

Sculptural composition "Robinson, Friday, and a dog." Fountain. In the second book of travels Robinsor Daniel Defoe sent his hero in the capital of Siberia: Tobolsk.



#### **Art Museum**



The exhibition presents the church and secular art, art carving. Is part of Tobolsk State Historical-Architectural Museum-Reserve.

#### **Prison Lock**

Transit-convict prison of the XIX century, which contained M. Petrashevsky, F. Dostoyevsky, N. Chernyshevsky, Vladimir Korolenko, and many others. Used until the end of XX century. Now here is the repository of museum funds. According to preliminary applications are guided tours.



#### **Monument Mendeleev**



Monument to the famous chemist who was born in a. Upper Aremzyany and up to 15 years who lived in Tobolsk and Aremzyanah, installed in early prospect of elements.
