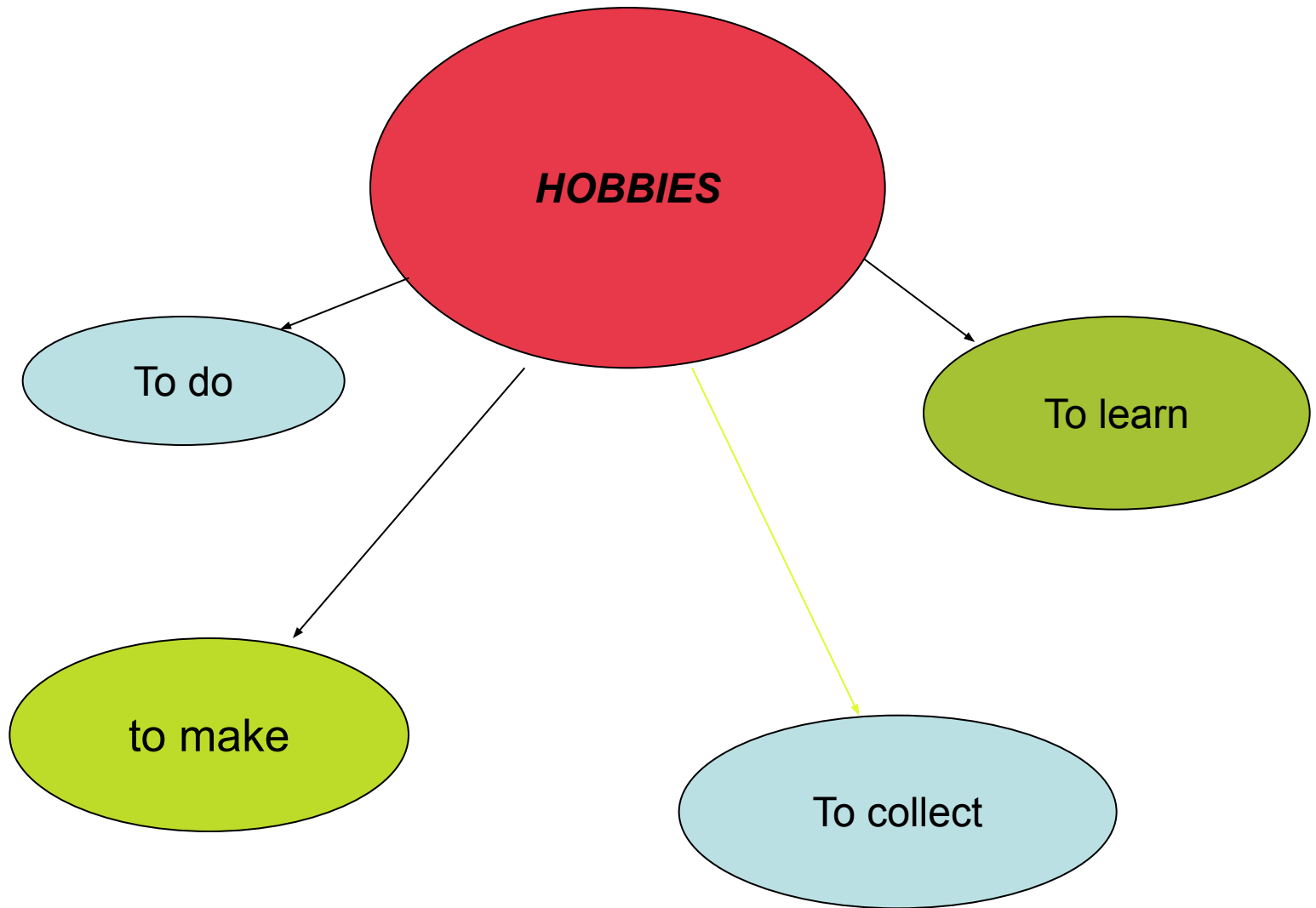

Hobby is something that people like to do in their free time:



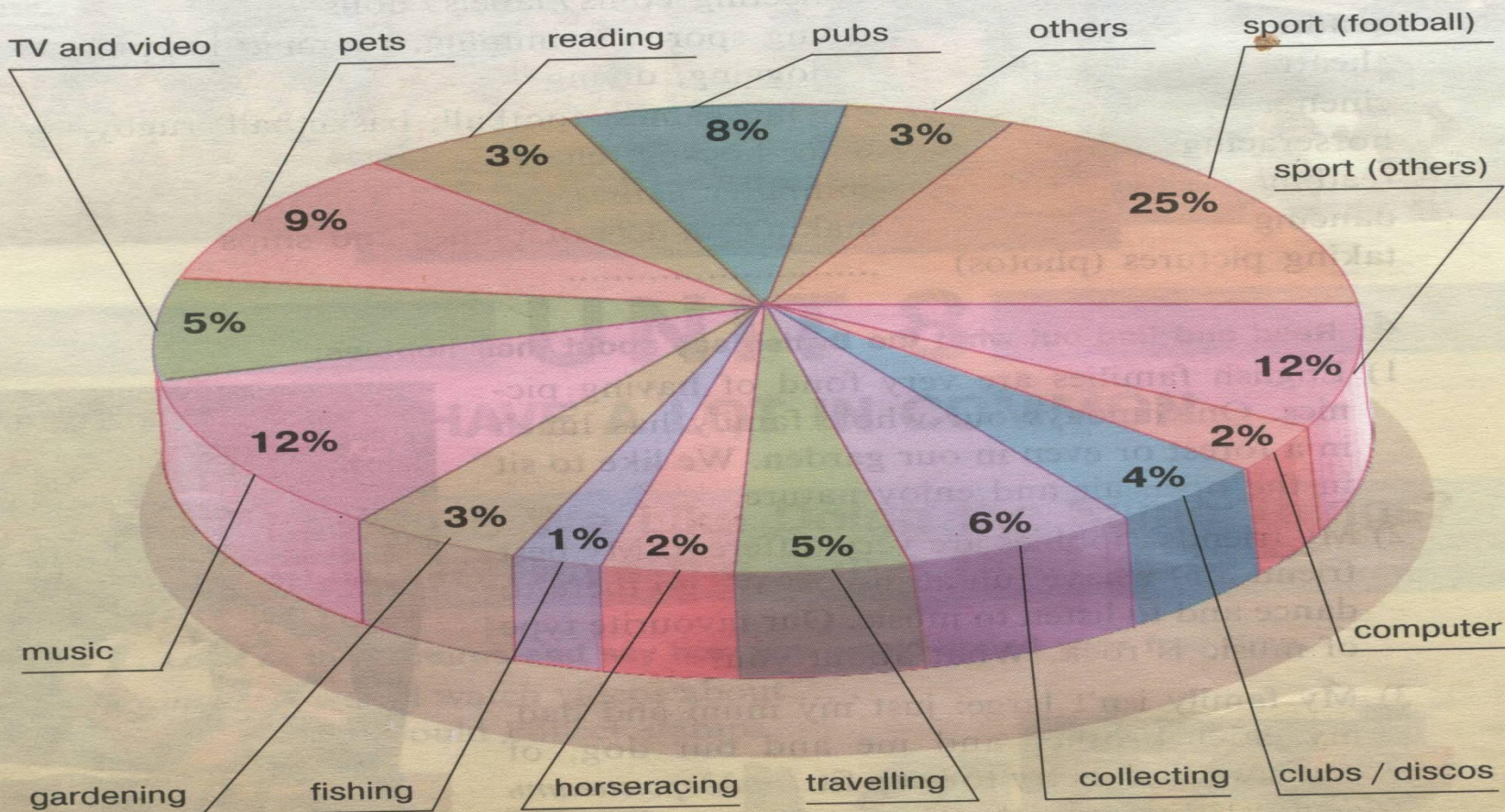
USEFUL LANGUAGE:

To learn	<p>Books, journals, programmes, Internet, museums, theatres</p>

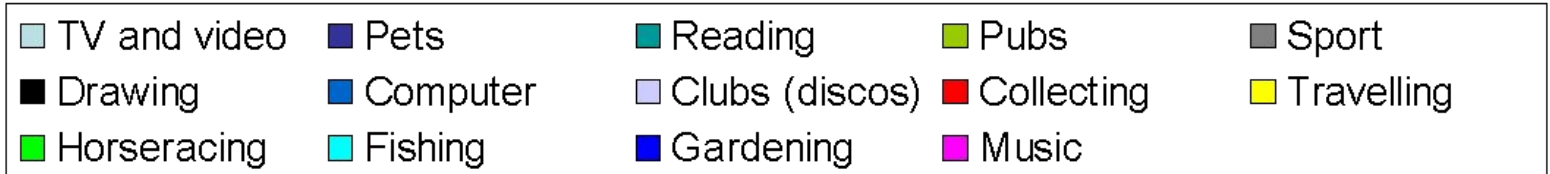
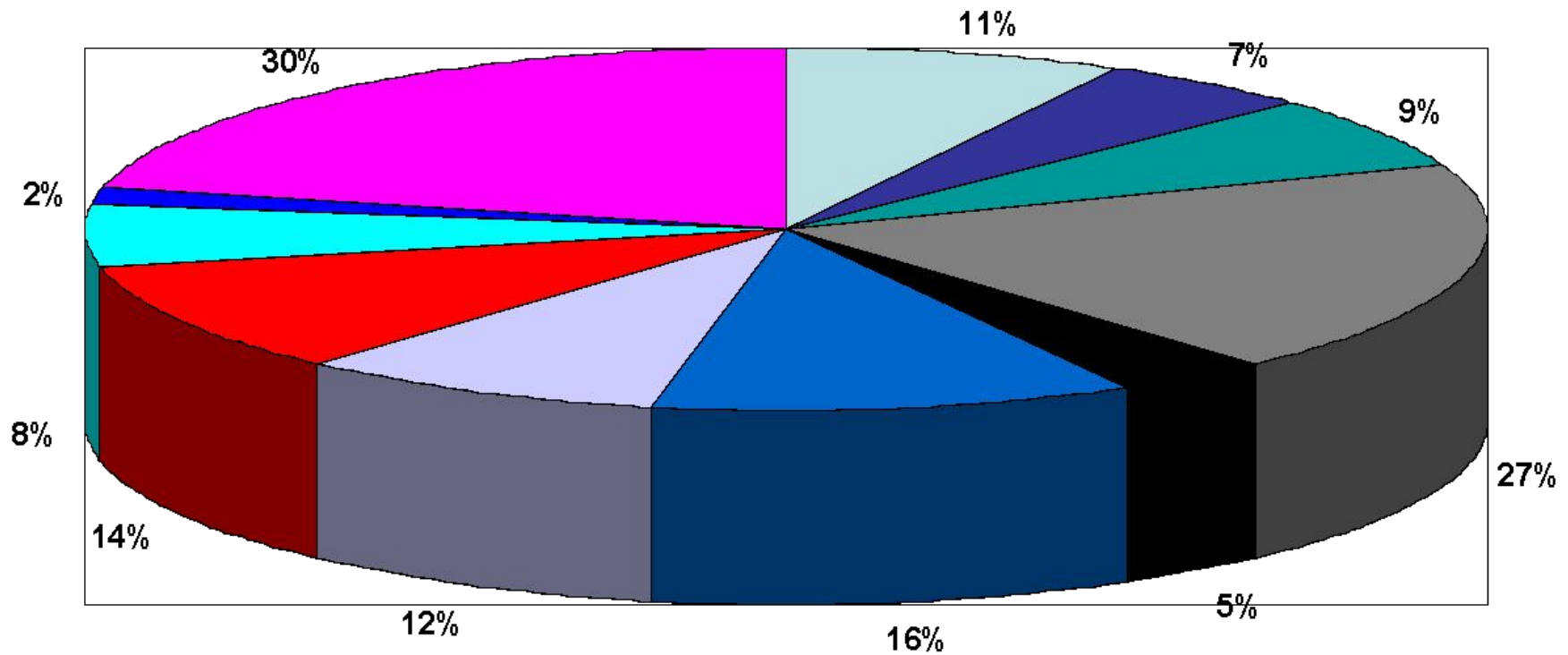
