Reported speech

We use reported speech when we want to tell someone what someone said.

We usually use a reporting verbs:
say, tell, ask and others

Direct speech is that someone actually says
and we report it with a reporting verb

Verbs *in the Present simple* change to *the Past simple*;

the Present continuous changes to *the Past continuous*;

the Present perfect changes to *the Past perfect*;

can changes to *could*;

will changes to *would*; etc.



- Jane told me she was going to get a part time job.

- Really? How wonderful.

She`ll probably have some money for her new bike.



**-What did they say to you?
(- We'll phone later and let you know.)**

We often use ask + if/whether, then change the tenses as with statements



'Do you have any experience working with people?'
They asked if I had any experience working with people.



'What acting have you done?'
They asked me what acting I had done.



**“Don`t forget to tell them about your work at school!”
She told her daughter
not to forget about her work at school.**
