Christmas carols are special songs which are sung during a Christmas season.



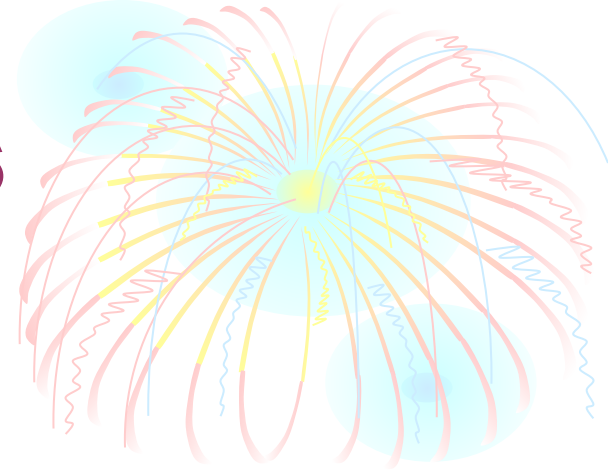
The songs are about Jesus and the time when he was born.







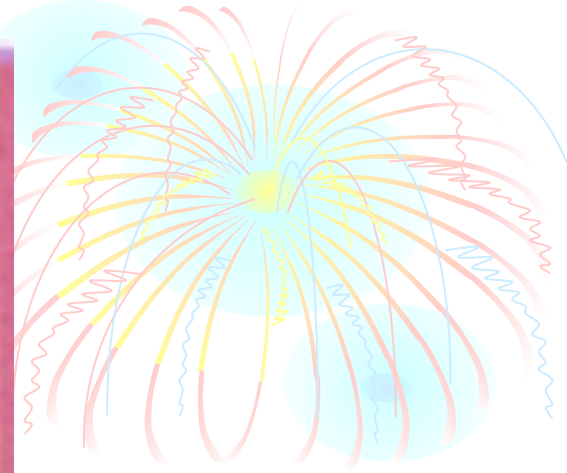
# Jingle bells

A sleighing song tonight.

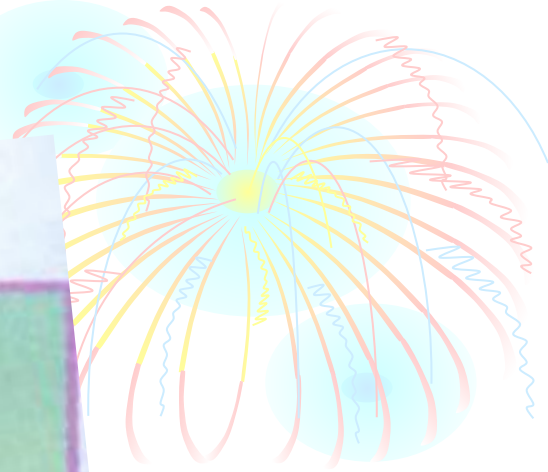

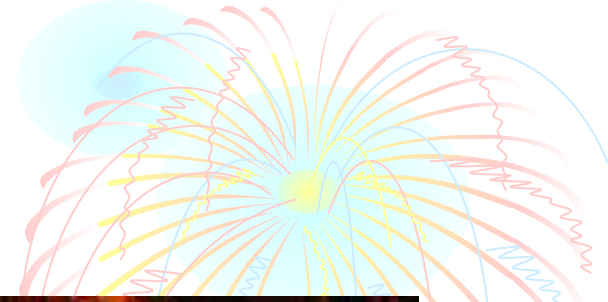
# Christmas Dinner

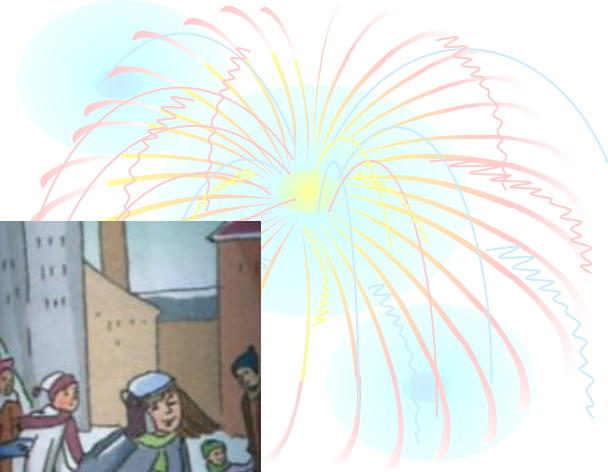
# Christmas in Britain
