- Monetary authority of a country granted the exclusive privilege to lend a government its currency.

Main functions

- controlling money supply
- money issuance
- setting the official interest rate
- implementing monetary policy

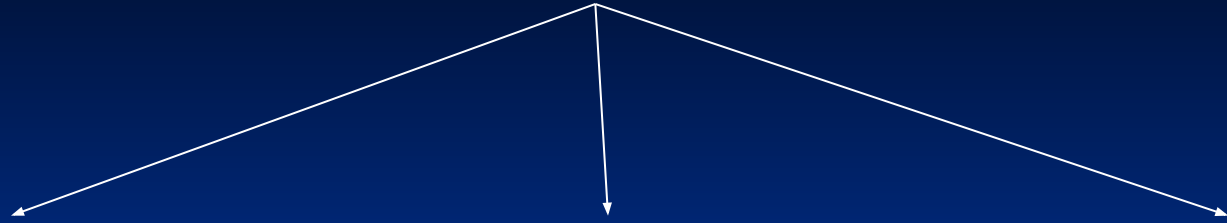
Currency issuance



- Exclusive privilege of a central bank



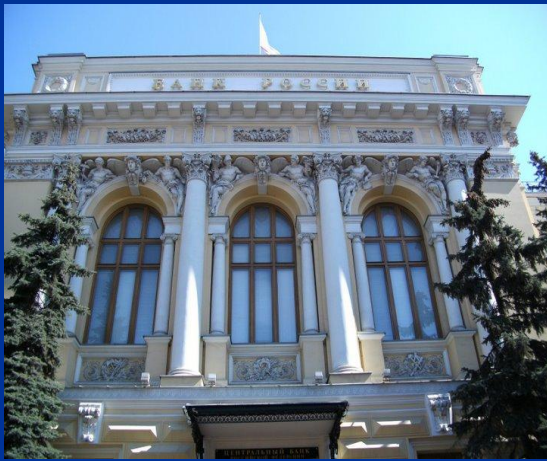
Examples of naming

Reserve bank of



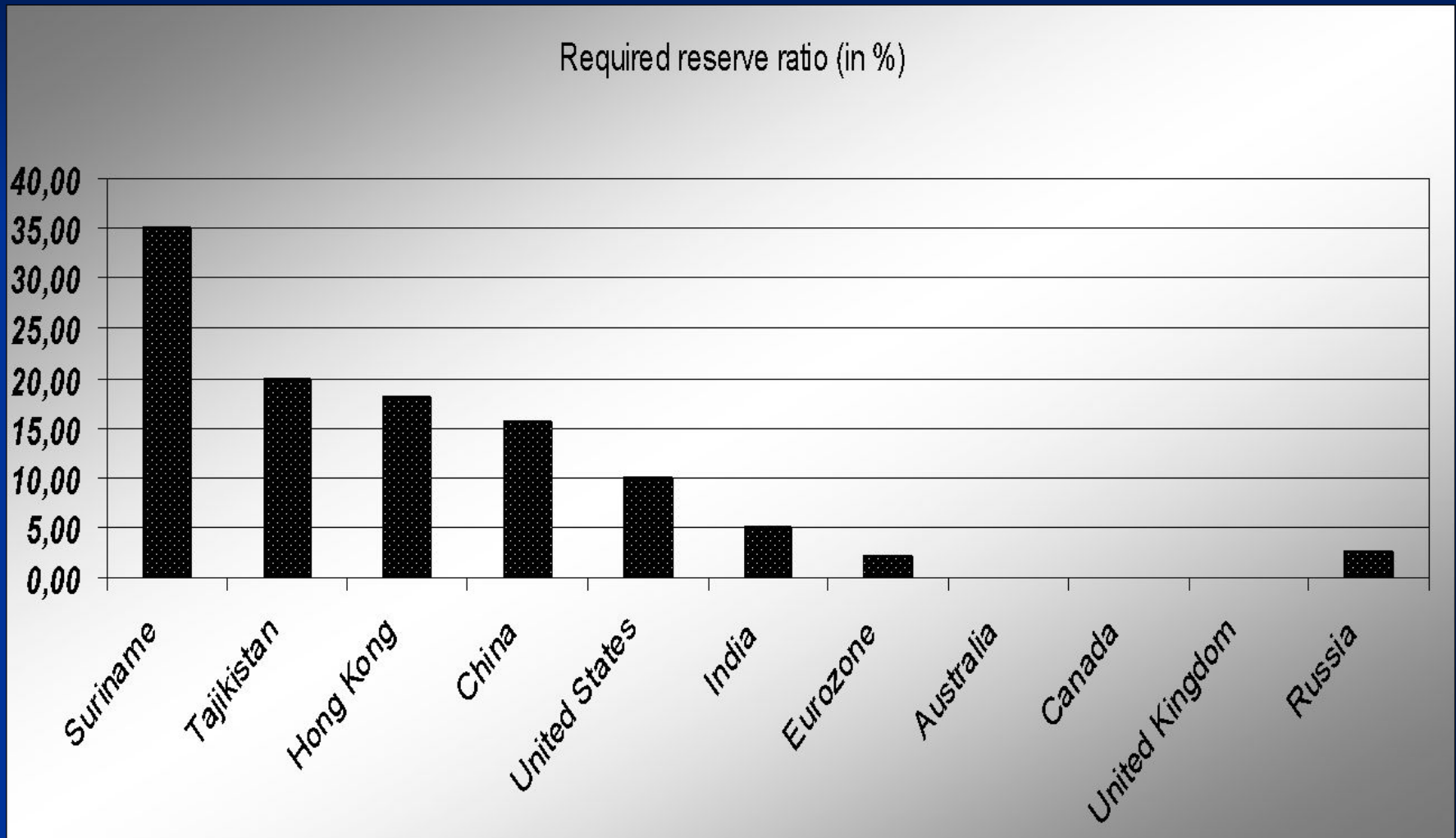
Main policy instruments

- Open market operations
- Reserve require ratio
- Discount rate policy

Open market operations

- Do not require the immediate printing of new currency
- Most frequently used tool of central bank

Required reserve ratio



Discount rate policy

- Affect the balance between demand and supply
- Taken into account before starting business
