Geographic Location



The United Kingdom is situated on the British Isles. The British Isles consist of two large islands, Great Britain and Ireland, and a great number of small islands. Their total area is over 244 000 sq. km.



The United Kingdom



- The flag of the United Kingdom is officially called the Union flag, because it embodies the emblems of three countries united under one monarch. The Union Flag is commonly known as the Union Jack.



The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland consists of 4 parts:

England on the south, Scotland on the north, Wales on the west and Northern Ireland is on the north-west of Ireland. All parts have their capitals.

England-London, Scotland-Edinburgh, Wales-Cardiff, Northern Ireland. All parts have their own languages.

England-English, Scotland-Scottish, Wales-Welsh, Northern Ireland-Irish. All parts have their symbols.

England-red rose, Scotland-thistle, Wales-daffodil

The flag of the UK, known as the Union Jack, is made up of three crosses. The upright red cross on a white background is the cross of the 1 St George, the patron saint of England. The white diagonal cross on a blue background is the cross of St. Andrew, the patron saint of Scotland. The red diagonal cross on a white background is the cross of St. Patrick, the patron saint





The Chief of the state is Queen Elizabeth II since 6 February 1952; the Heir of the Crown is Prince Charles, the son of the queen.

Population



The population of the United Kingdom is over 58 million people. The main nationalities are: English, Welsh, Scottish and Irish.

London



London is the capital of Great Britain. The full name of the country is the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. London is an ancient city. Over 8 million people live in London.

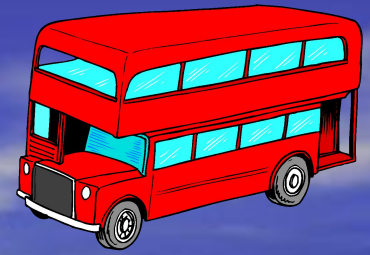
