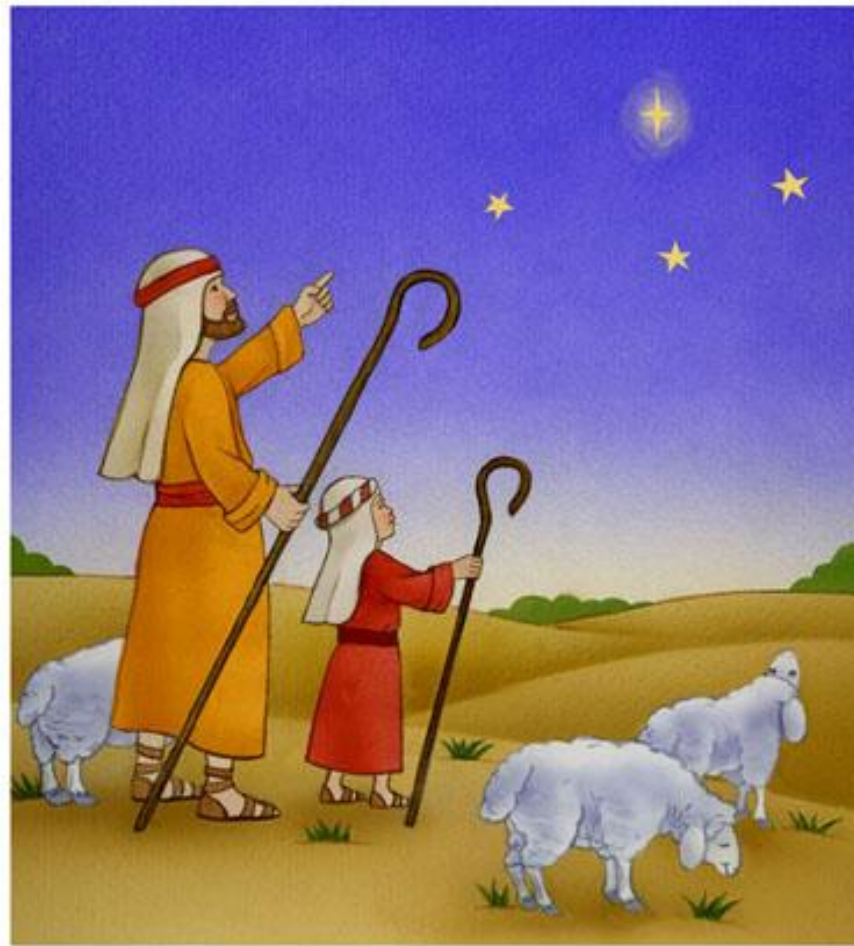

* This Carol unless an interesting point is an instance of that Handel collected 114 English carols in England and in each country 500 or 2000. In this instance the words of the text in the same degree of the period last would be a team with a melody more than a hundred repetitions of the four phrases each one which freely altered of an old French Chanson de Noël. This would be quite a common style of the time - if Handel's manuscript 118 was so called a year. In these circumstances I am justified in restoring the melody to its original complete form making a note of Handel's words to all the original notes above. 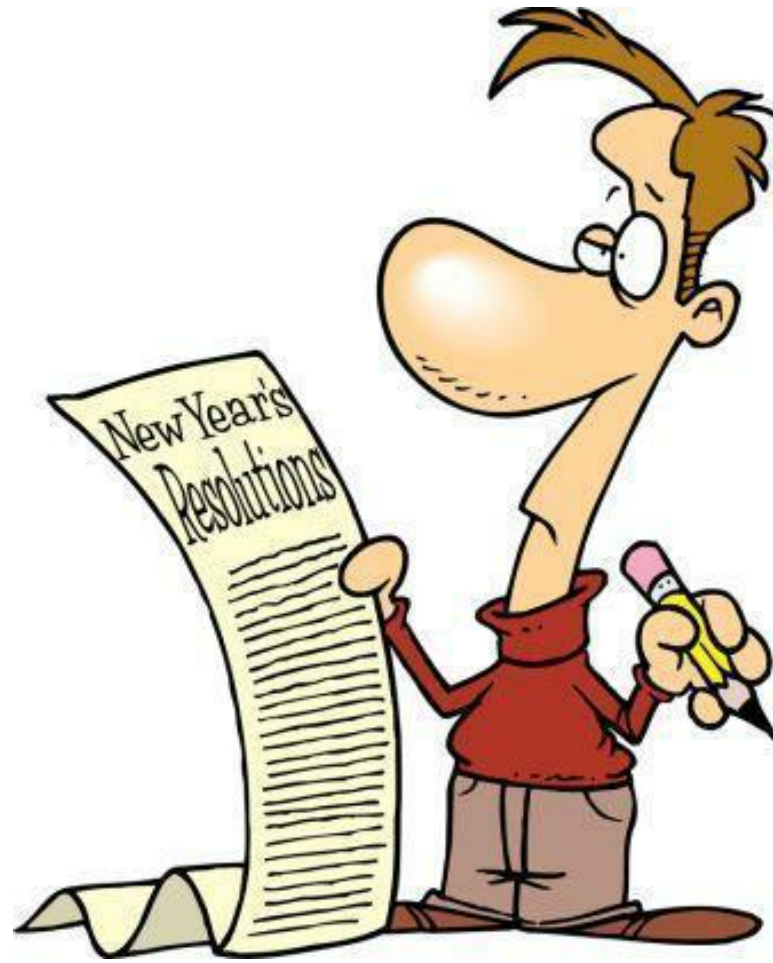
