

Lena Pillars is a real miracle of nature

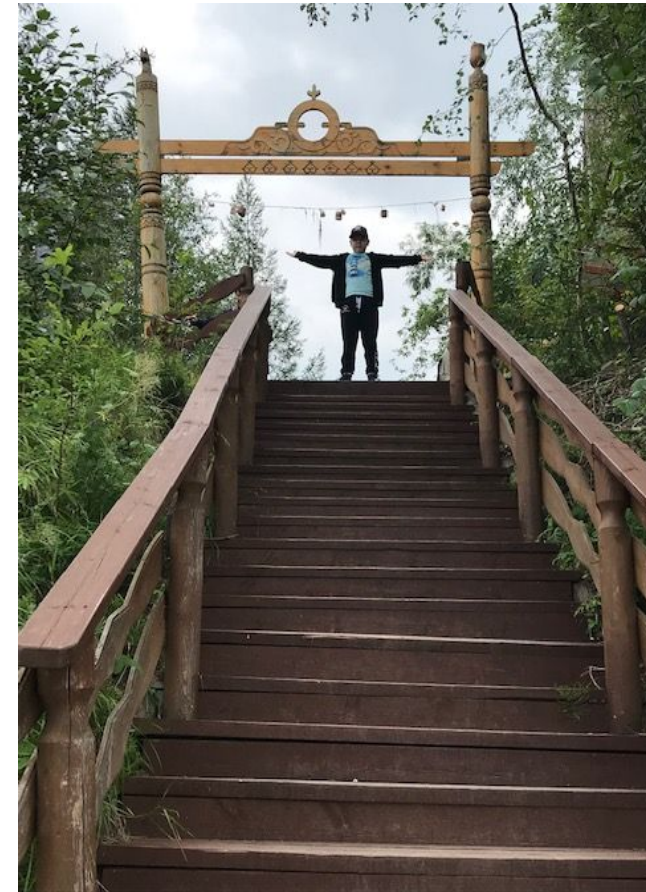

Lena Pillars are part of protected areas as National Parks in Russia

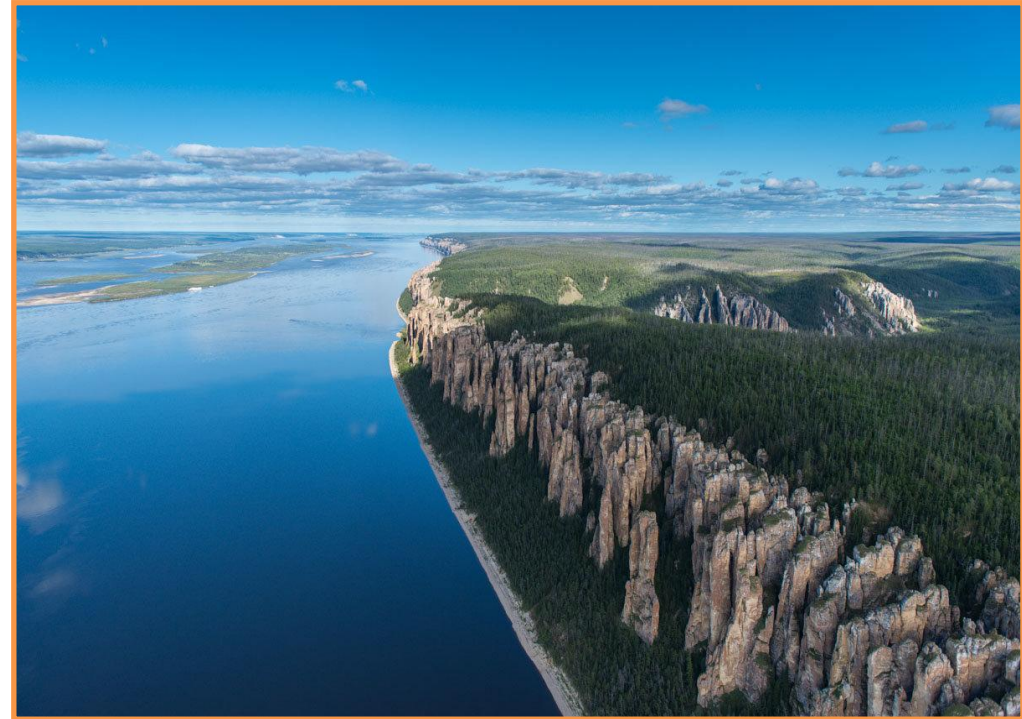


National Nature Reserve Lena Pillars is one of the national parks in Russia which is located in the Sakha republic, Russia and was inaugurated in 1995.

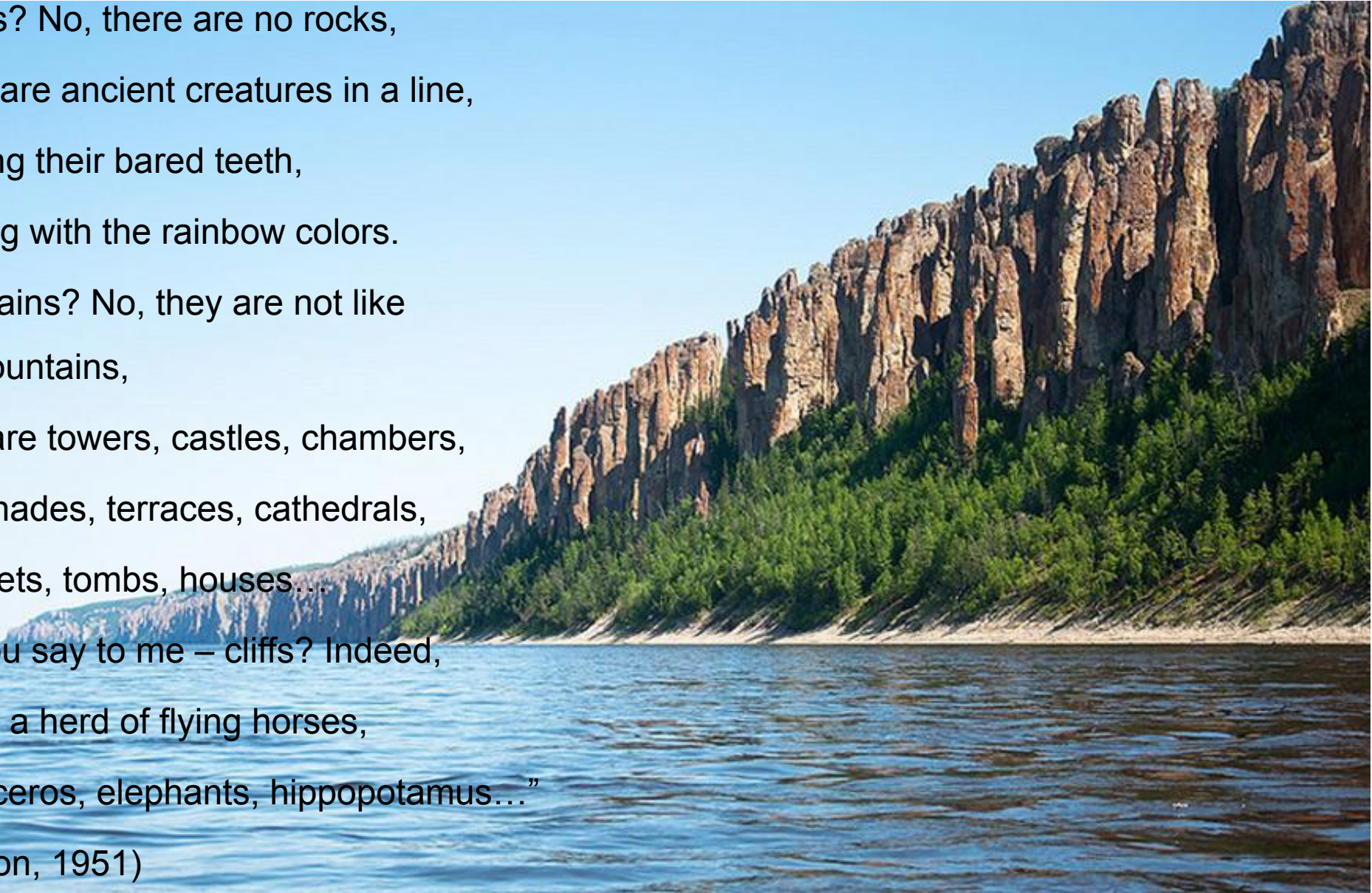


For the Yakuts, they are a symbol of

“Rocks? No, there are no rocks,

Burning with the rainbow colors.
Mountains? No, they are not like
mountains,
They are towers, castles, chambers,
Colonnades, terraces, cathedrals,
Minarets, tombs, houses...
Will you say to me – cliffs? Indeed,
This is a herd of flying horses,
Rhinoceros, elephants, hippopotamus...”
