# The beginning of his long voyage...

**Arseniy Grigoriyevich Golovko was born on June 10, 1906 in a Cossack village Prokhladnaya.**

**He entered the Soviet Navy in 1925 and in 1928 graduated from the Higher Naval School by M.V. Frunze in Leningrad. After that he served in various Fleet assignments.**



**In 1937 and 1938 he took part in the Spanish Civil War on the side of the Republicans. In Spain his name was don Simon Garcia Galvis. He served as a councillor to the commander of the naval base in Cartagena.**



**After his return to the USSR he attended the naval warfare school. From 1940 to 1946, during the second world war, he was Commander of the Red Banner Northern Fleet.**



**The present generation must pay tribute to Arseniy Grigoryevich Golovko, who commanded the Northern Fleet. He won the war on the Northern theater of war.**



**His strategic decisions helped to protect allied convoys and repel Nazi attacks.**



**After the war he held various naval commands, among them Commander of the Baltic Fleet. In 1956 he was named First Deputy Commander-in-Chief of the Soviet Navy.**

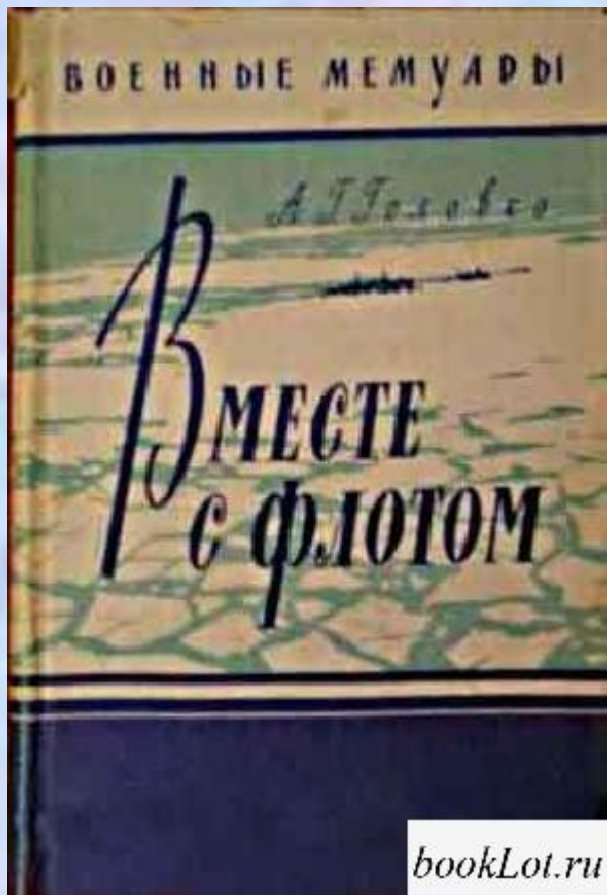

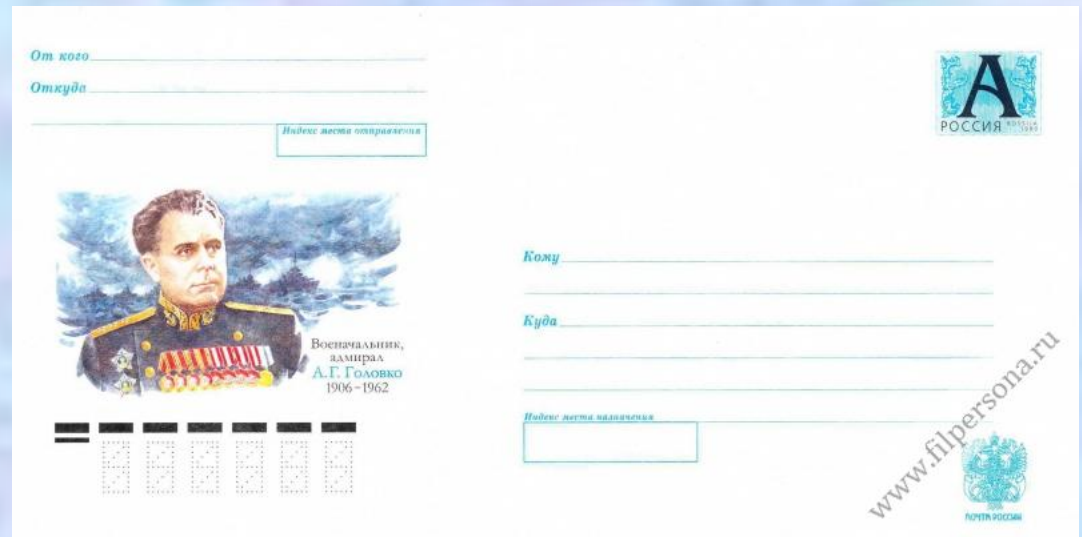
