The FIFA World Cup is the official name of the FIFA World Cup – international soccer competition.

The world championship is held by the governing body of FIFA world football, and the men's national teams of all FIFA member countries can participate in it.

In the final tournament, which takes place once every 4 years during the month and in advance of the selected host country of the championship, 32 teams take part (31 teams that have received this right in the qualifying tournament, and the national team of the

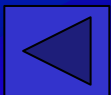


In the history of the world championships, only 8 countries were honored with the title of champions.

Italy won the World Cup 4 times. Soon the number of countries participating in the Championships has increased

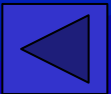


On March 18, 2009, FIFA announced that 9 applications were accepted for the 2018/2022 championships.

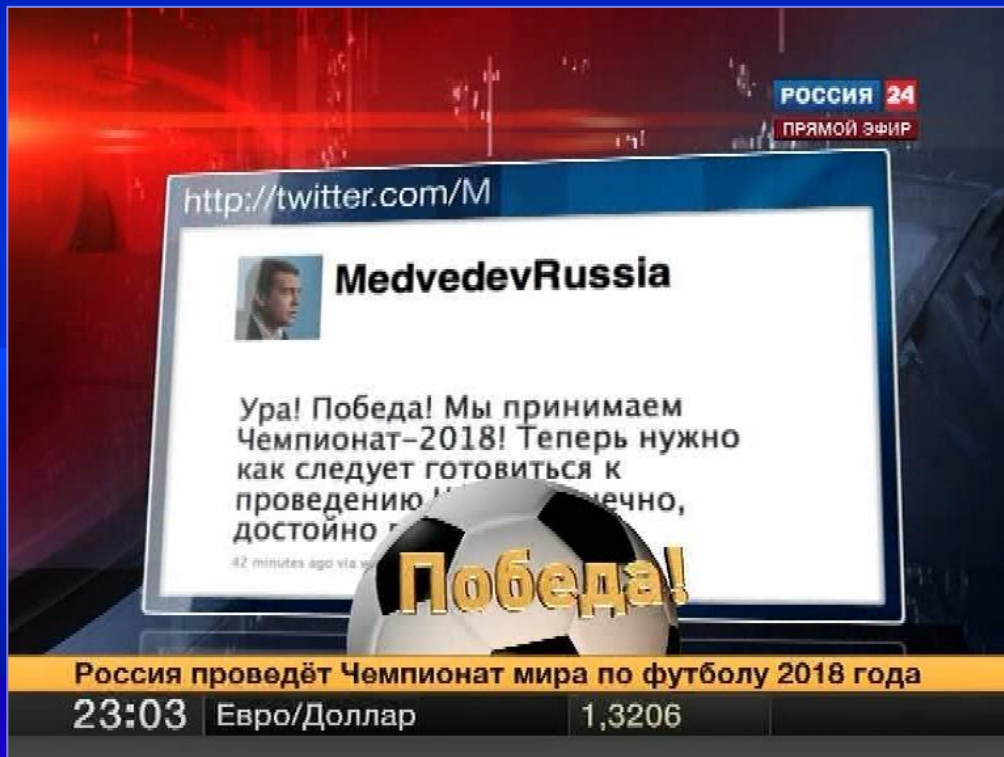


Brilliantly worked videos – screensavers that showed all our advantages:

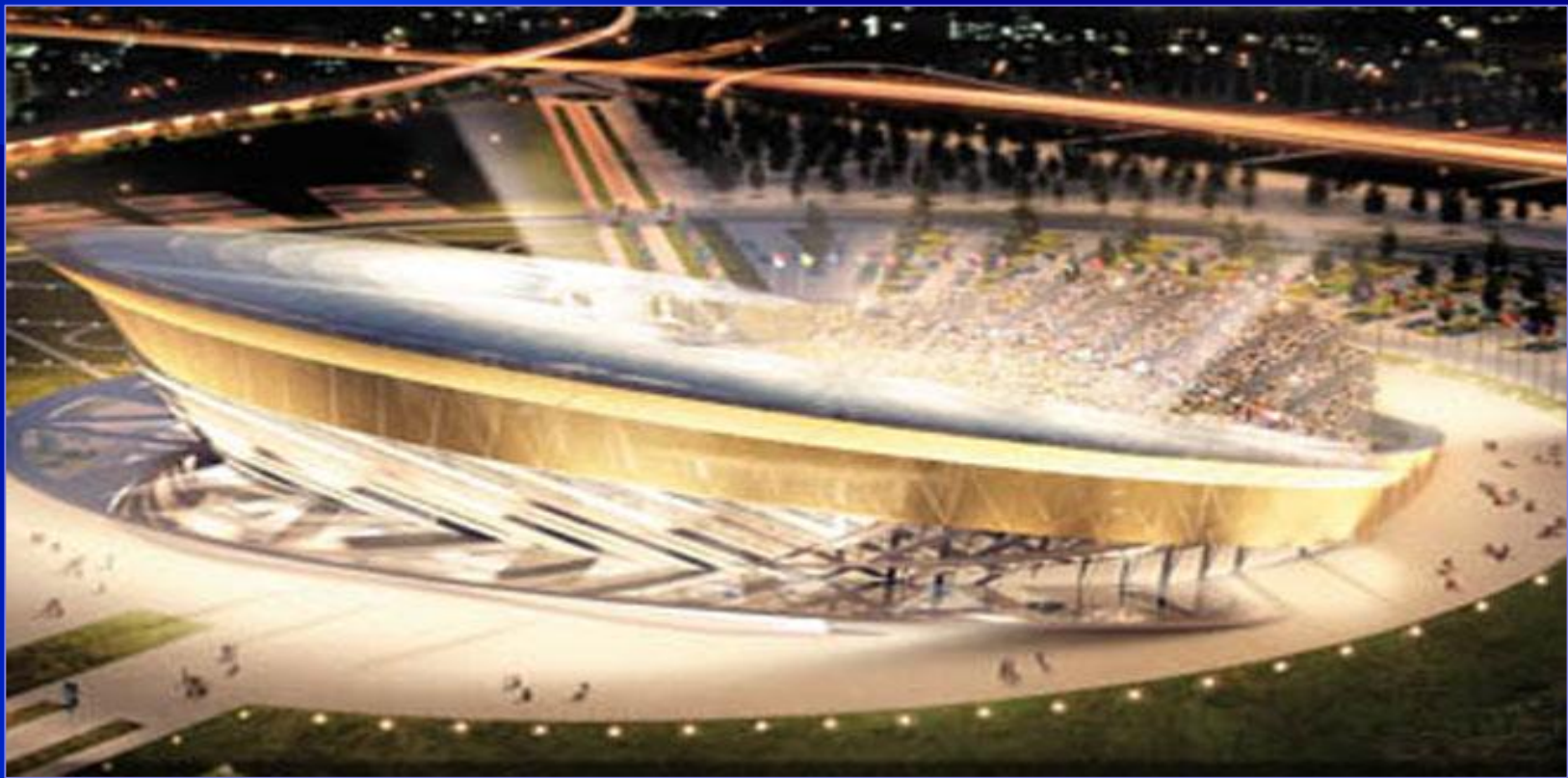

Moscow, “ Dinamo Stadium”. Total capacity: 44 920 spectators and 630 VIP seats.



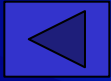

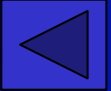




Nizhny Novgorod, "Stadium Nizhny Novgorod". Total capacity: 44,899 spectators. Number of VIP seats: 600.

St. Petersburg, "Stadium St. Petersburg". Total capacity: 69, 501 spectators. Number of VIP seats: 1, 360.

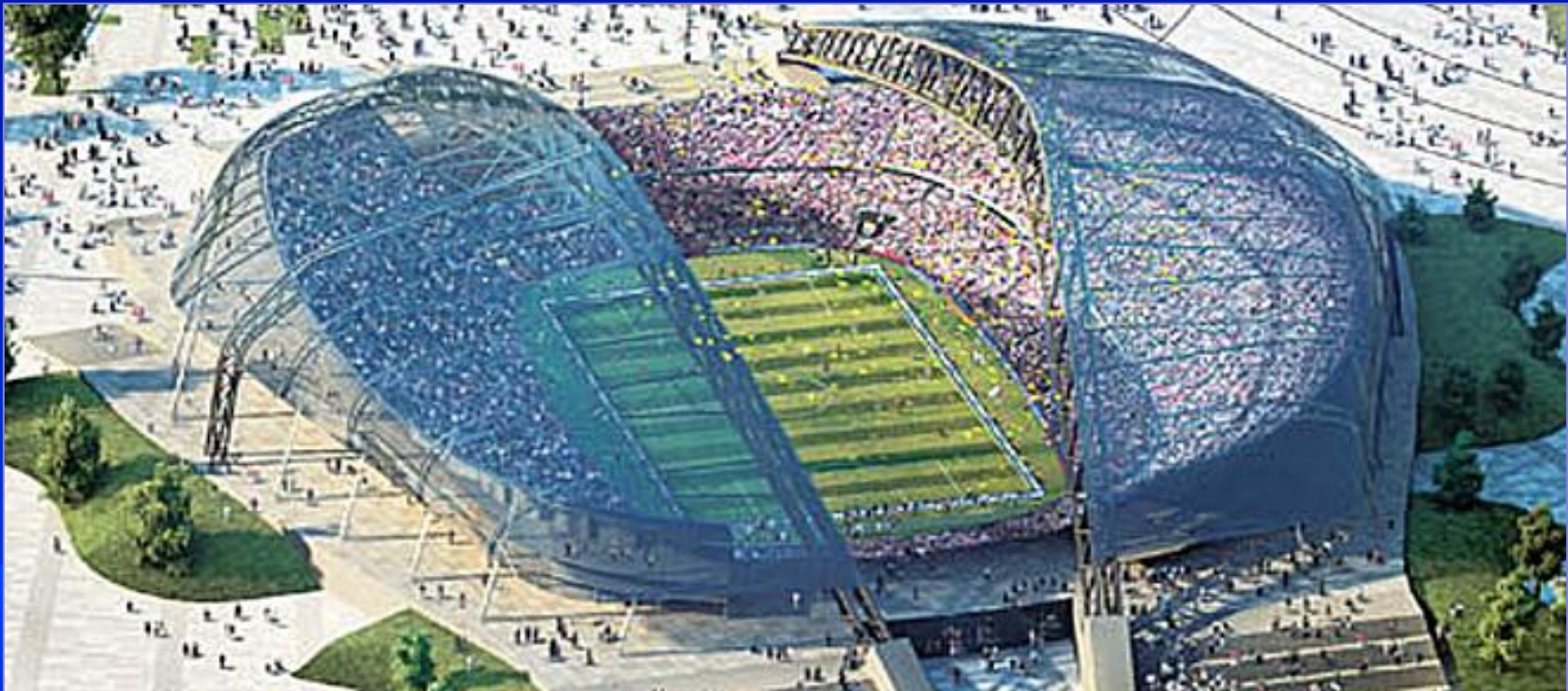


Samara, "Stadium Samara". Total capacity: 44, 198 spectators.
