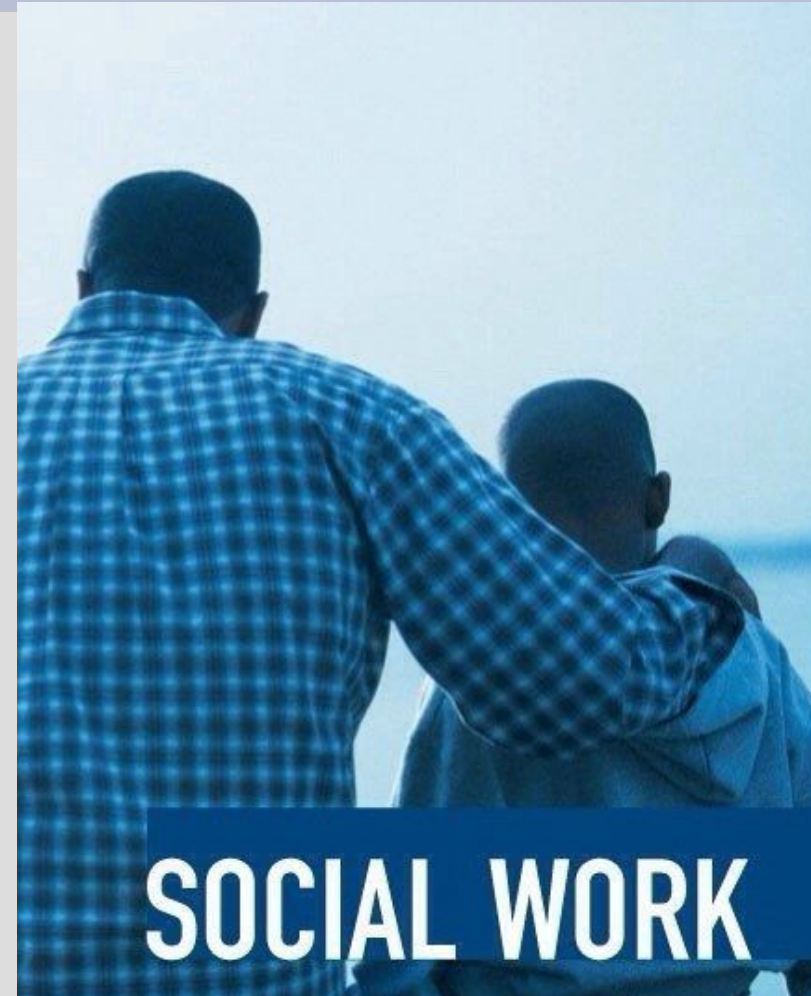
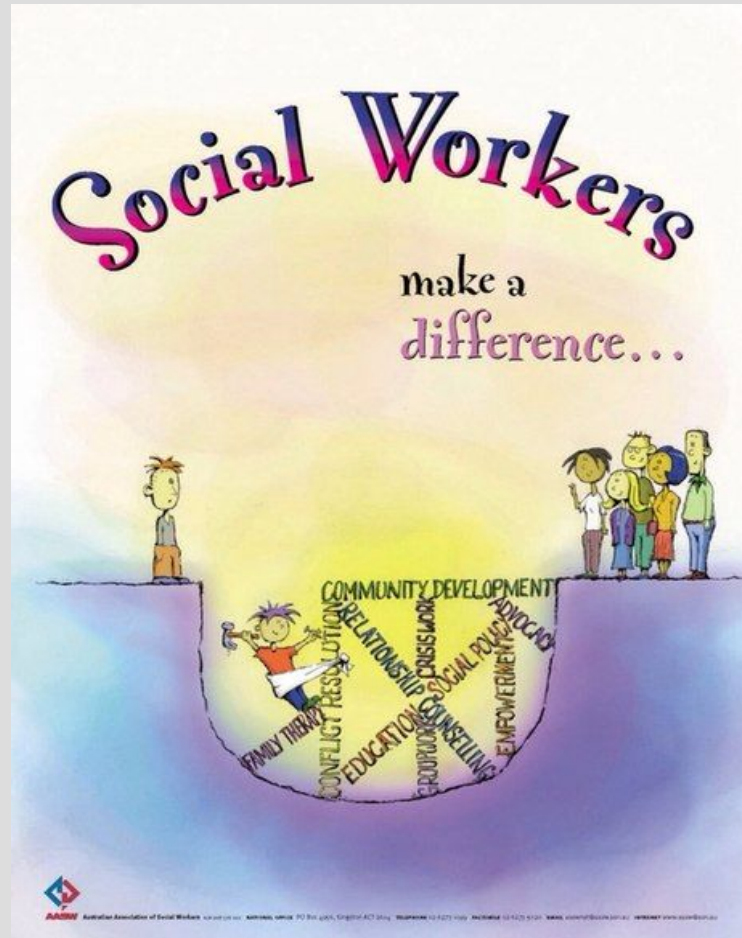
Deviant behavior (as a social deviation) - a behavior that deviates from the standard, the most common and well-established standards in certain communities in a certain period of their development.



Causes of deviant behavior



Socially-psychological characteristics of children and adolescents with behavioral problems as a specific social group may include: increased anxiety, cruelty, aggressiveness, conflicts.



Distribution deviancy among children and adolescents dictates the need for urgent measures for their socio - pedagogical support.
