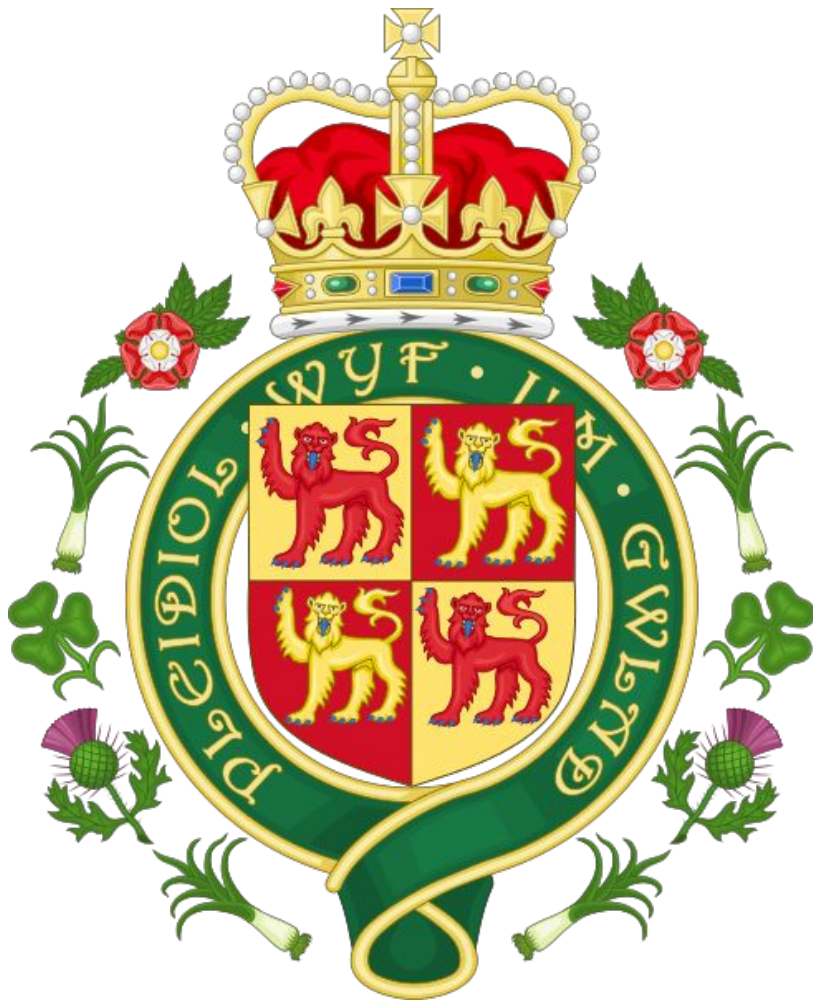




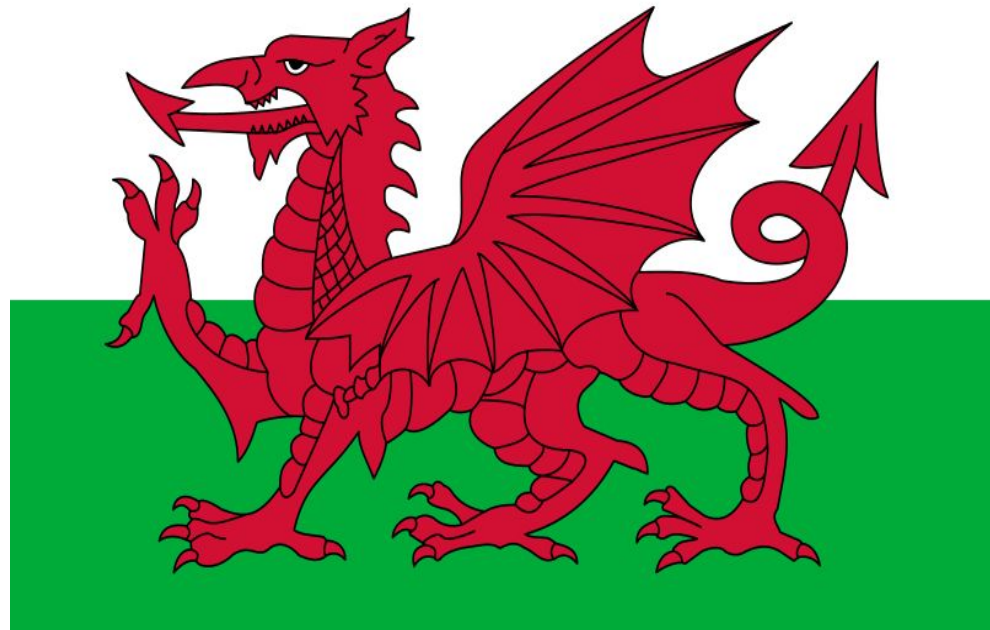

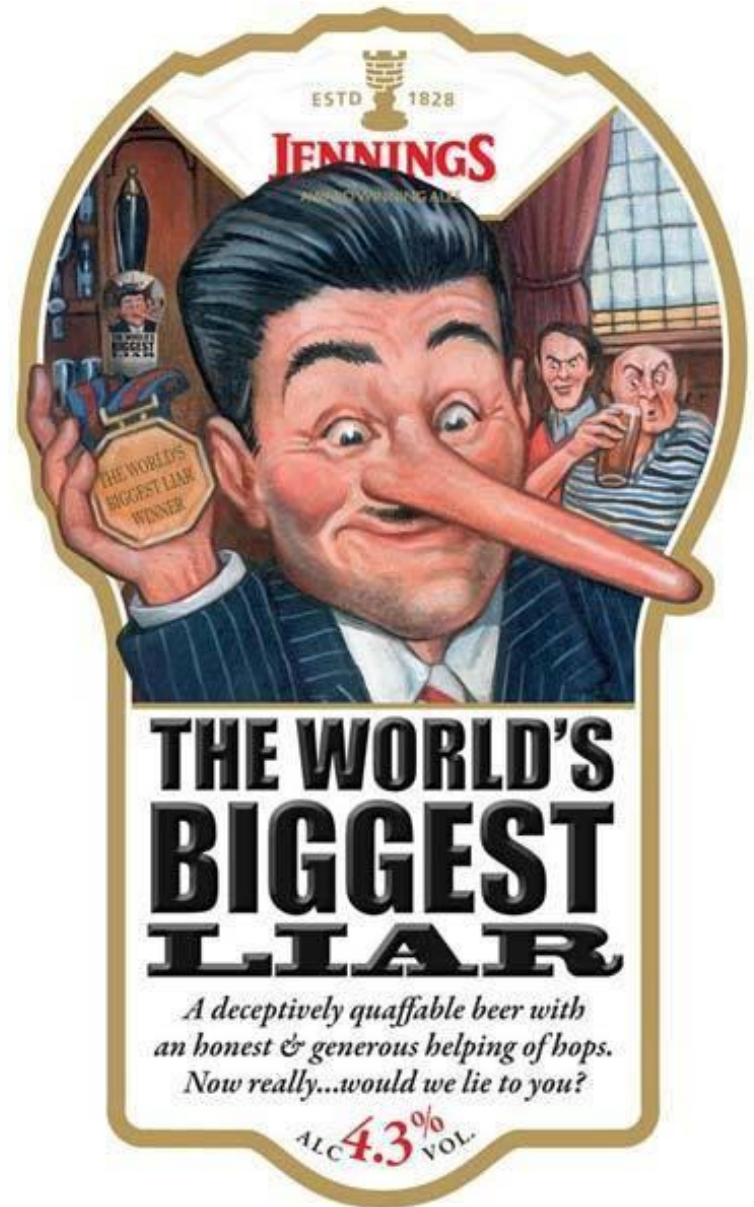
- Wales is the place, where the number of castles per square mile higher than anywhere else in the world. Moreover, Wales is a country of the legendary King Arthur.
