails.

Have you ever met a (1) bully?
Sure, you have. A (2) bully can be a child or an adult, a boy or a girl. Bullies usually (3) pick on people who cannot (4) defend themselves.
