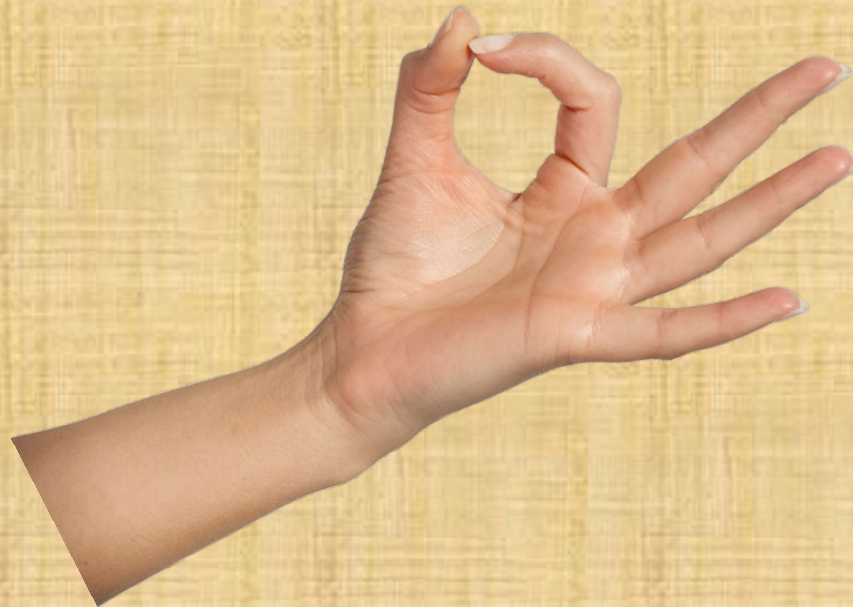

The American “OK” sign shows that all is well or perfect. It was formed as the letter “O” indicating that something was as perfect as a circle.





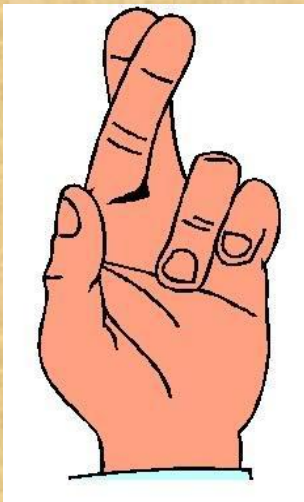

- **when they lie** they hide their arms behind their backs not to let on that they are lying.





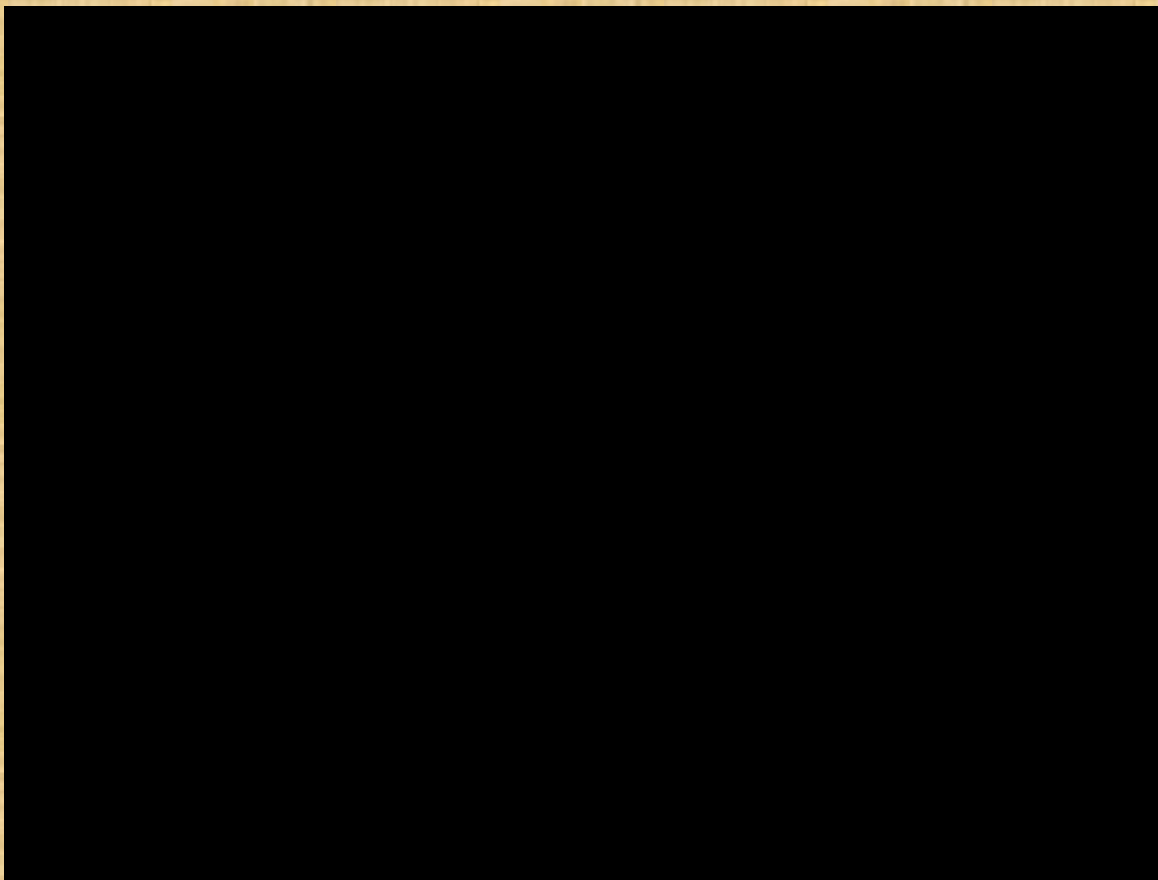

shows a feeling of helplessness: ***“Don’t ask me, I don’t know what to say,”*** or ***“I couldn’t help it.”***





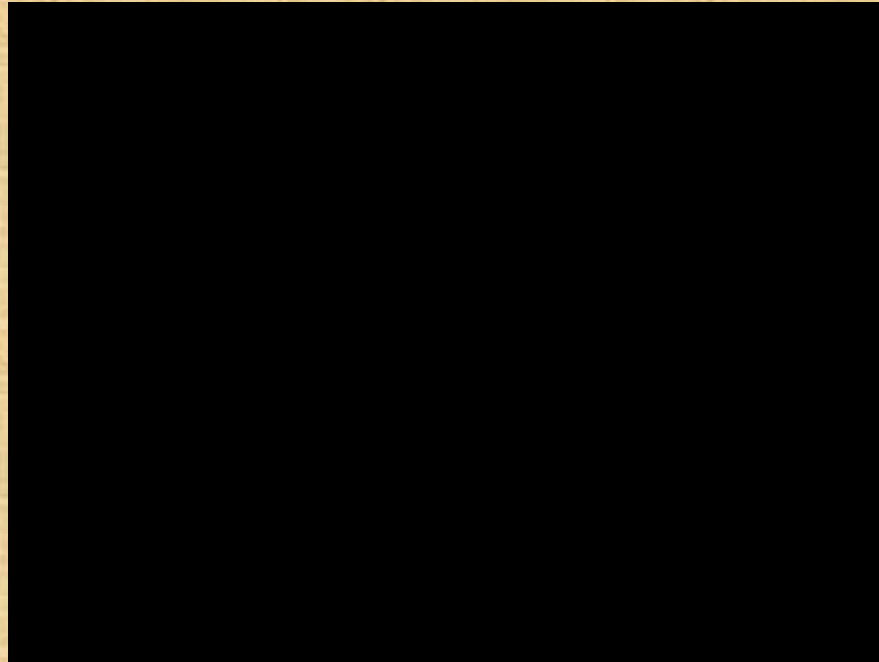
