

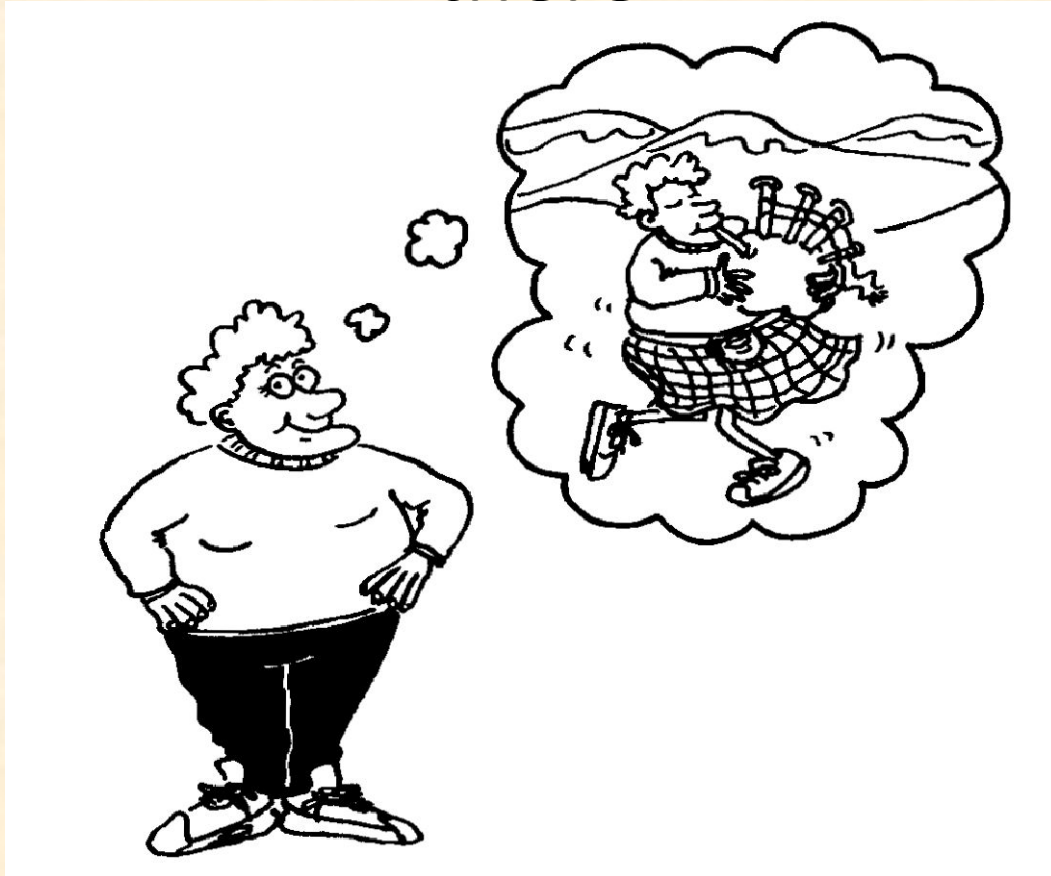
1st Conditional

возможная ситуация в будущем)

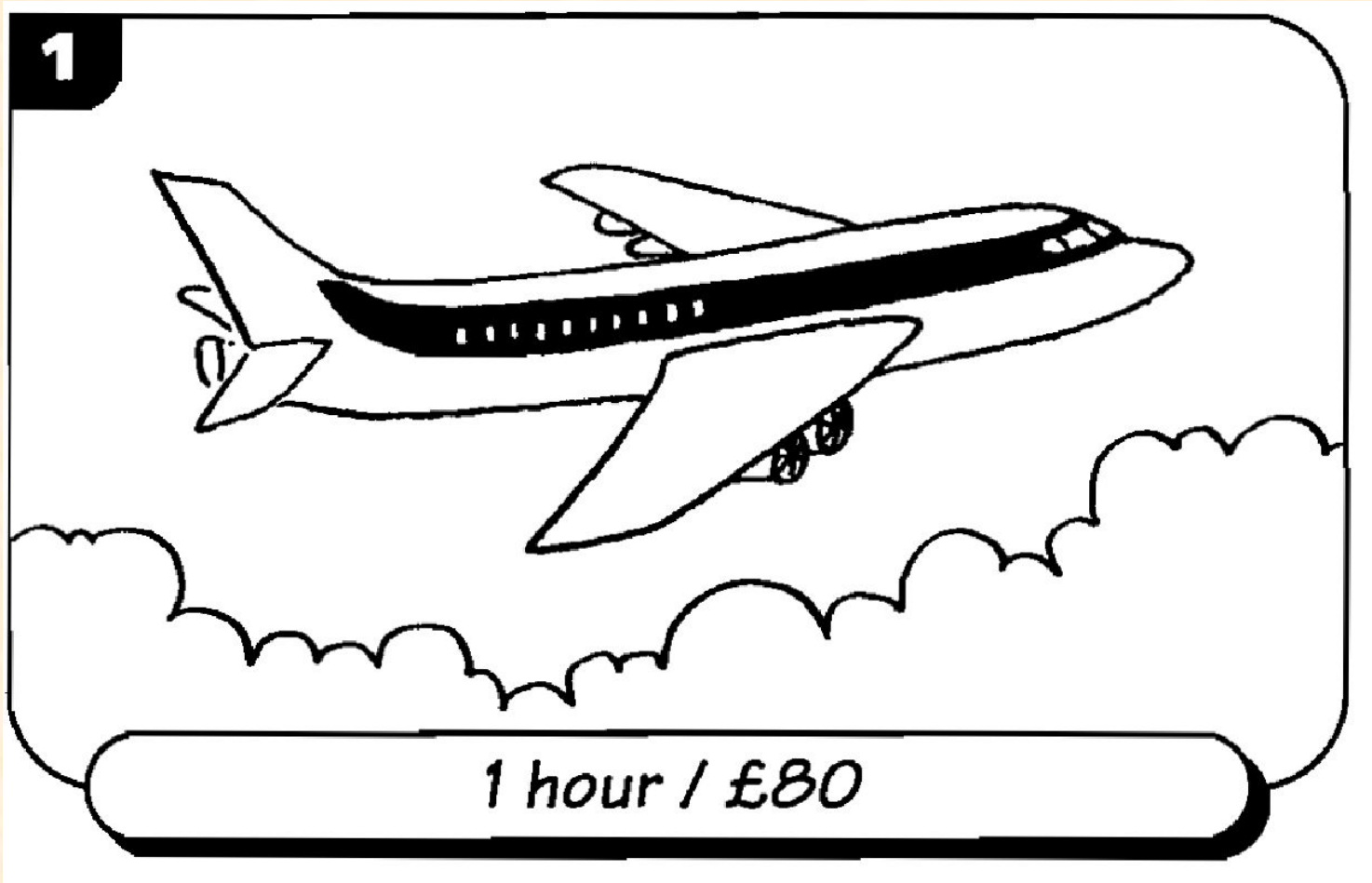
If + Present Simple, → Future Simple (will+verb)

Groovy Granny's trip to Scotland

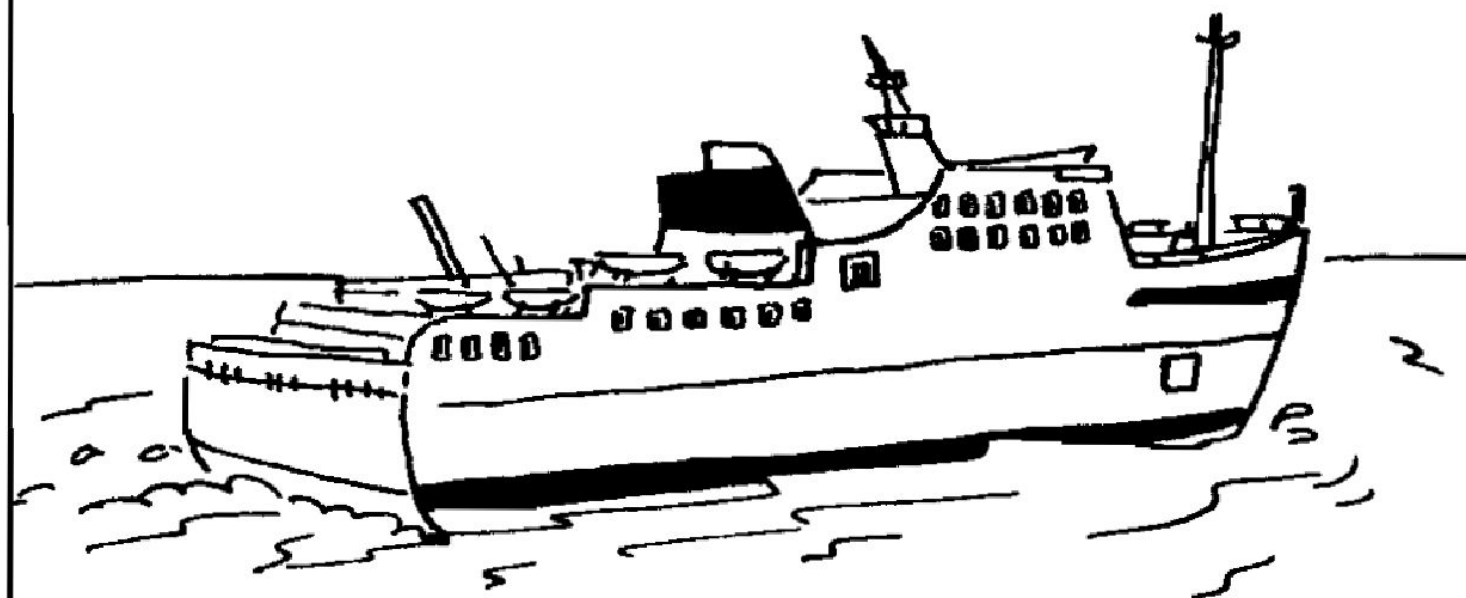
Groovy Granny wants to go to Scotland for a holiday. There are many ways she can go there

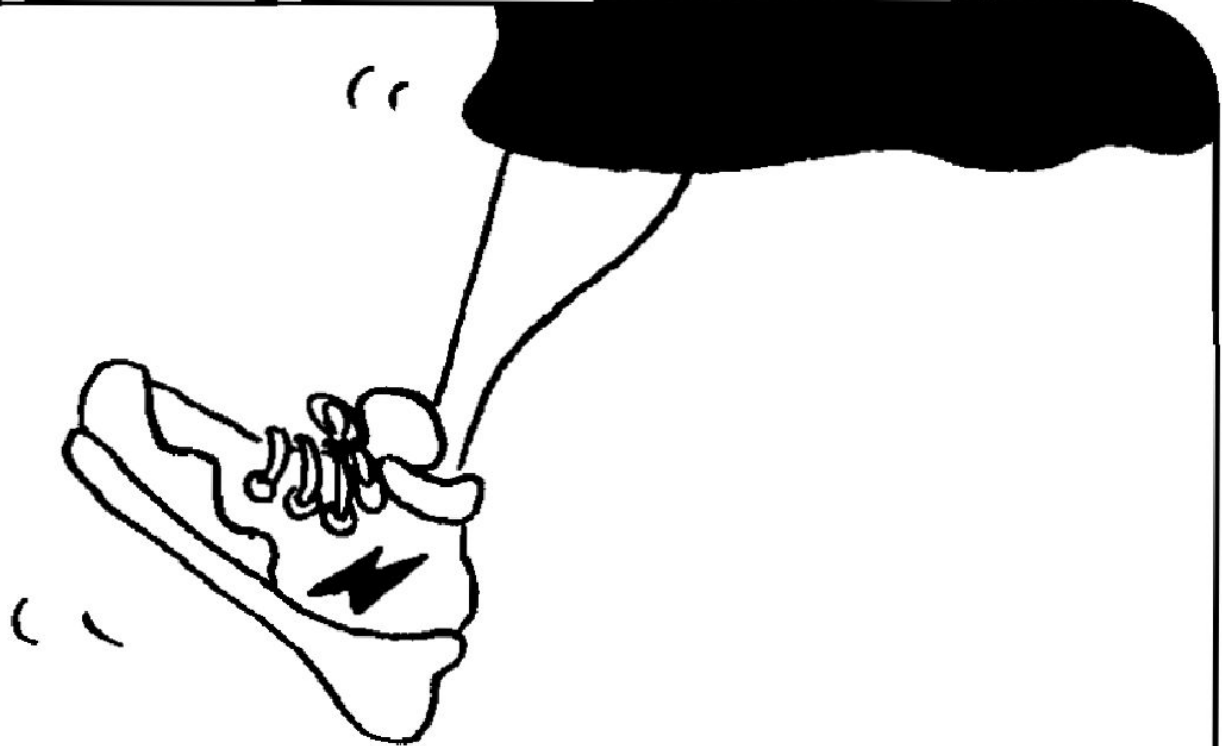

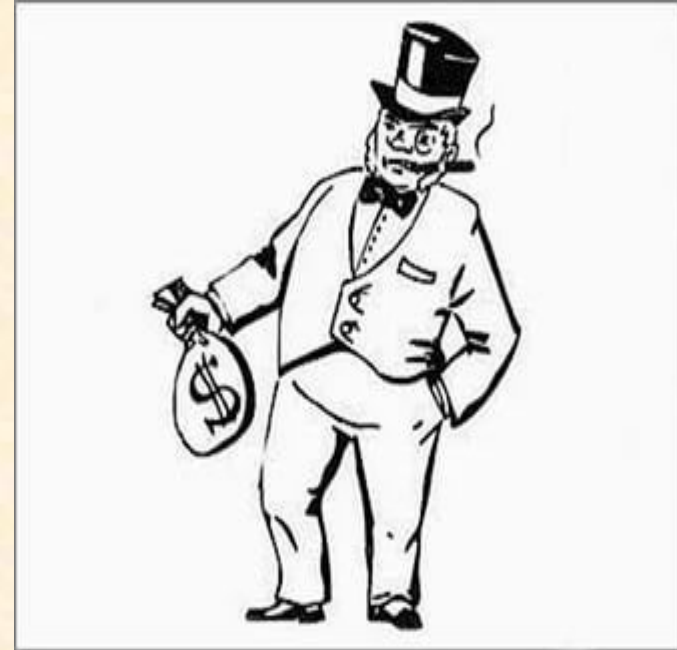
2nd Conditional

If they hadn't ...

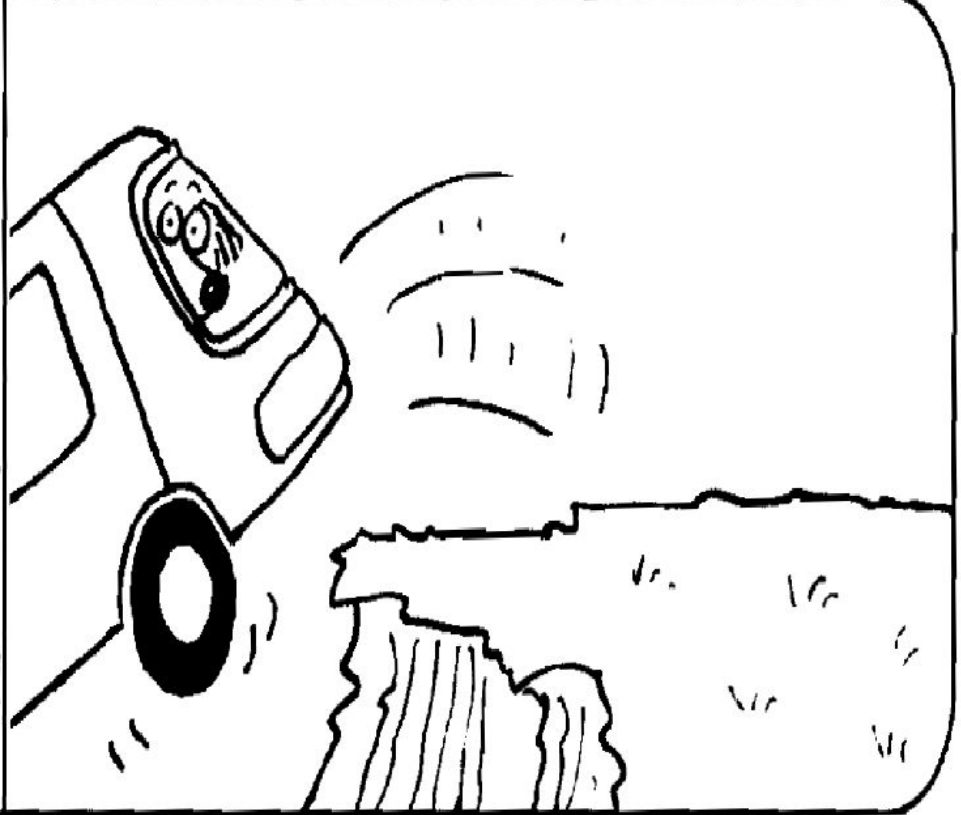

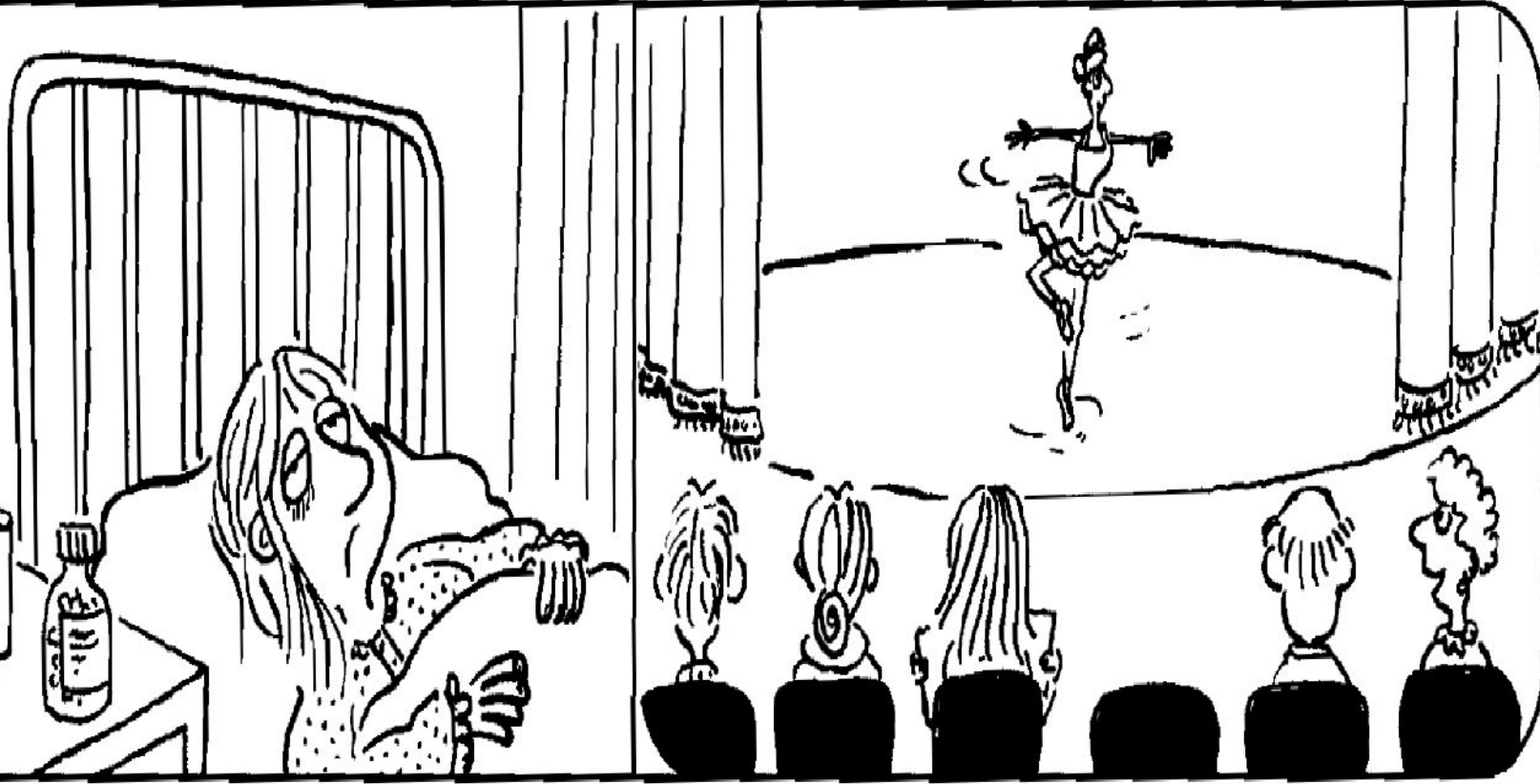

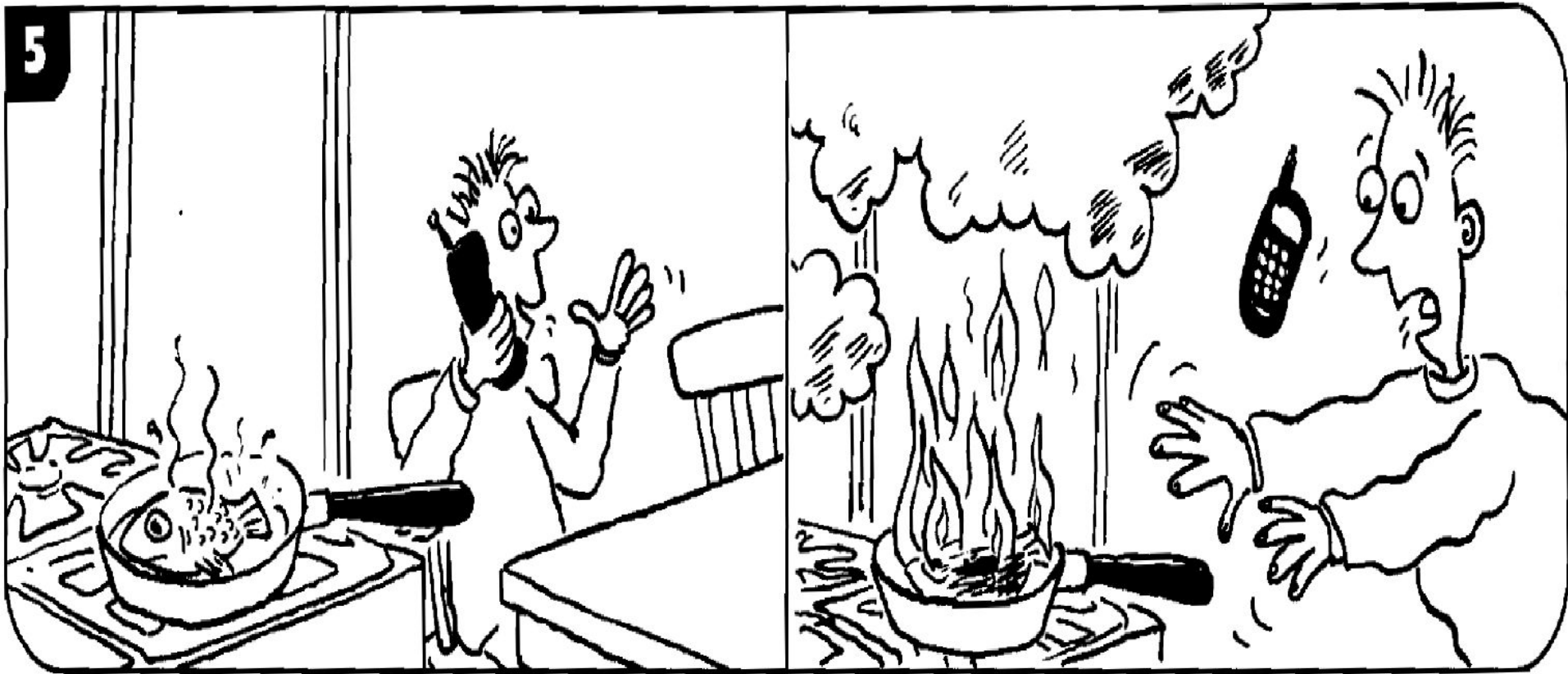
