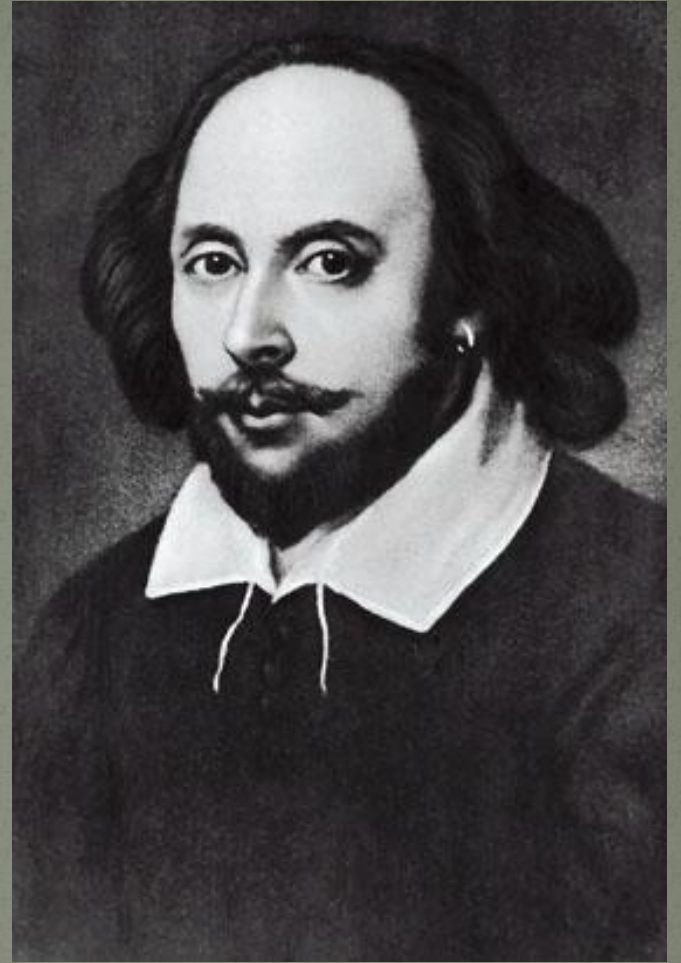


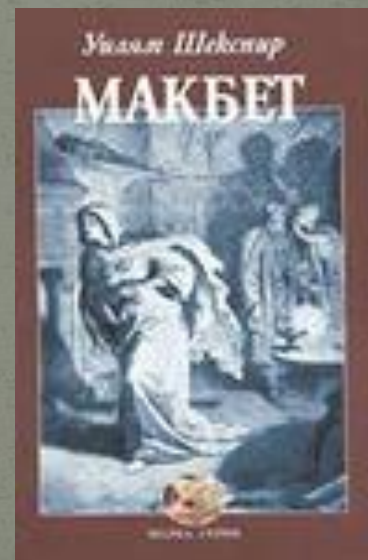
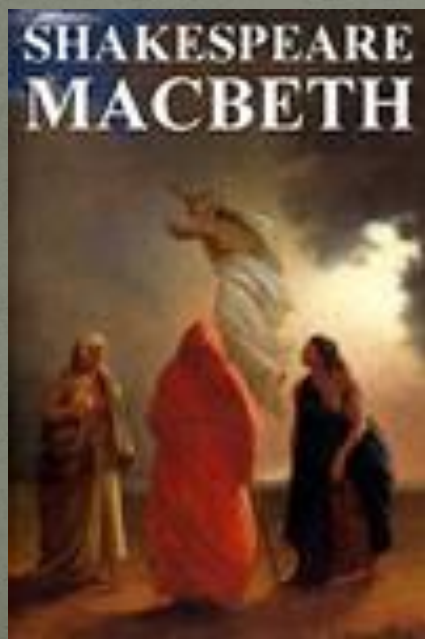
He was born

tragicomedies



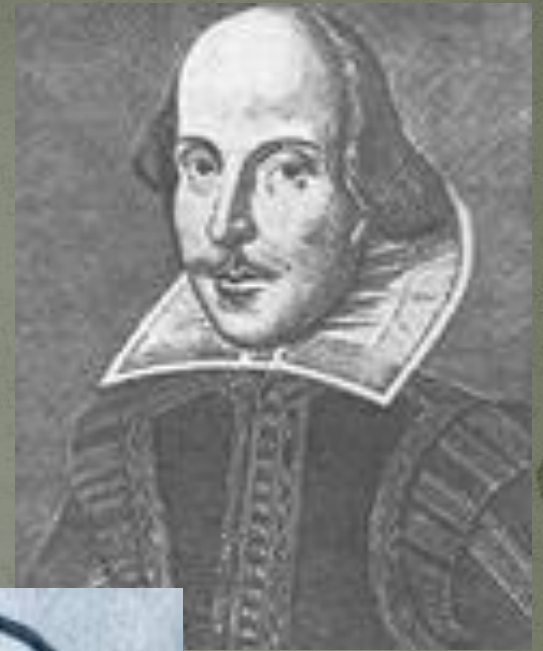


At the end of

- His work-the highest peak of the art world, it has had a huge impact on the world of theater and the whole culture of mankind.



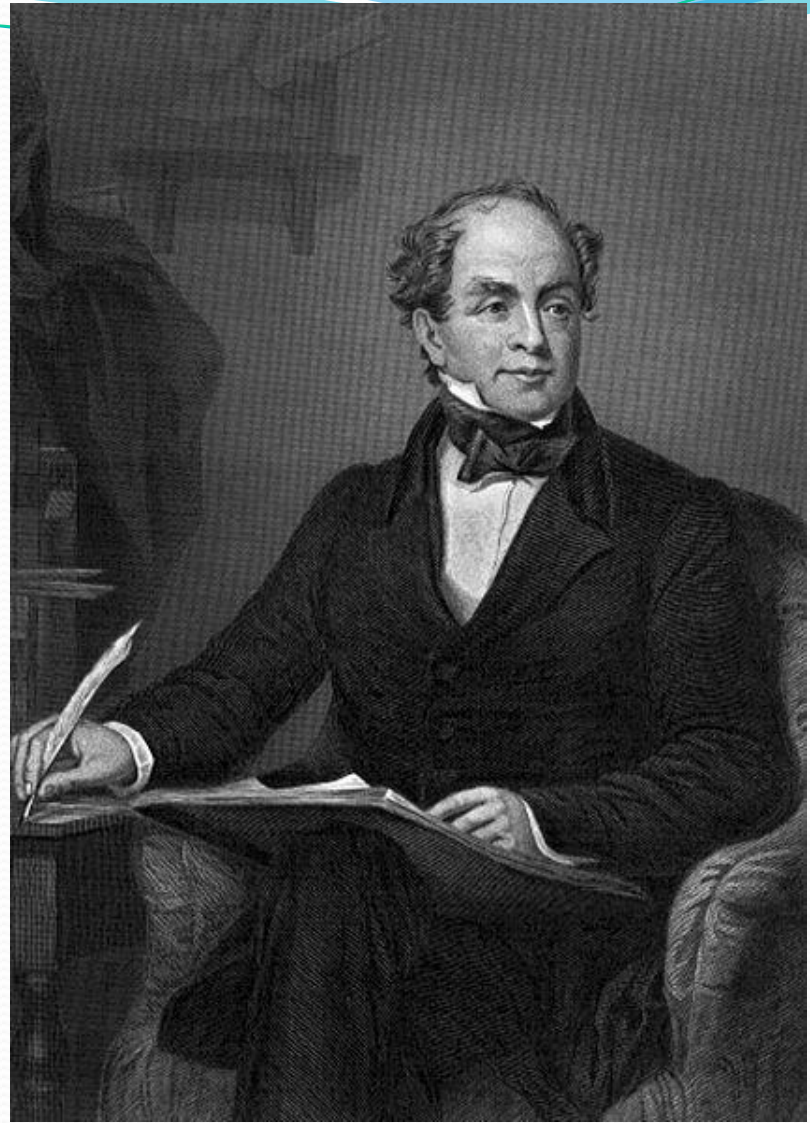






Thomas Moore

(Wiltshire)

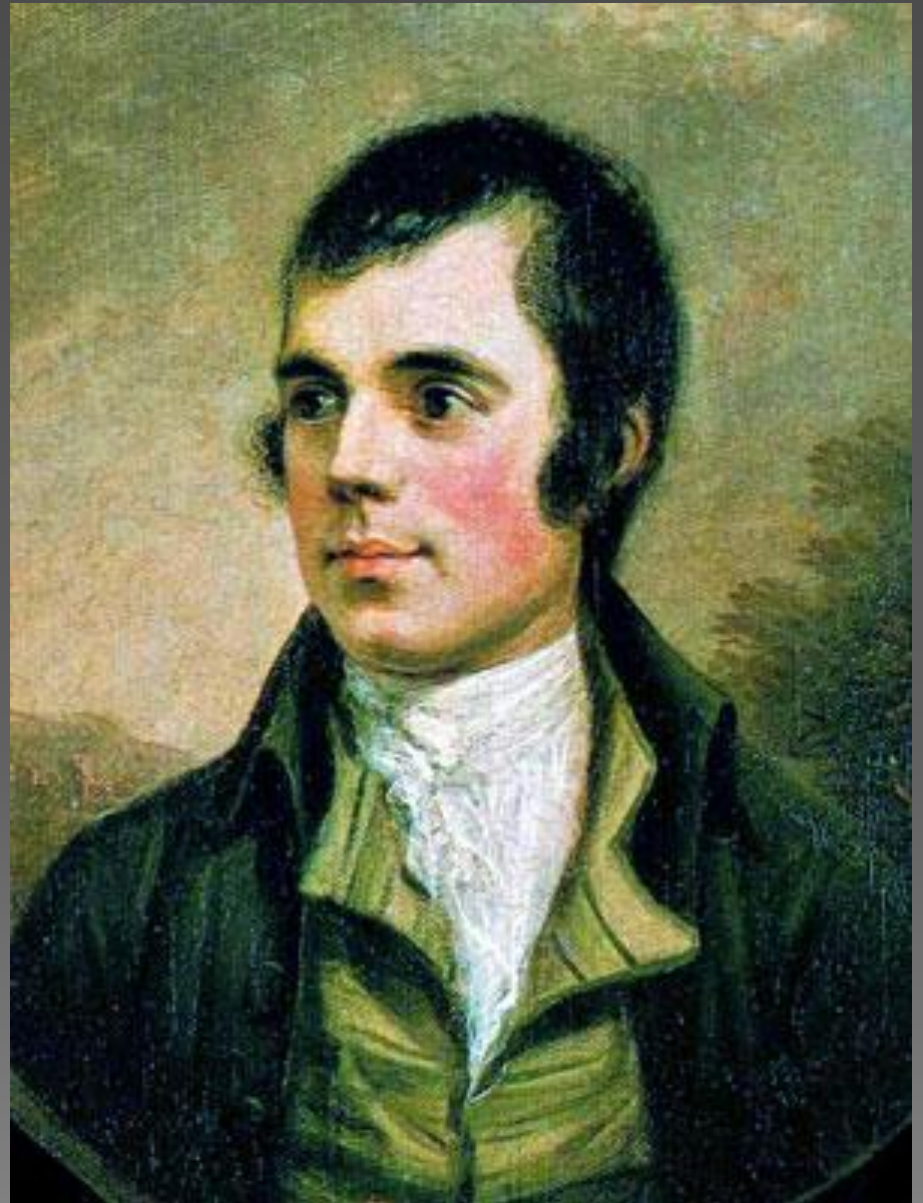






Robert Burns

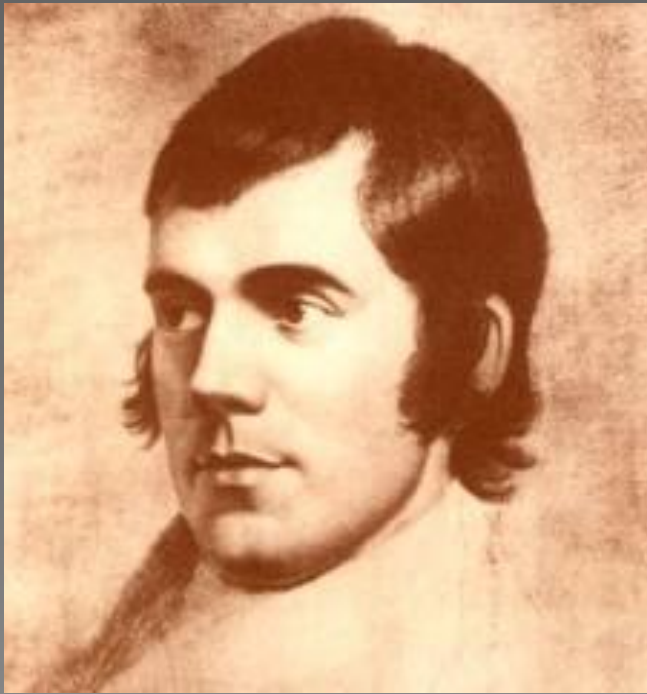
**Robert Burns,

national holiday.**



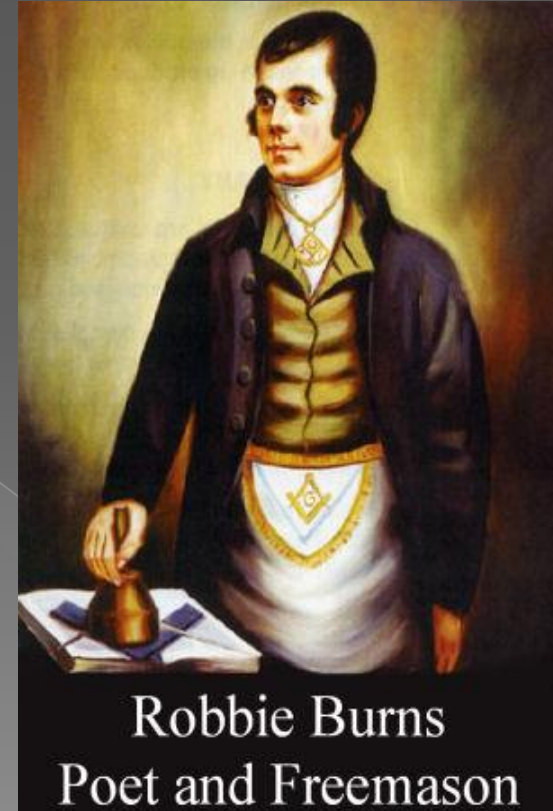
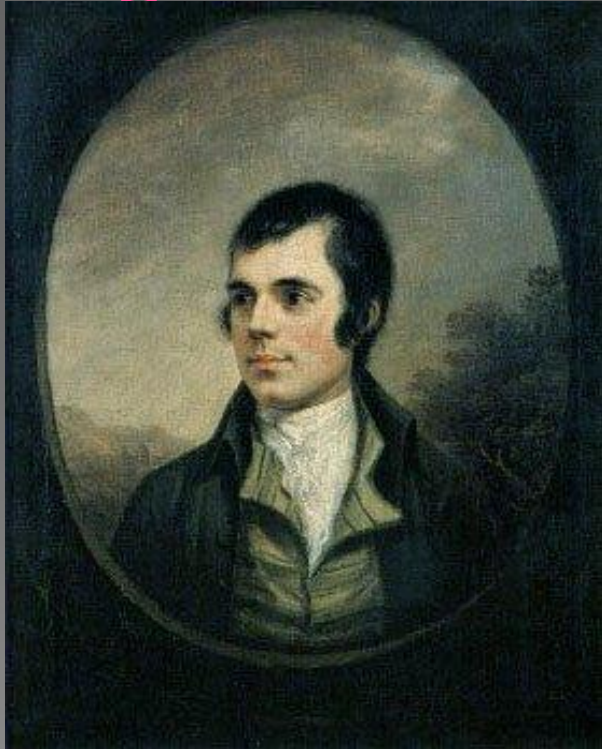
The literary English and Scottish dialect in which his mother sang songs and his aunt told tales of horror about witches influenced Robert's character and his work.



Burns started writing poems at the age 17. He composed verses to the melodies of old folk-song. His life was full of events.



He is widely regarded as the national poet of Scotland, and is celebrated worldwide. He is the best known of the poets who have written in the Scots language, although much of his writing is also in English.
