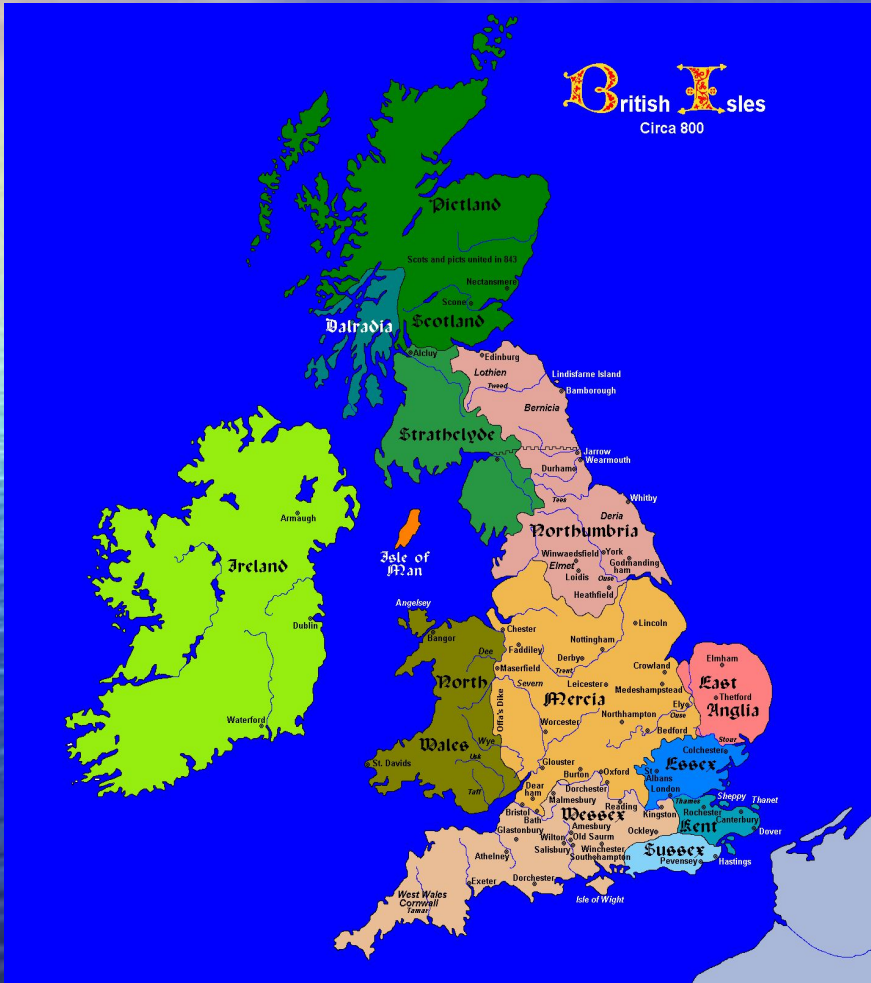
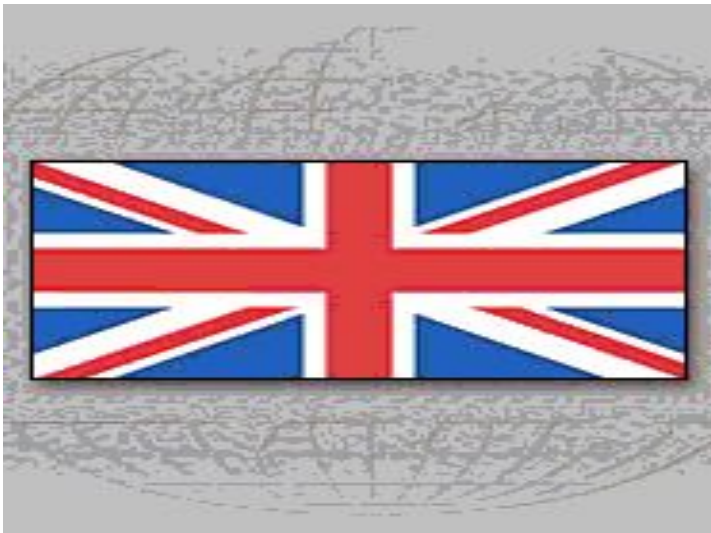


British Isles

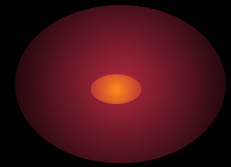
Buckingham Palace
