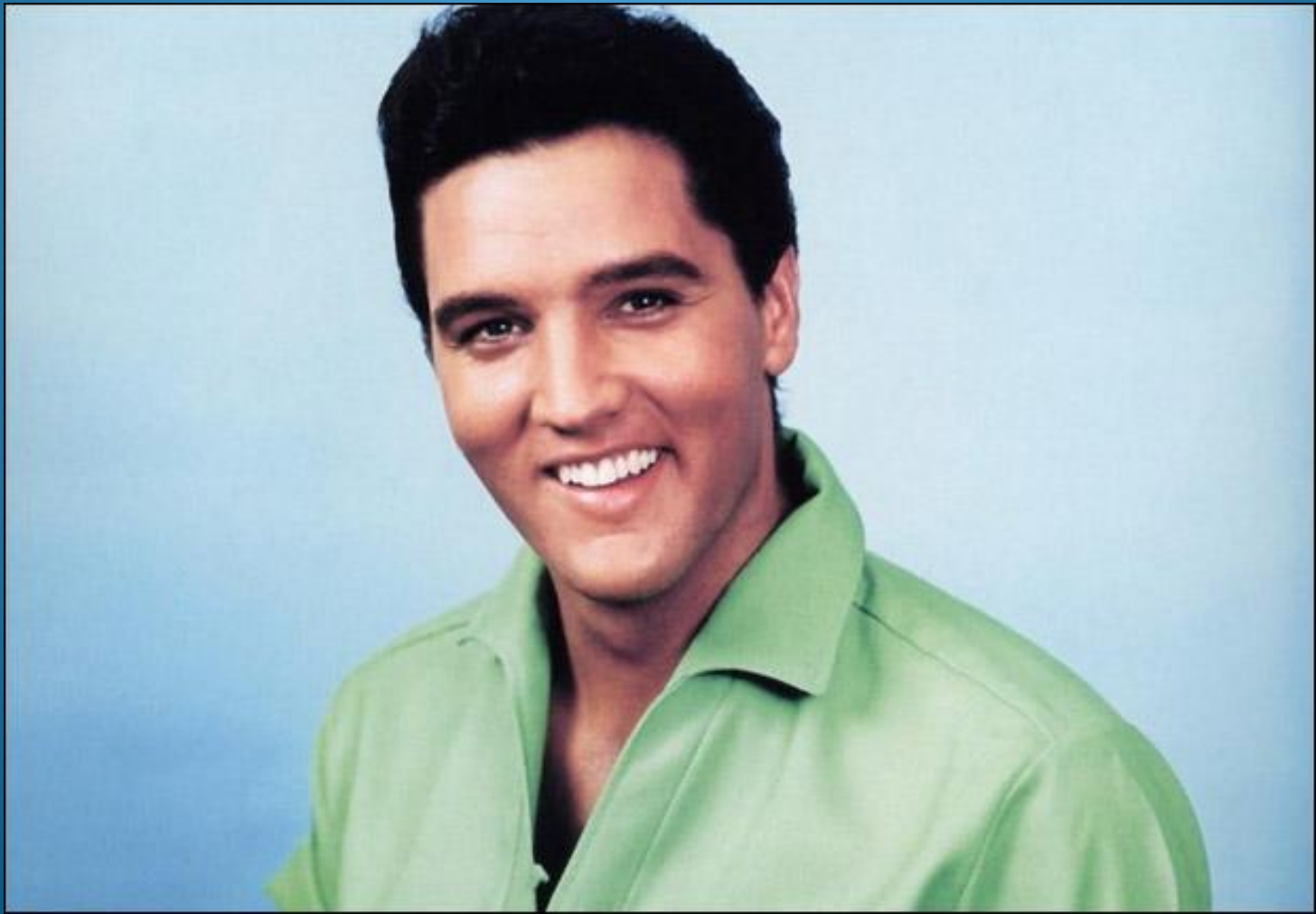

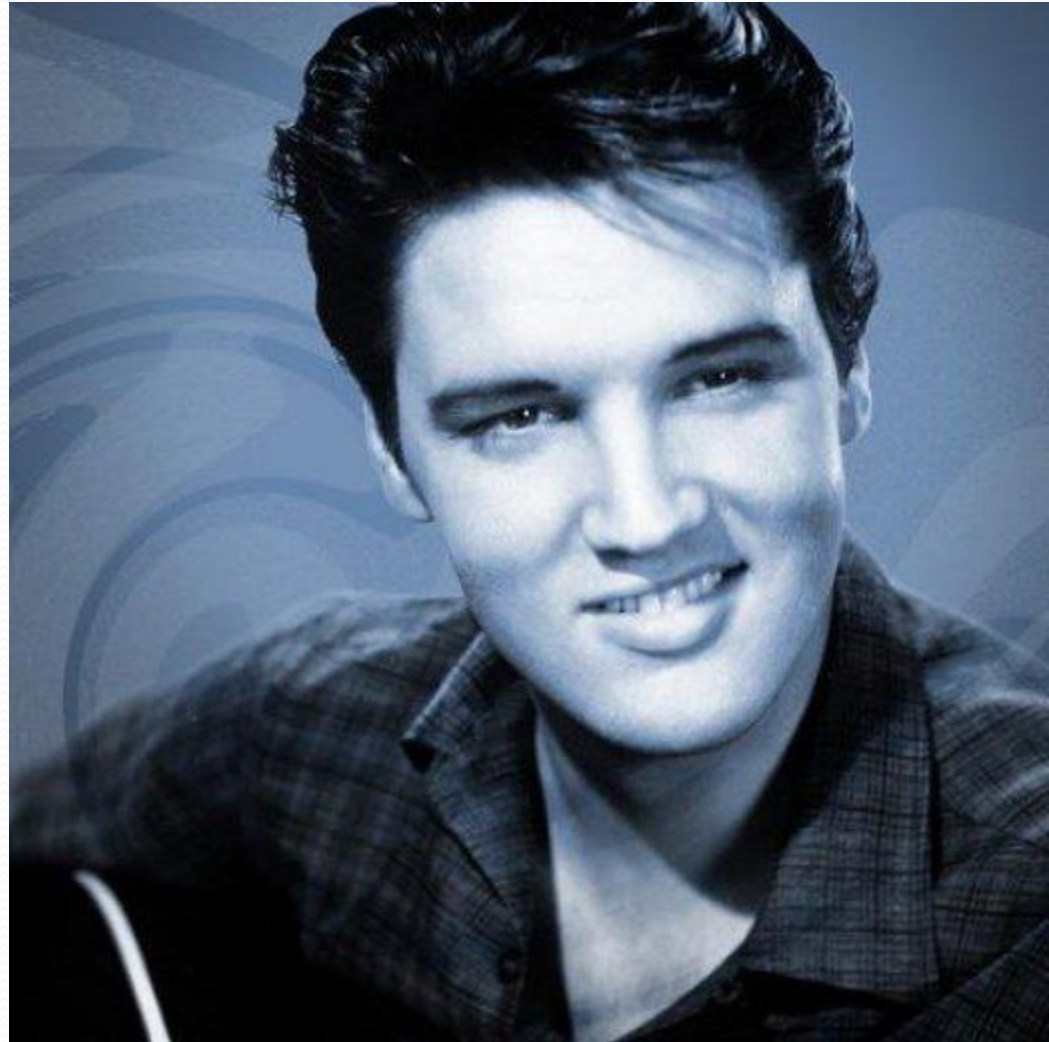
# Elvis Aaron Presley

- The first guitar from his parents

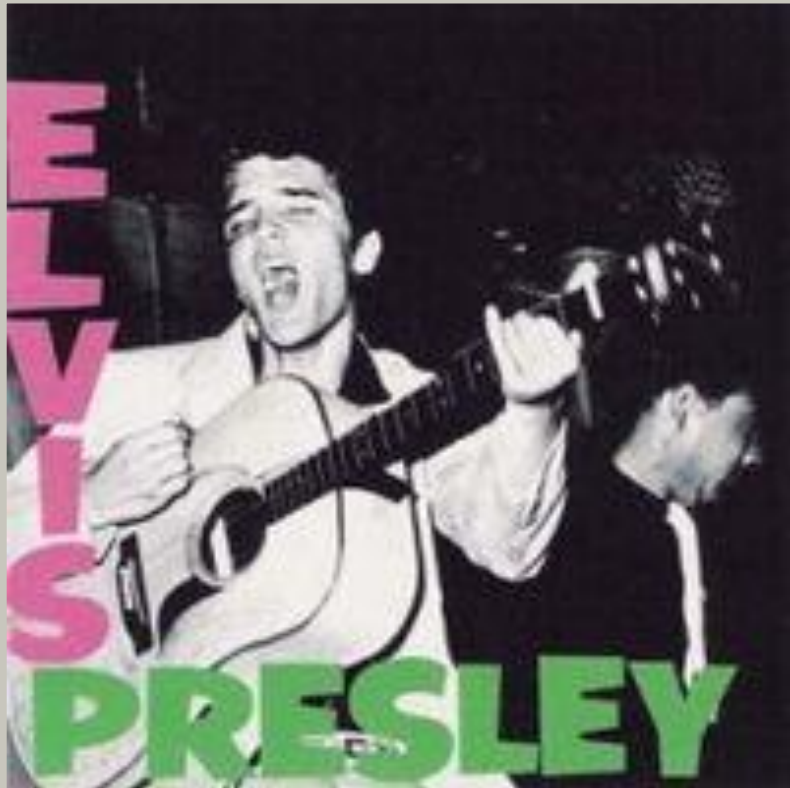
# 1954

- the beginning of their popularity

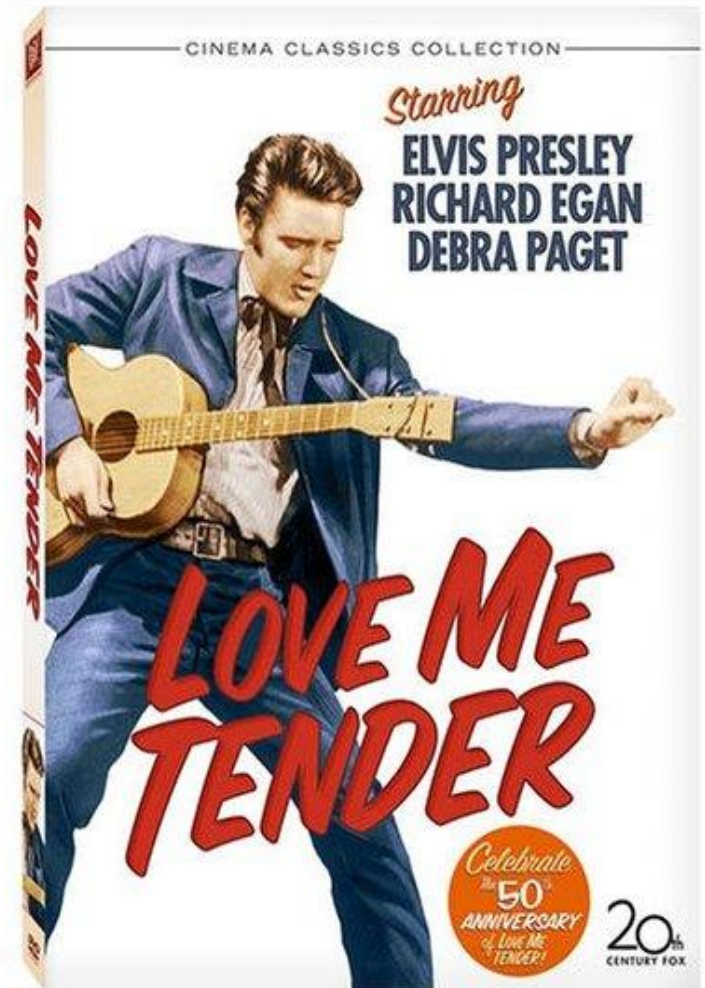


# 1956 – 1958

  - the peak of popularity

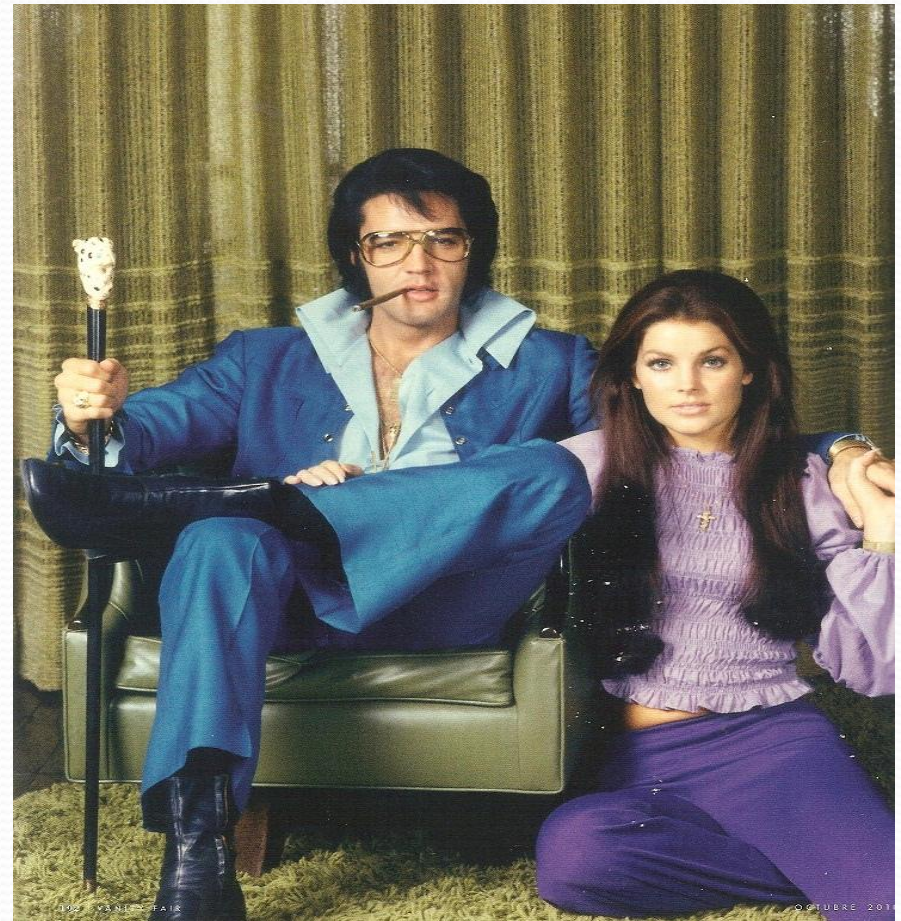


November, 1956 – the premiere of the film “Love Me Tender” with Elvis

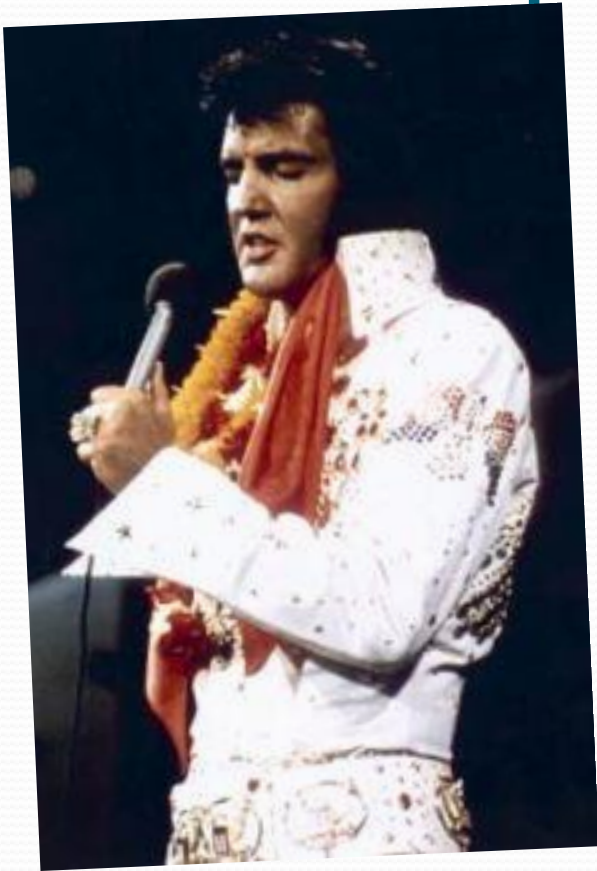
# 1969 - the end of film career and the loss of popularity

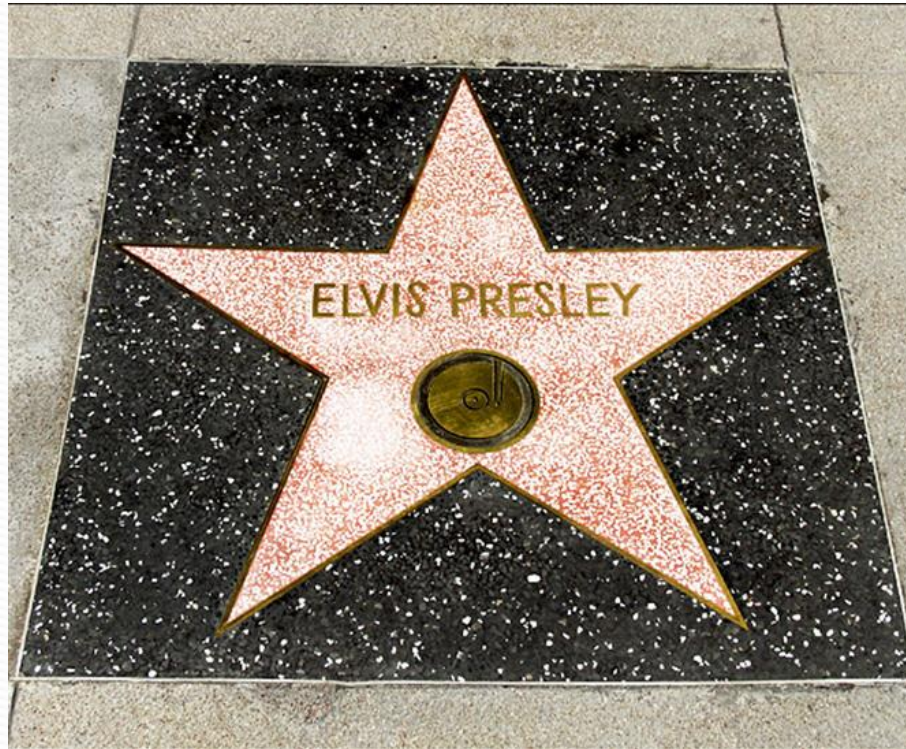
