I have a dog,








Flowers.


Flowers here, flowers there, Flowers growing everywhere.






















Little Kate is only three, She must learn the ABC.

Four nuts for little Sue.










An Orange.

About the Queen.


Q is for questions









This is my rose. My rose is red. I like to watch roses In my flower - bed!

Do quick!"











Buses.

In the streets the buses run, Two by two, or one by one.
















Foxes.
