Mikhail Vasilyevich Lomonosov



Mikhail Lomonosov

(November 8, 1711 - April 4, 1765) was a Russian polymath, scientist and writer, who made important contributions to literature, education, and science.

Early life and family



Lomonosov was born in the village of Denisovka in Archangelgorod Governorate.



Education in Moscow



In 1730, at nineteen, Lomonosov went to Moscow on foot, because he was determined to study. Not long after arriving, Lomonosov obtained admission into the Slavic Greek Latin Academy by falsely claiming to be a priest's son.

Education abroad



Lomonosov plunged into his studies and was rewarded with a two-year grant to study abroad at the University of Marburg, in Germany.

Return to Russia



Lomonosov returned to Russia in 1741. A year later he was named adjutant to the Russian Academy of Science in the physics department.

Physicist and Astronomer



He stated that all matter is composed of corpuscles – molecules that are "collections" of elements – atoms.



Lomonosov was the first person to hypothesize the existence of an atmosphere on Venus

Chemist, Geologist and Geographer



«*On The Strata of the Earth*», 1763

Lomonosov was the first person to record the freezing of mercury.

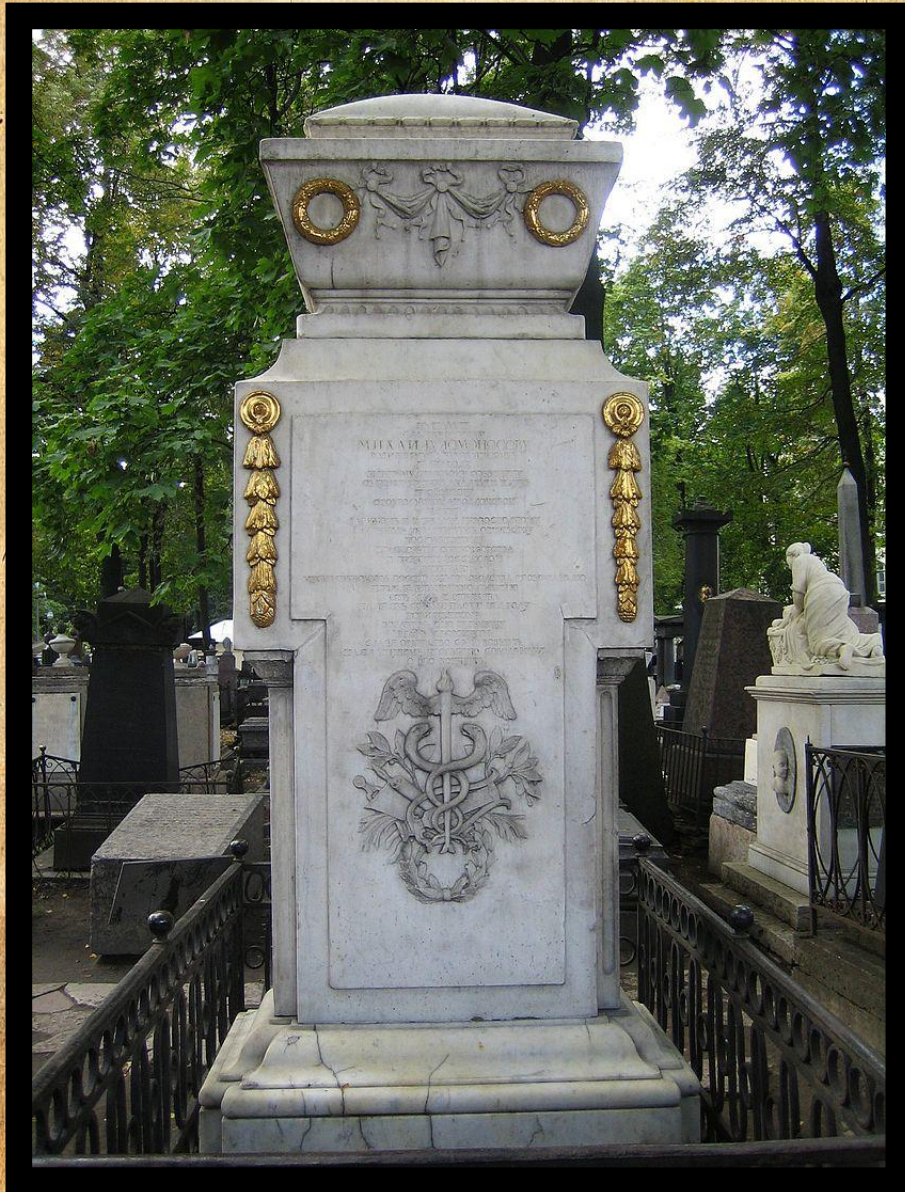


Lomonosov's observation of iceberg formation led into his pioneering work in geography.

Lomonosov in art and literature

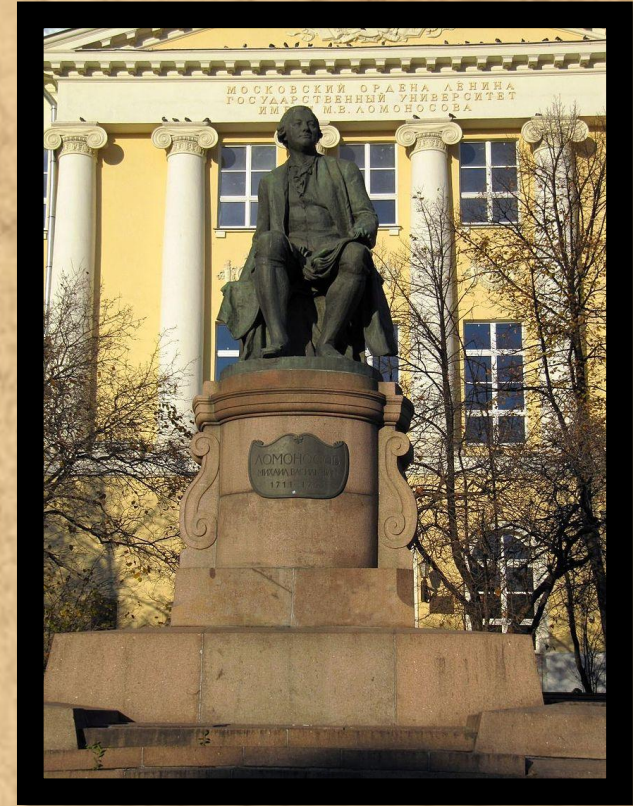
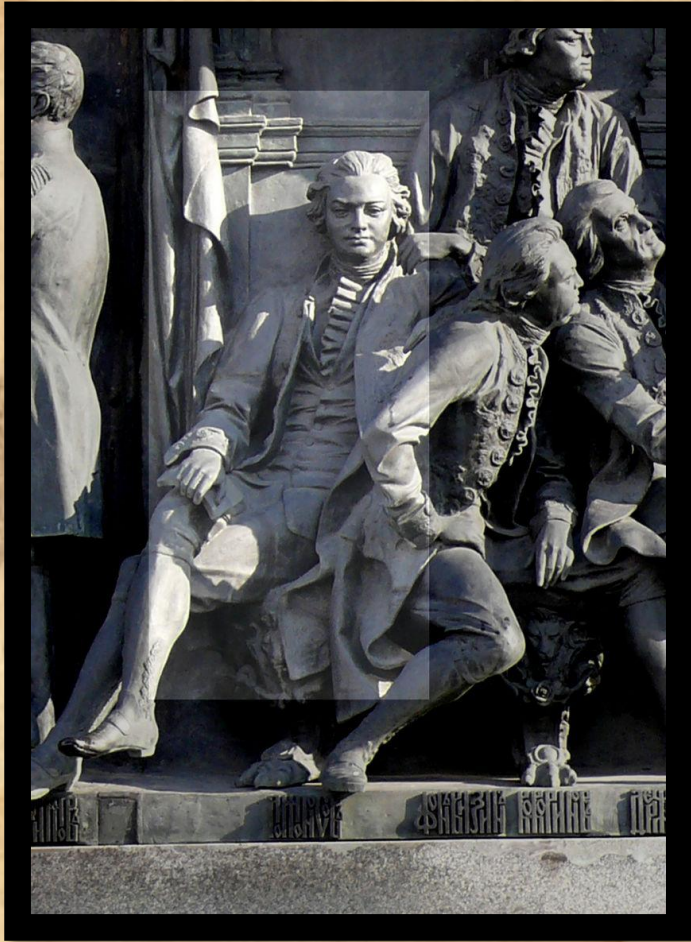


The death of Lomonosov
