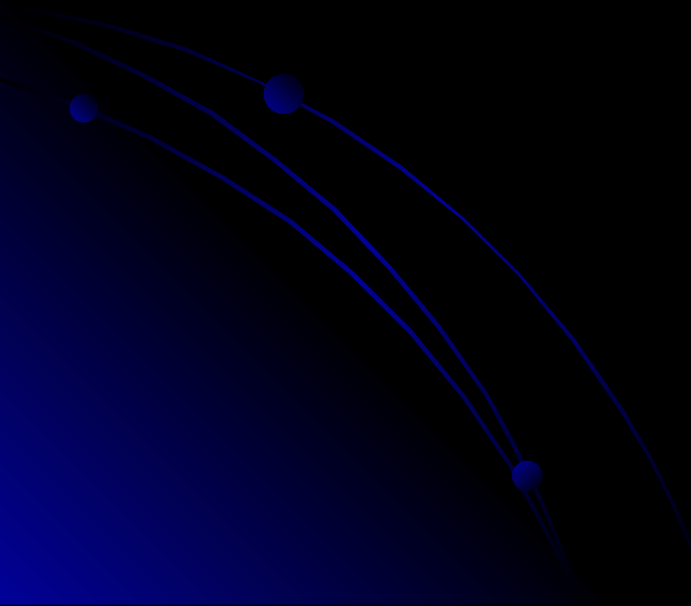


- *Satellite* - is an object, which has been placed into orbit by human endeavor.

Artificial satellites.

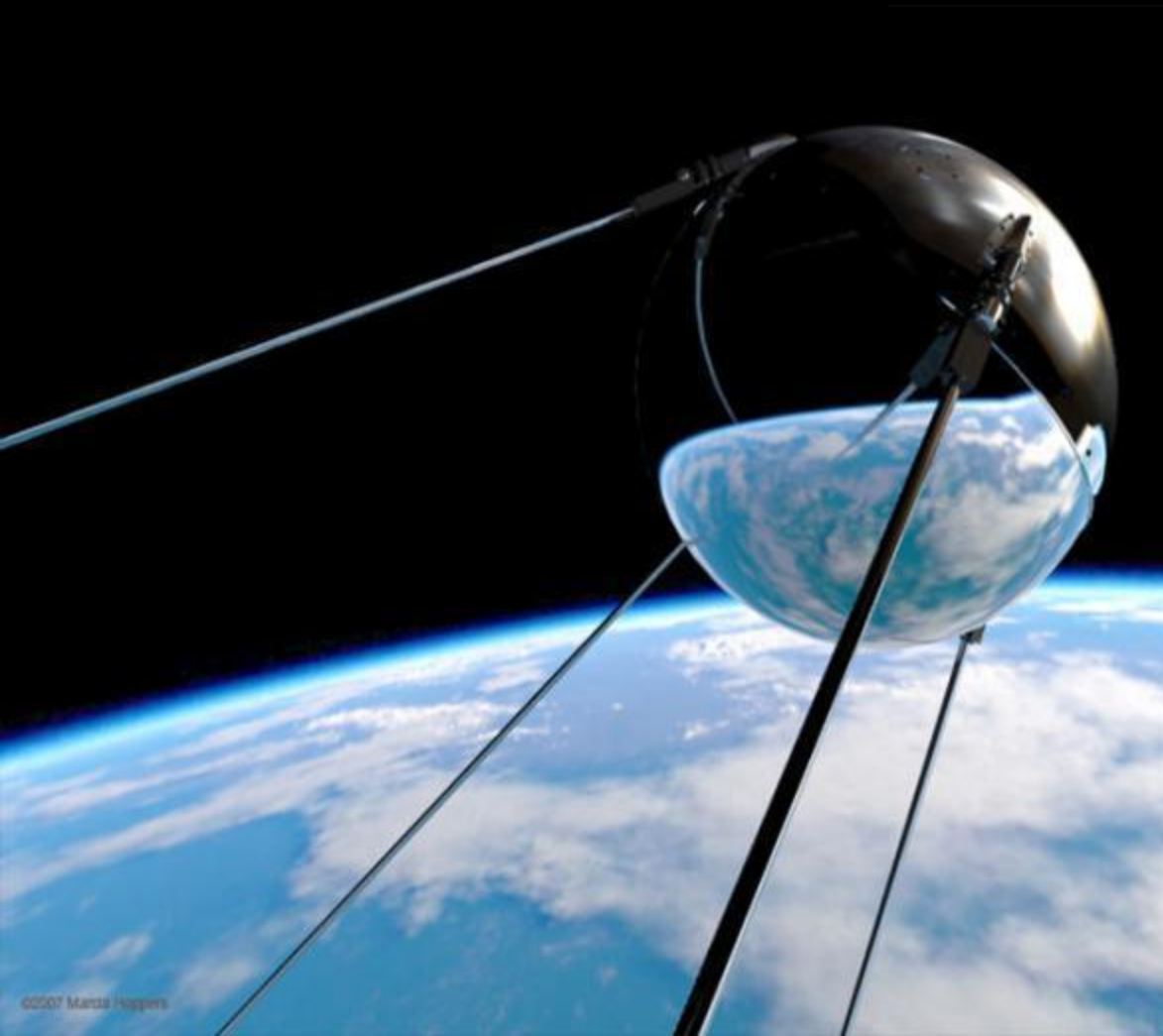
- Sputnik 1.

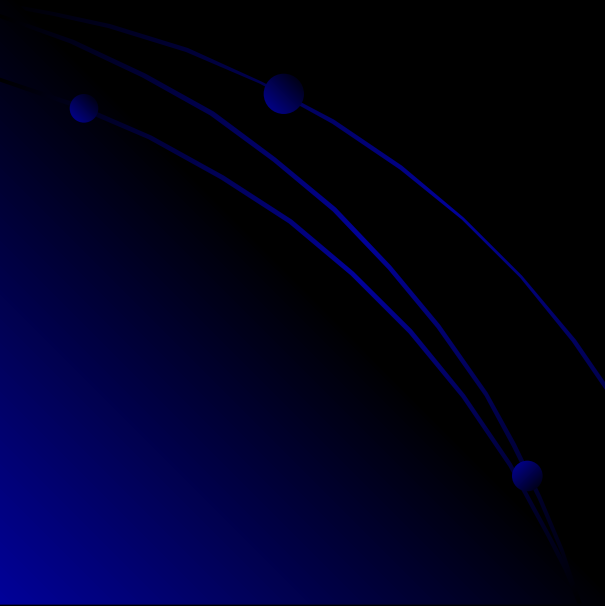
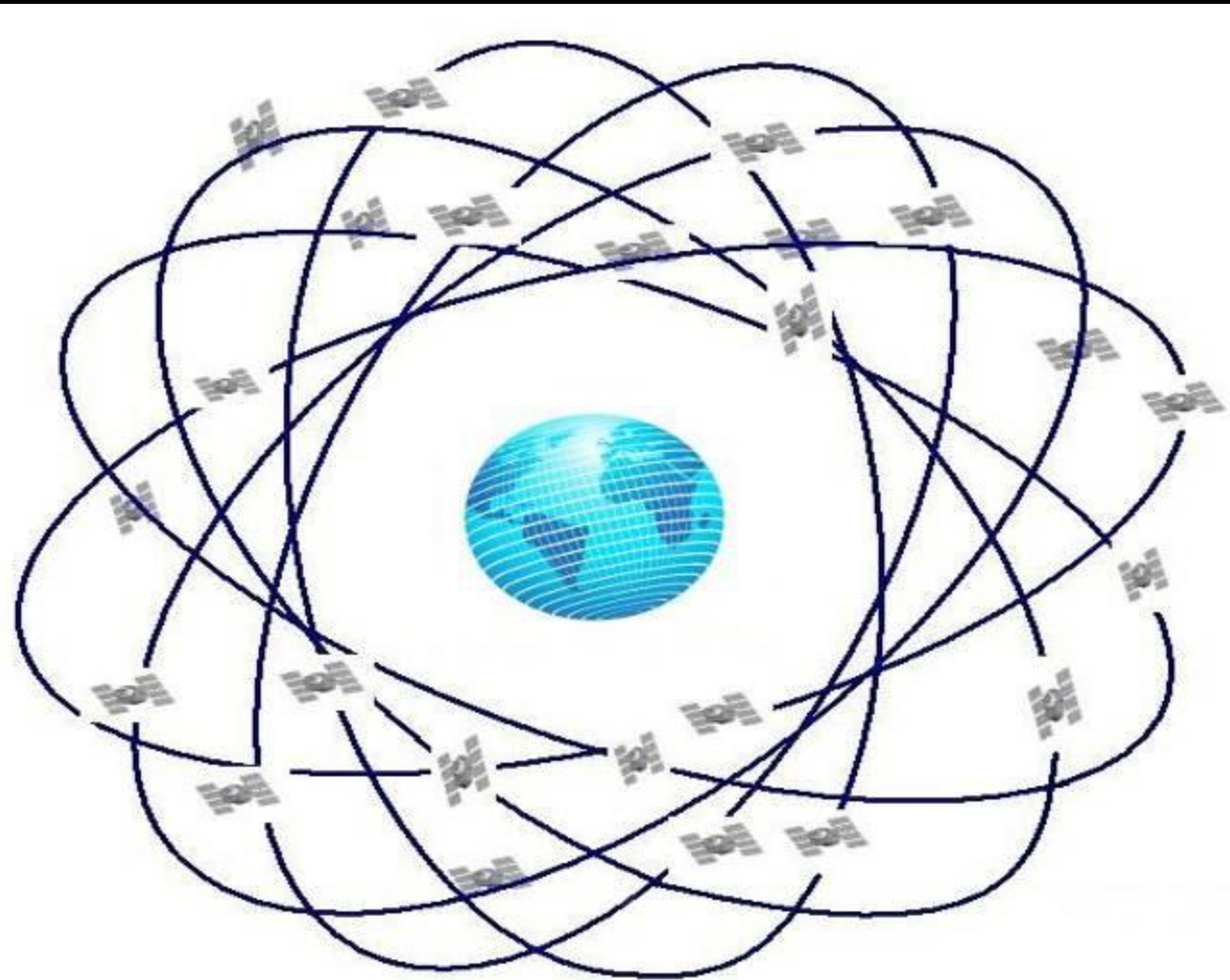


The first artificial satellite was Sputnik 1.
