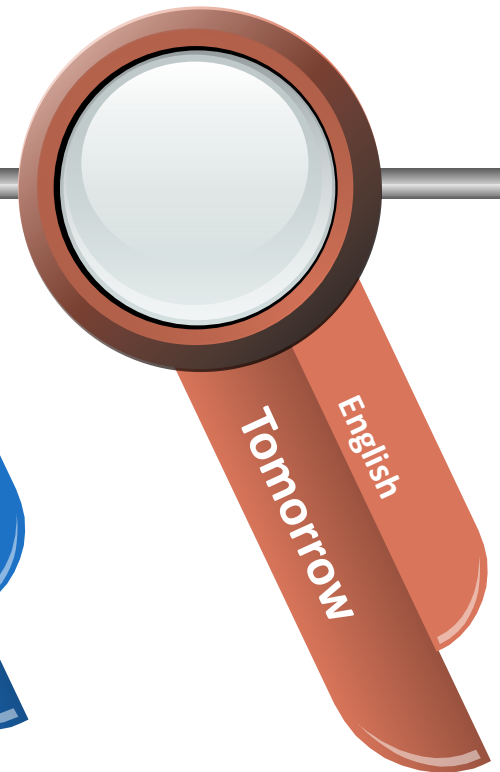
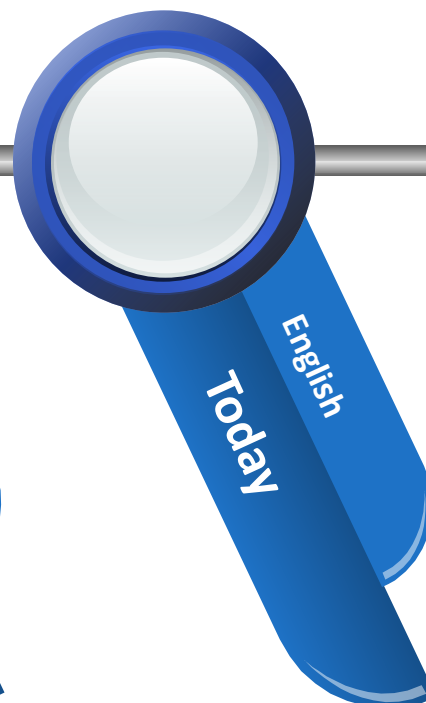

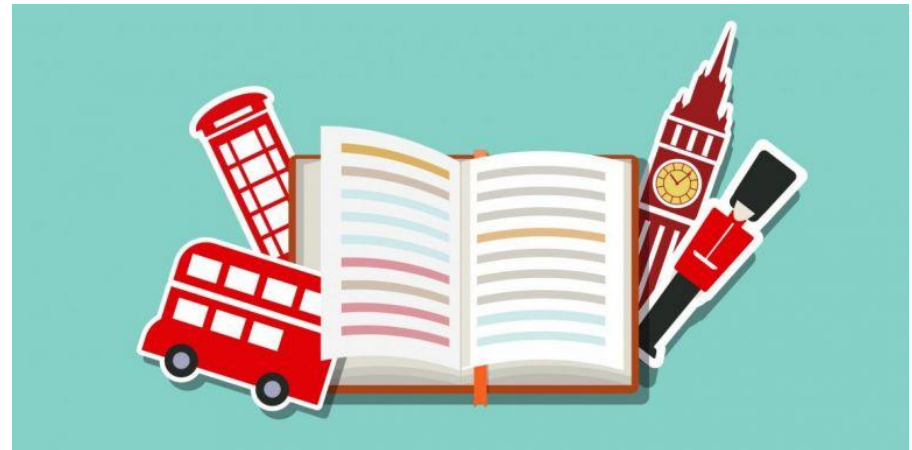


## Why English Is So Popular?

# English Today

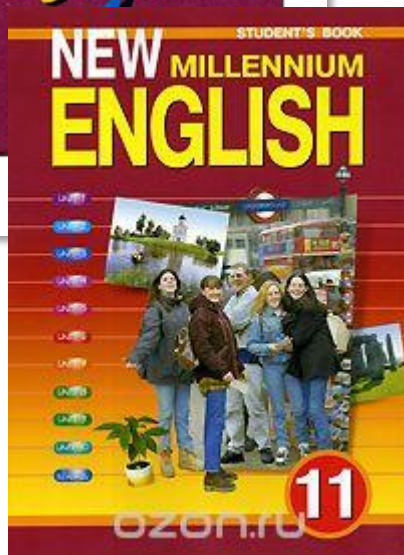
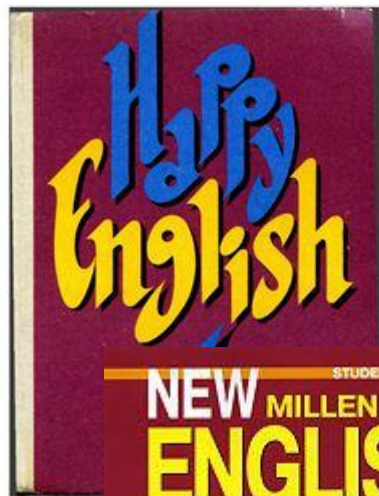


There are lots of private English schools, classes etc. Everyone seems to either be planning to study English, or studying English, or dreaming to study English, or already knows the language.
