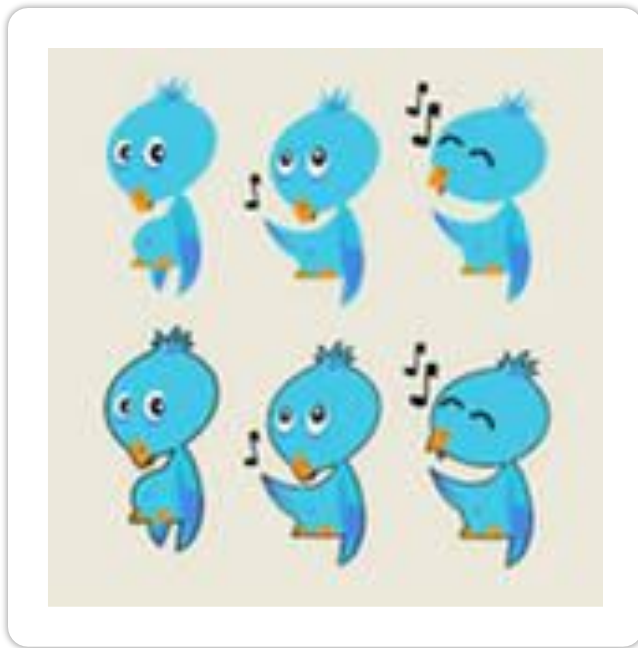

- And so are you.



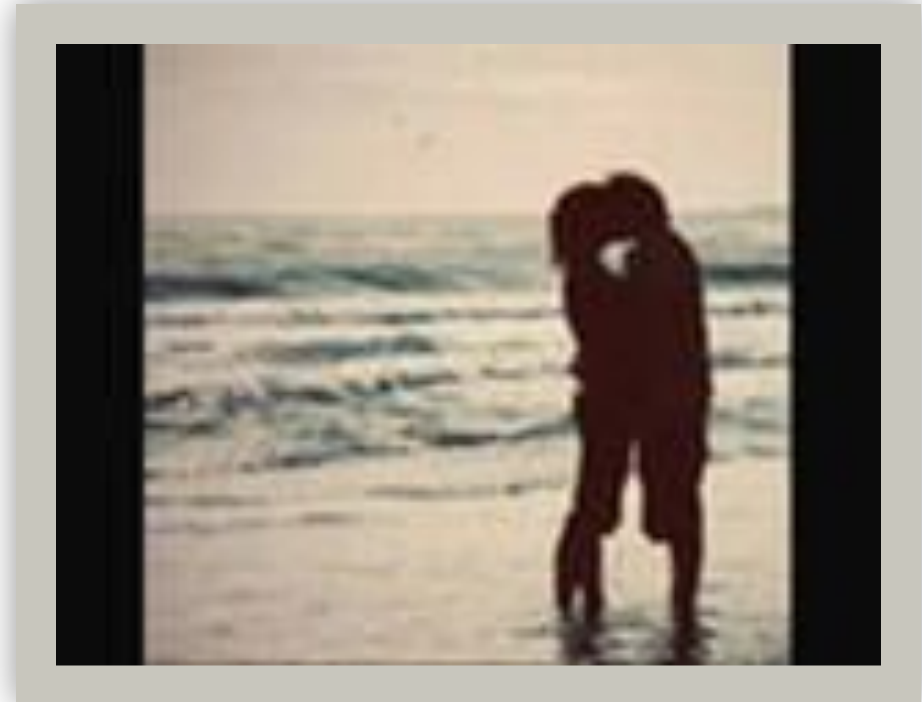
«Poems»

- That you love me, too.



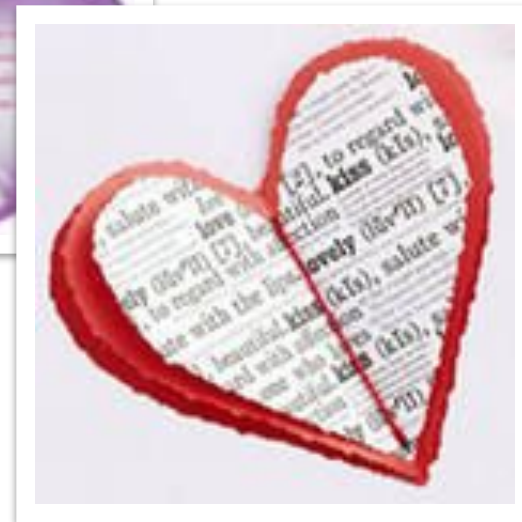
«Poems»
