

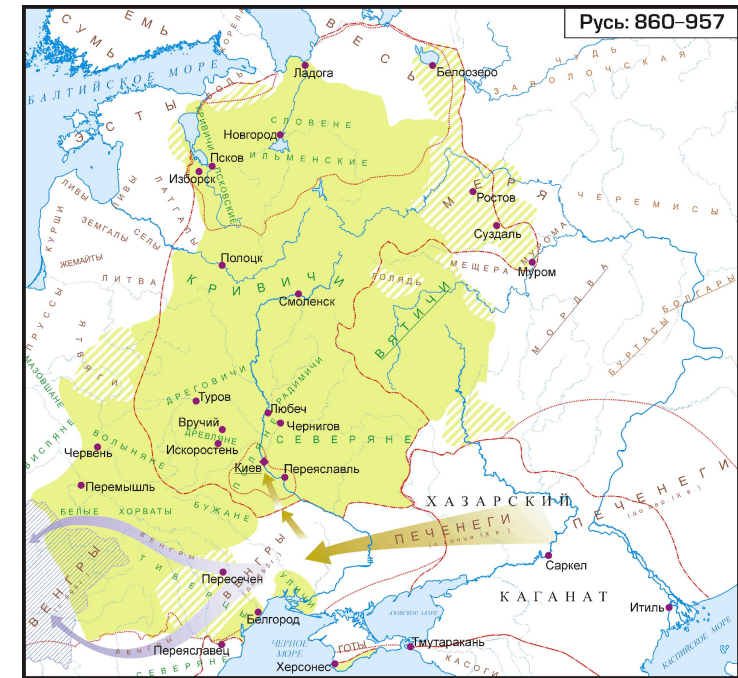
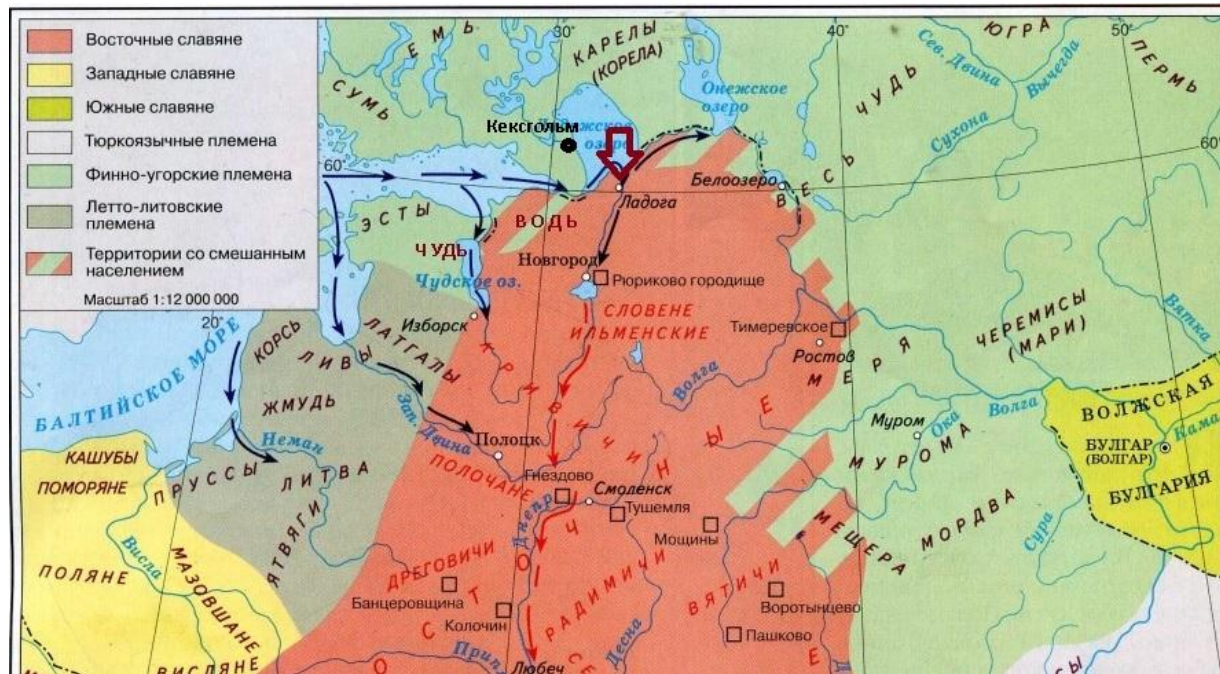
The North-Eastern Russia

Suzdal was founded on the river Kamenka in the X century



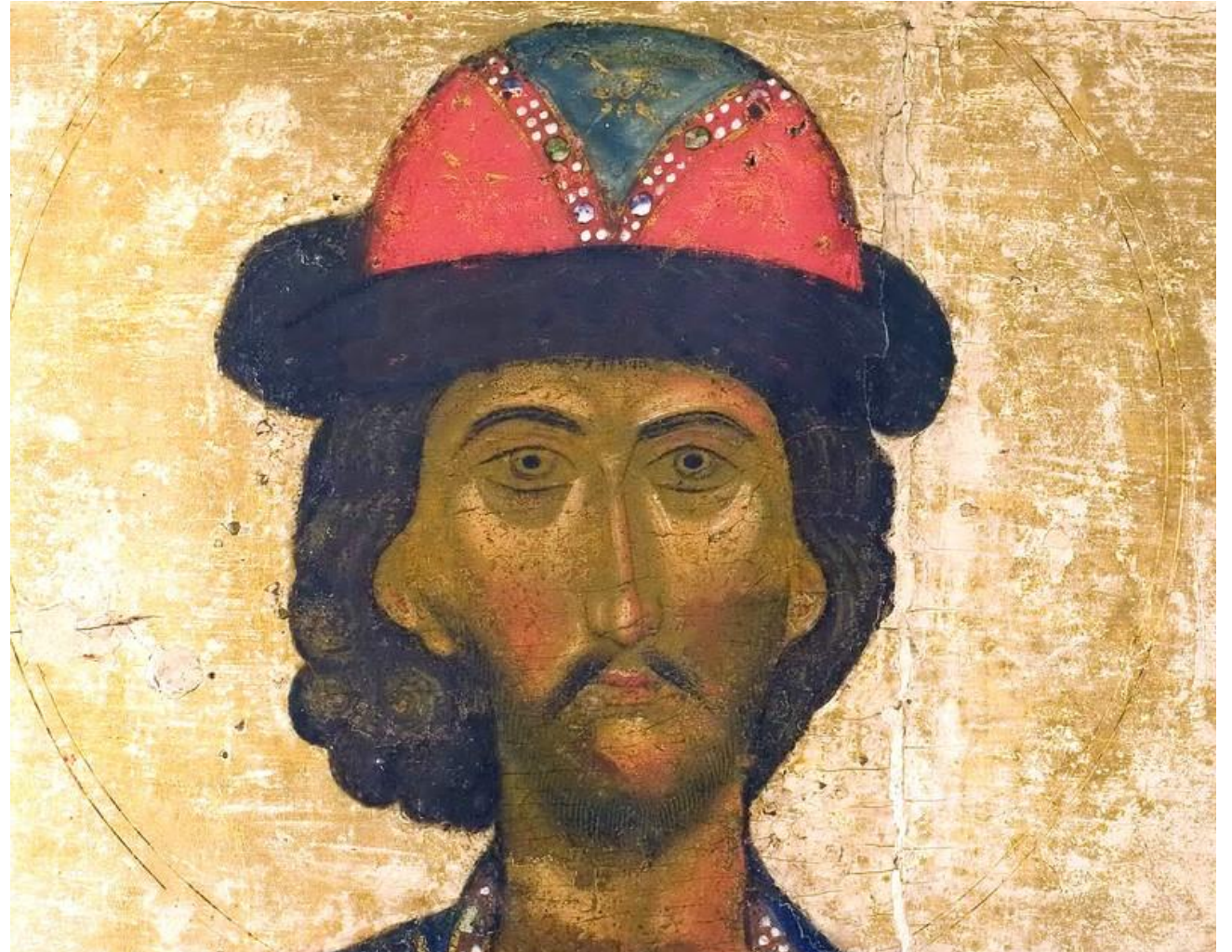
Prince Vladimir the Krestitel

the river Klyazma**



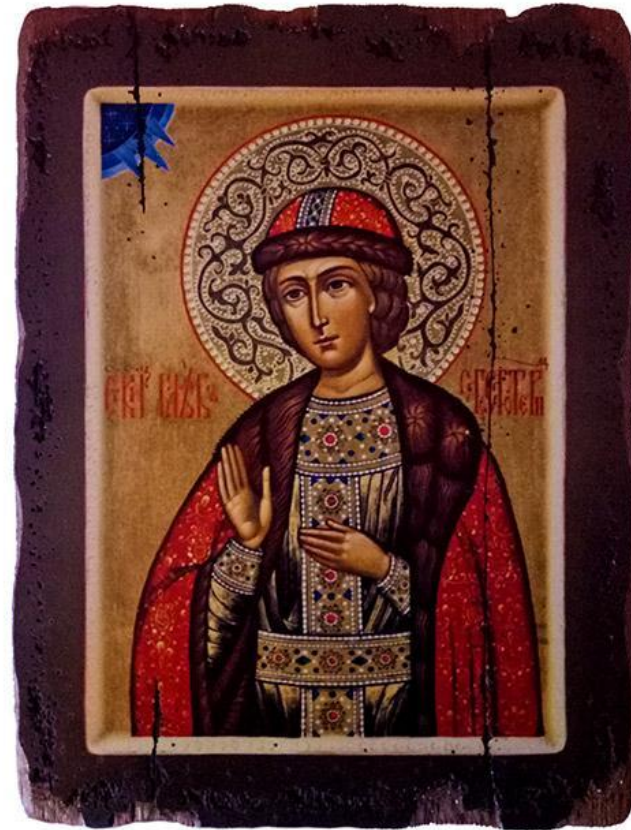
Rostov Prince Boris

Prince Vladimir Monomah built the Cathedral of The Nativity of the Virgin in Suzdal Kremlin (the building was destroyed)

КНЯЗЬ Yuri Dolgorukiy built the Church of SS. Boris and Gleb in Kideksha (this settlement near the confluence of the river Kamenka into Nerl became his countryside residence, thus, prince Yuri could control the river route from Vladimir to Suzdal.)

Prince Andrew Bogoliubskii continued to develop Vladimir-Suzdal region

Reconstructed portrait of prince Andrew



For temple building he was compared with Solomon



Near with mouth of the river Nerl prince Andrew built his residence village of Bogoliubovo and the Cathedral of the Nativity of the Virgin



Near the village of Bogoliubovo the Church of the Intercession-on-the-Nerl was built

The Church was built in the place of the confluence of the river Nerl into the river Klyazma

Religious holiday Intercession began to be celebrated



Prince Andrew built the Cathedral of the Assumption

During the reign of Prince Andrew the Cathedral was single-domed

Prince Andrew put the ancient Icon of the Virgin to Vladimir in the Cathedral of the Assumption. Nowadays it's called Vladimirskaya

Golden gates were built

They had the sacral
meaning of the Golden
Gates in Kiev,
Constantinople and
Jerusalem



Vsevolod the Big Nest built the Cathedral of St Demetrius



Prince George Vsevolodovich rebuilt the Cathedral of the Nativity of the Virgin in the Suzdal Kremlin in the beginning of the XIII century



Prince George built Nizhny Novgorod above the river Volga in the place of the confluence of the river Oka
