

Passive Voice

to be + V₃

Mary makes tea (active)

Tea is made **by** Mary
(passive)

	ACTIVE	PASSIVE
Present Simple	<i>Mary makes tea.</i>	<i>Tea is made by Mary.</i>
Present Continuous	<i>I am making tea.</i>	<i>Tea is being made (by me).</i>
Past Simple	<i>Mary made some cakes.</i>	<i>Some cakes were made by Mary.</i>
Past Continuous	<i>Mary was making tea.</i>	<i>Tea was being made by Mary.</i>
Present Perfect Simple	<i>Mary has made tea and coffee.</i>	<i>Tea and coffee have been made by Mary.</i>
Past Perfect Simple	<i>Mary had made tea.</i>	<i>Tea had been made by Mary.</i>
Future Simple	<i>Mary will make tea.</i>	<i>Tea will be made by Mary.</i>
Future Perfect Simple	<i>Mary will have made tea.</i>	<i>Tea will have been made by Mary.</i>
Infinitive	<i>Mary has to make tea.</i>	<i>Tea has to be made by Mary.</i>
Modal Verbs	<i>Mary may make tea.</i>	<i>Tea may be made by Mary.</i>

Passive Voice

	ACTIVE	PASSIVE
Pres. S.	V/Vs	is/are + V3
Pres. Con.	am/is/are + V ing	is/are + being + V3
Past S.	V2	was/were + V3
Past Con.	was/were + V ing	was/were + being + V3
Pres. Perf. S.	have/ has + V3	have/has + been + V3
Past Perf. S.	had + V3	had + been + V3
Fut. S.	will + V	will + be + V3
Fut. Perf. S.	will have + V3	will have + been + V3
Infinitive	have/has to V	have/has to + be + V3

Passive Voice

With some verbs (**bring, tell, send, show, teach, promise, buy, sell, read, offer, give, lend, etc.**) we can form two different passive sentences.

Philip will send Jane a gift. (active)

A gift will be sent to Jane by Philip. (passive)

Jane will be sent a gift. (passive)

Causative

Subject + to (have) + Object + V₃

He **paints** the wall. (active)

He **has** the wall **ainted**. (causative)
