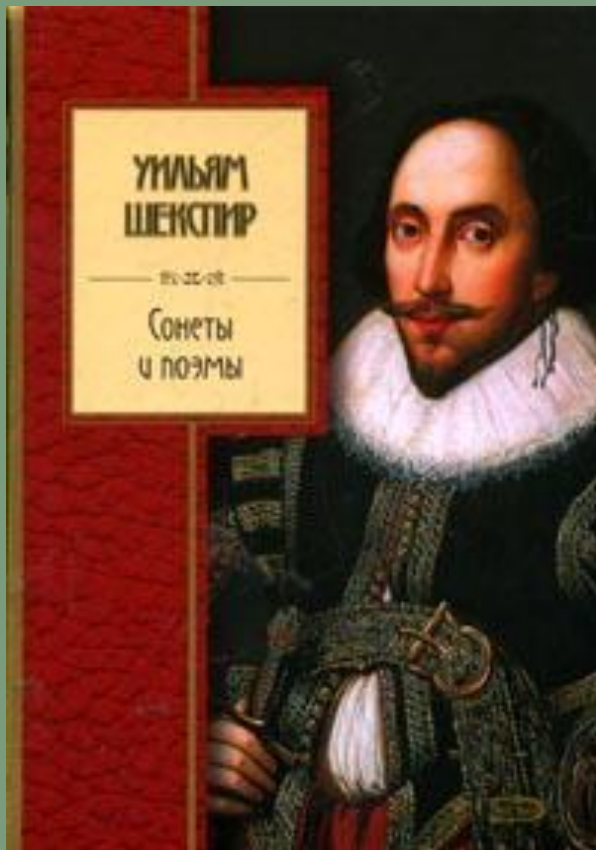

# Шекспир Уильям

(23 апреля 1564 года – 23 апреля 1616 года)



The name of **William Shakespeare** is known all over the world. The last half of the 16-th and the beginning of the 17-th centuries are known as the Golden Age of English Renaissance and sometimes are called 'The Age of Shakespeare'.



*Shakespeare was born on April 23, 1564 in Stratford - on - Avon.*

*His father was a dealer in corn, meat, wool.*

*William's mother was a daughter of a rich farmer in the village of Wilmcote.*

*Being 18 years old, William married Anne Hathaway, who was 9 years older than himself. They had a daughter Susanna and twins - son Hamnet and daughter Judith.*

**People often call Shakespeare 'Our National Bard', 'The Immortal Poet of Nature'**

- In 1567 *Shakespeare* went to *London* to find a job, where he began writing plays staged at the *Globe Theatre*. By 1592, he had been an important member of a well - known acting company of *London*.

- Only in 1611, at the height of his fame, Shakespeare returned to Stratford, where in April 23, 1616 he died. He was buried in a fine old church in Stratford.





end*

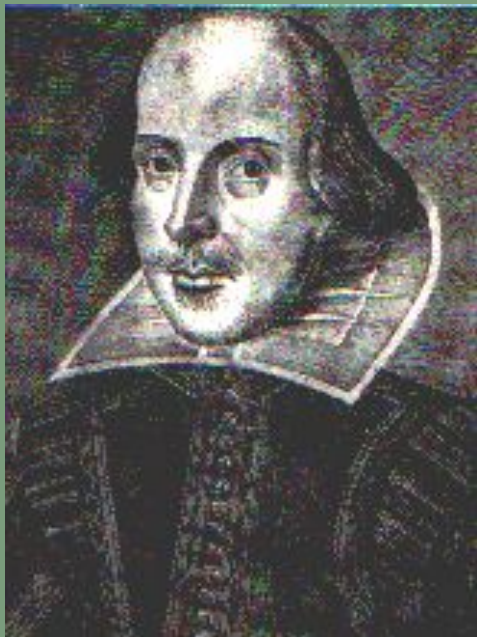
*The heart – ache, and the thousand natural
