As built a Stonehenge.

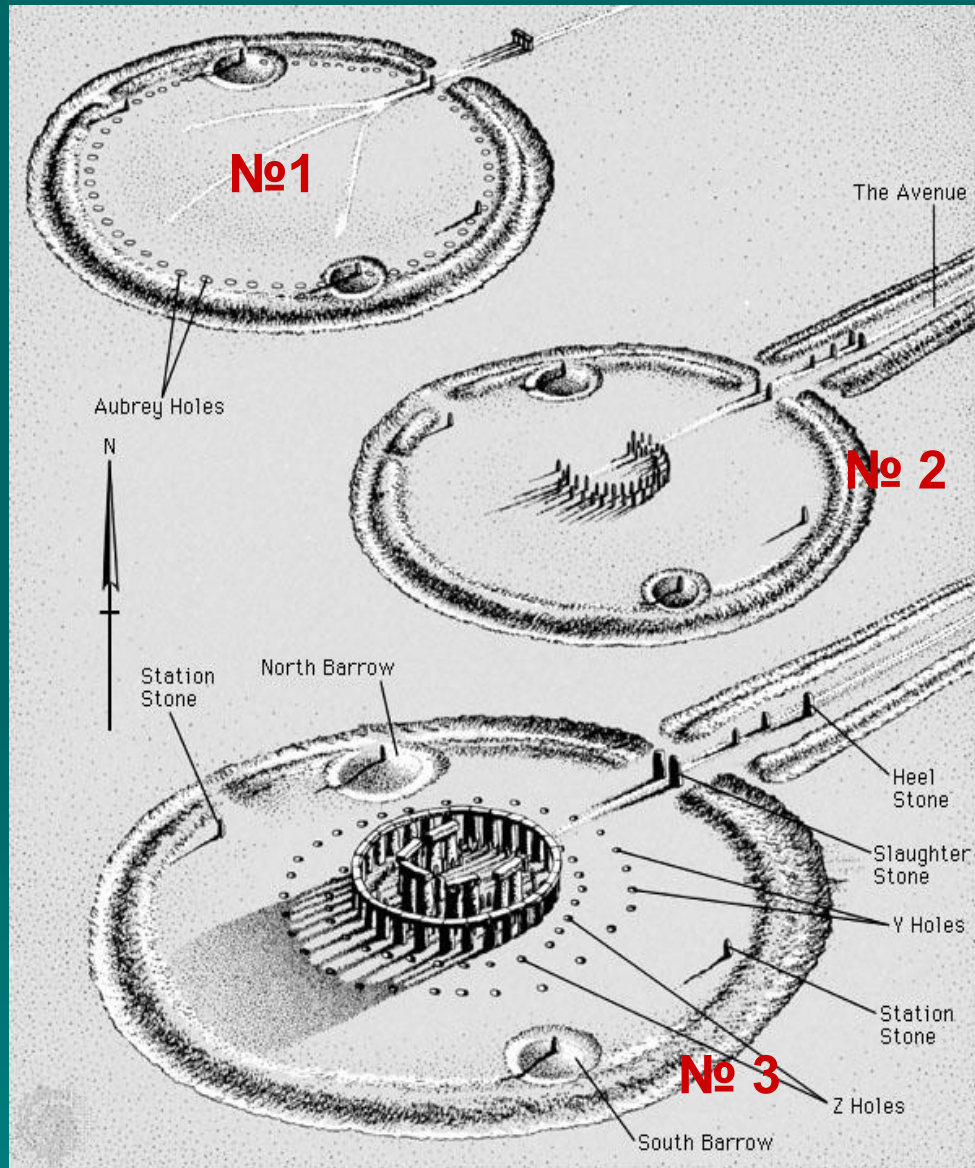
- Building of a Stonehenge occurred in some stages which have occupied in total over 2000.



Stonehenge. As it was.

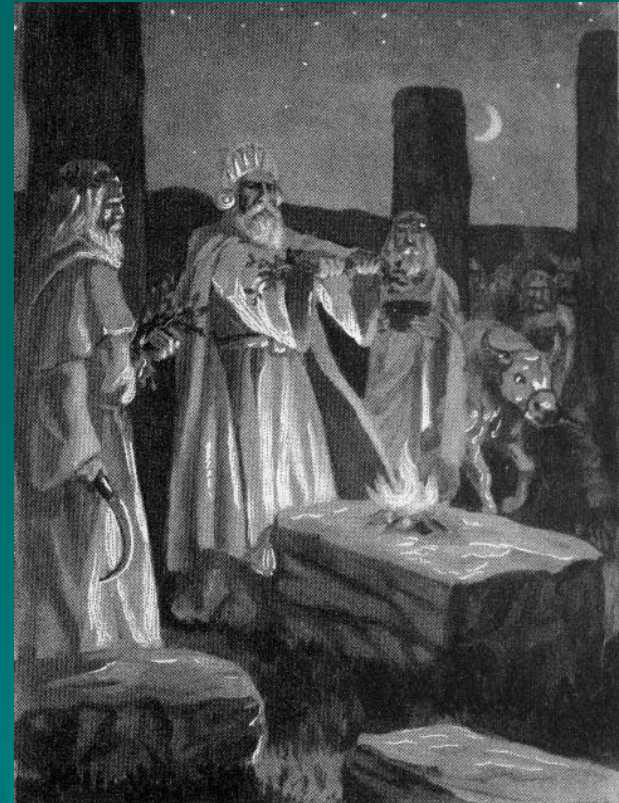


Periods of Stonehenge building.

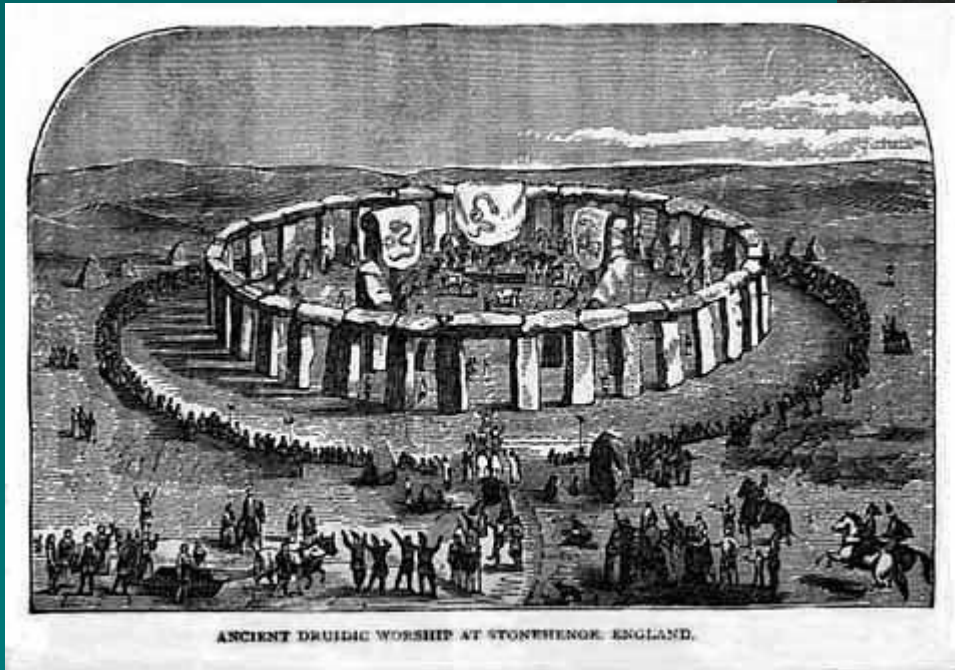


Who Built Stonehenge?

- The question who built Stonehenge is largely unanswered, even today.

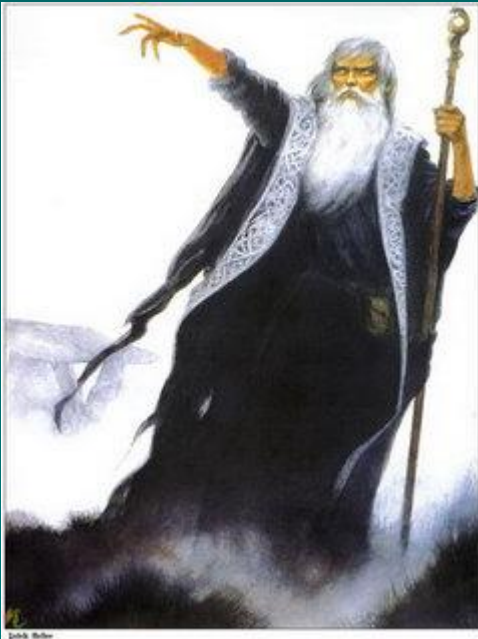


□ Neolithic period

- However the Stonehenge is also a huge layer of the legends, collecting centuries.



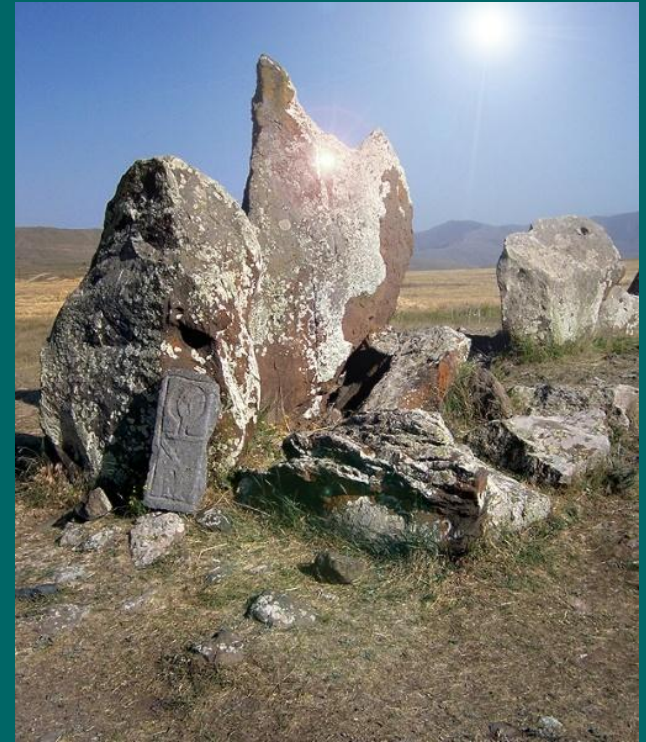
Zorats-Karer (karahundzh)



□ Zorats Karer ("Stones men"), also known as Karahunge - prehistoric complex, which may be called an Armenian Stonehenge".

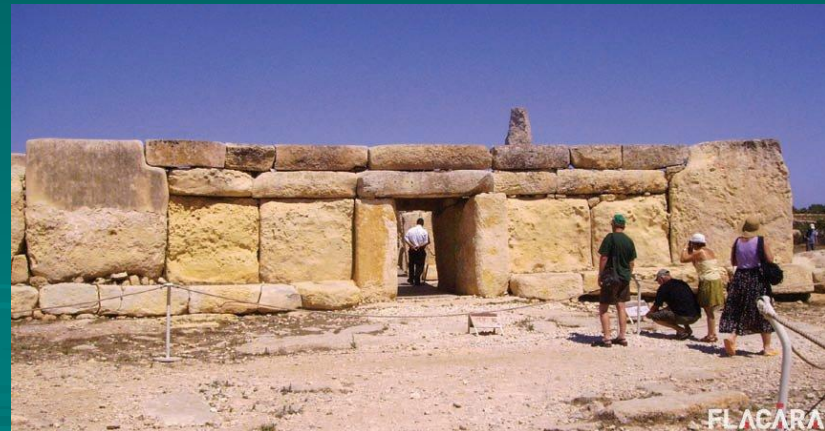


About 223 large stone tombs can be found in the area. It was explored by a team of archaeologists from the University of Munich who published their findings in 2000.



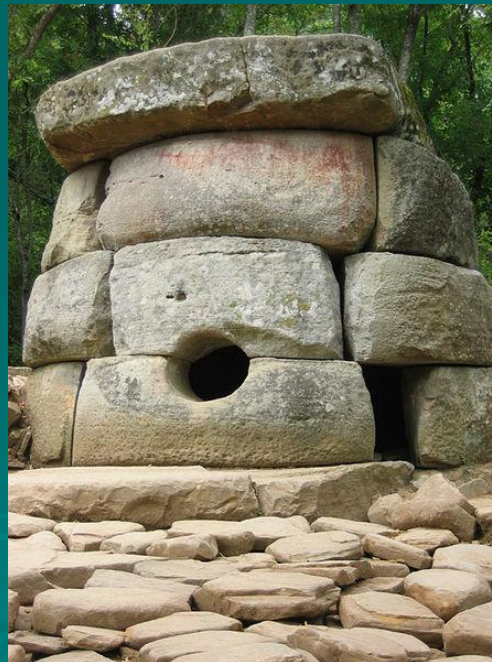
Stonehenge on Malta

- Mysterious megalithic sanctuaries in Malta, reminiscent of Stonehenge, are between the ages of 4-6 thousand years.



North Caucasus Dolmens.
