o Foreign Languages in our life

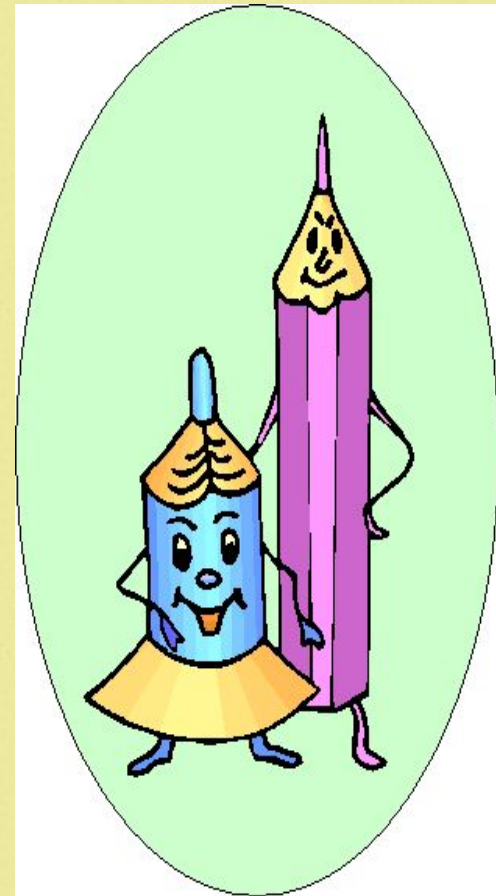
