


Thomas Alva Edison 1847 - 1931







So it would be difficult to choose some of them to put in a Time Capsule.



- 4. They are important because they allow us to do thousands of things that seemed impossible a century ago.







































- 3. They are important, because they give us easy, instant communication all over the world.


























- 1. I think I would include the airplane.

- 4.I don't know what I'd do instead of watching my favourite shows and switching from channel to channel.


























- 1.I am always very busy and have no time to cook.
