The Japanese school carefully monitor the students of the second shoe. Therefore, each shelf are lightweight slippers.



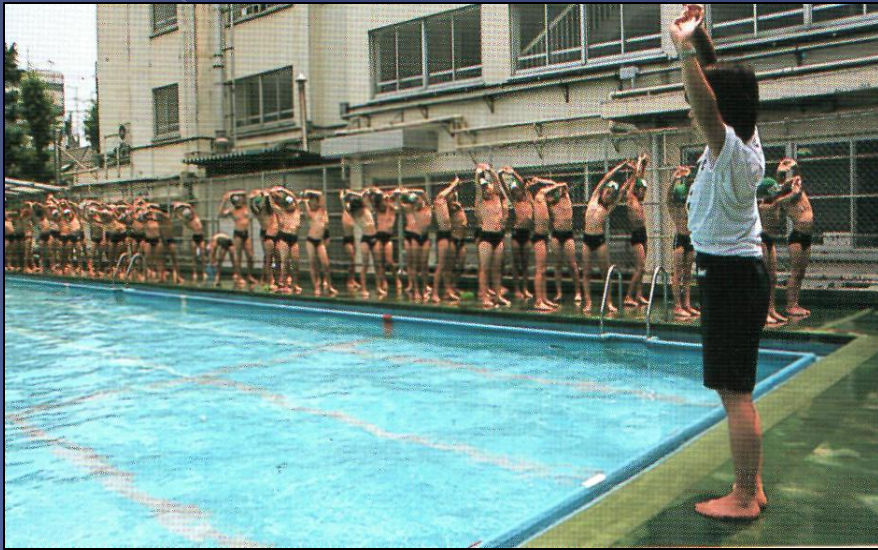
A trip to the nature
