

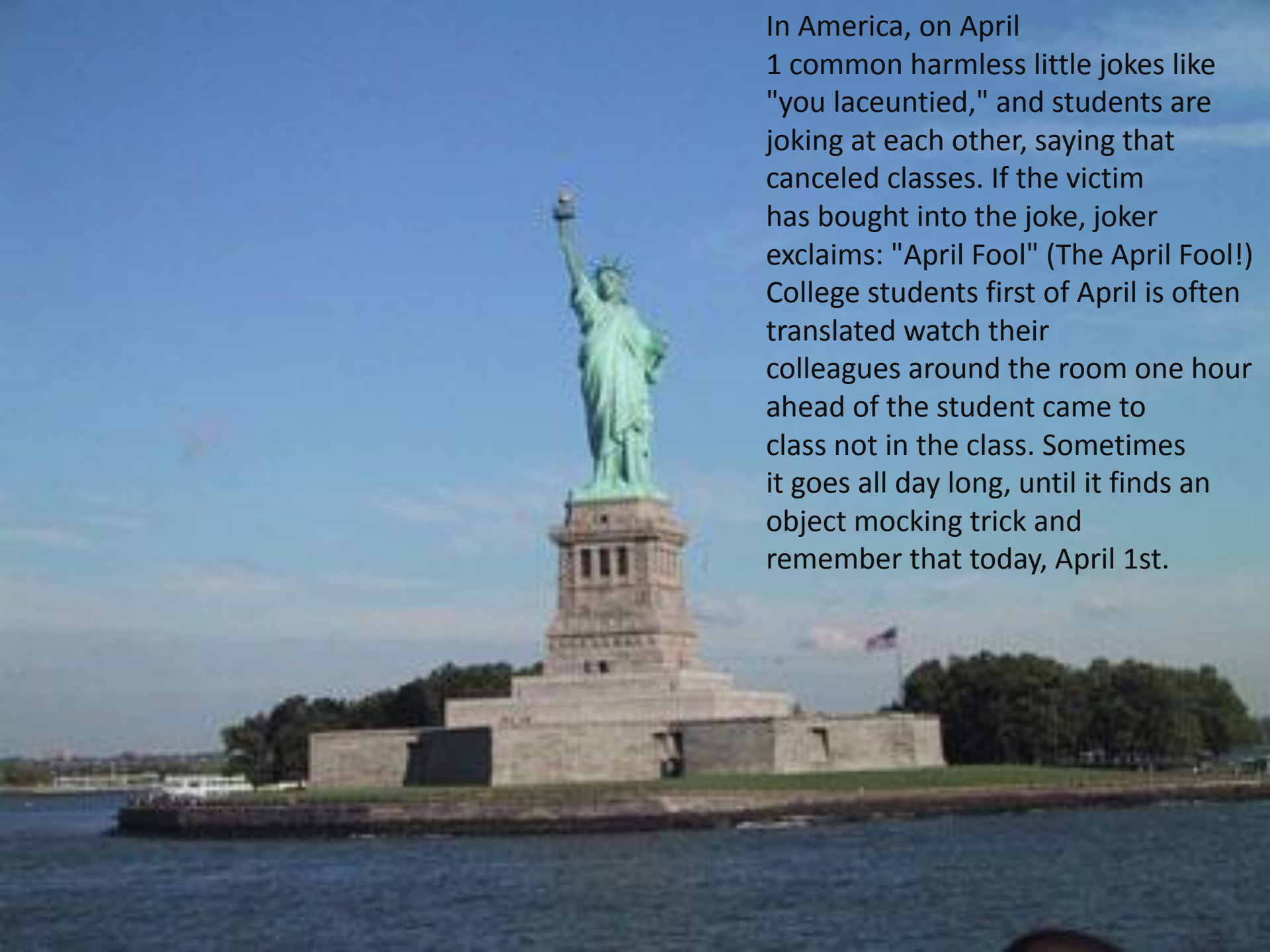


All Fool's Day

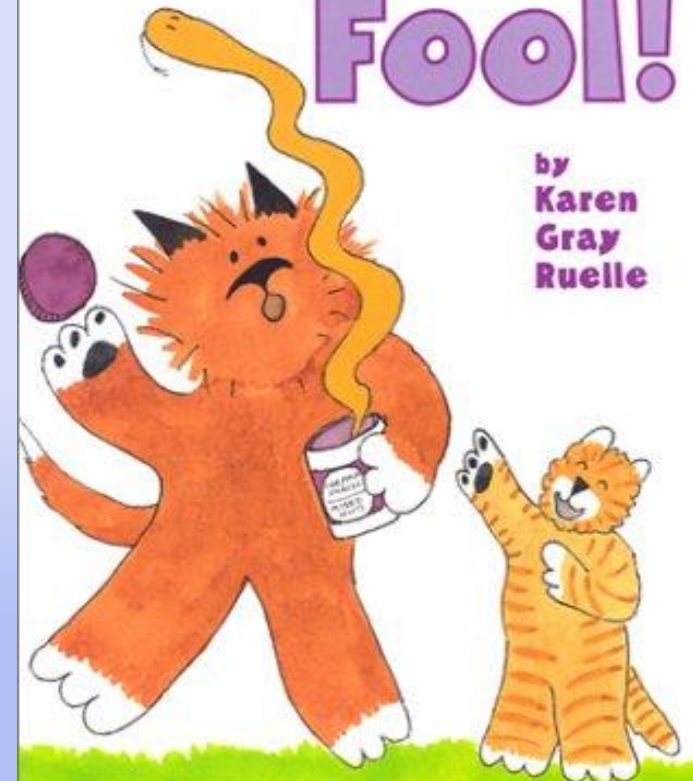
