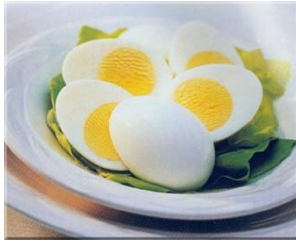

● Исключение:

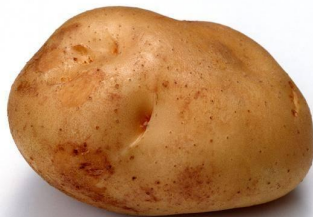
- Can I have **some** milk, please?
