The Smithsonian's National Air and Space Museum is located in Washington and has the world's largest and most significant collection of aviation and space artifacts. In 2016, the museum saw approximately 7.5 million visitors, making it the second most visited museum in the world, and the most visited museum in the United States.





The Canada Aviation and Space Museum is Canada's national aviation history museum. The museum is located in Ontario, Canada, at the Ottawa Airport. Featuring aircrafts from all eras of flight, flight simulators, and many interactive exhibitions, there is always lots to see and do.





The Pima Air & Space Museum, located in Tucson, Arizona, is one of the world's largest non-government funded aerospace museums.

It features over 350 historical aircraft. Sitting on 80 acres the museum opened its doors to the public in May of 1976.
