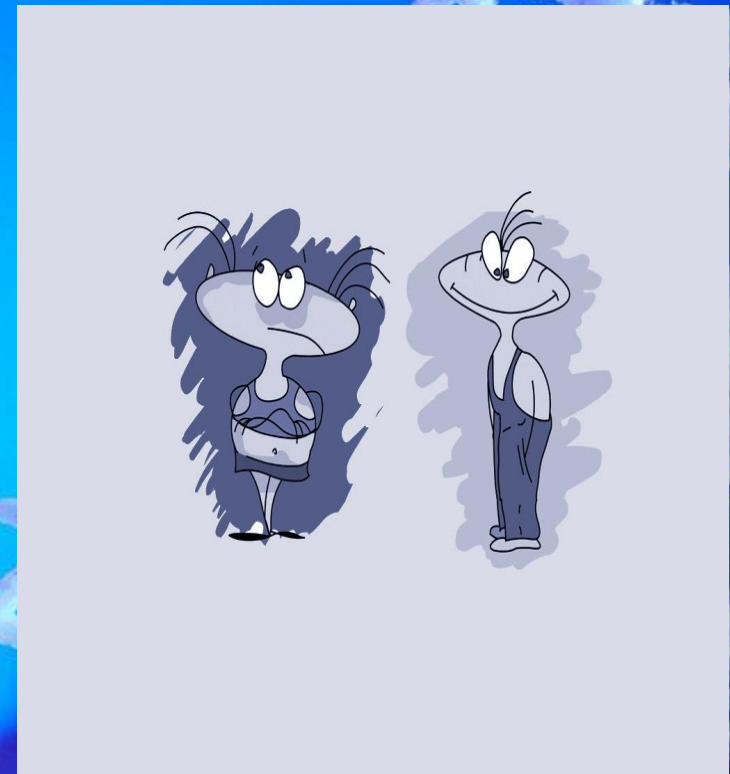
ЦЕЛЬ
