## утвердительные предложения

Единственное число	Множественное число
<b>I play football.</b>	<b>We play football.</b>
<b>You play football.</b>	<b>You play football.</b>
<b>He/she/It plays</b> <b>football.</b>	<b>They play football.</b>



# Отрицательные предложения

Полная форма	Краткая форма
I <b>do not play</b> tennis.	I <b>don` t play</b> tennis.
You <b>do not play</b> tennis.	You <b>don` t play</b> tennis.
He/She/It <b>does not play</b> tennis.	He/She/It <b>doesn` t play</b> tennis.
We/You/They <b>do not play</b> tennis.	We/You/They <b>don` t play</b> tennis.

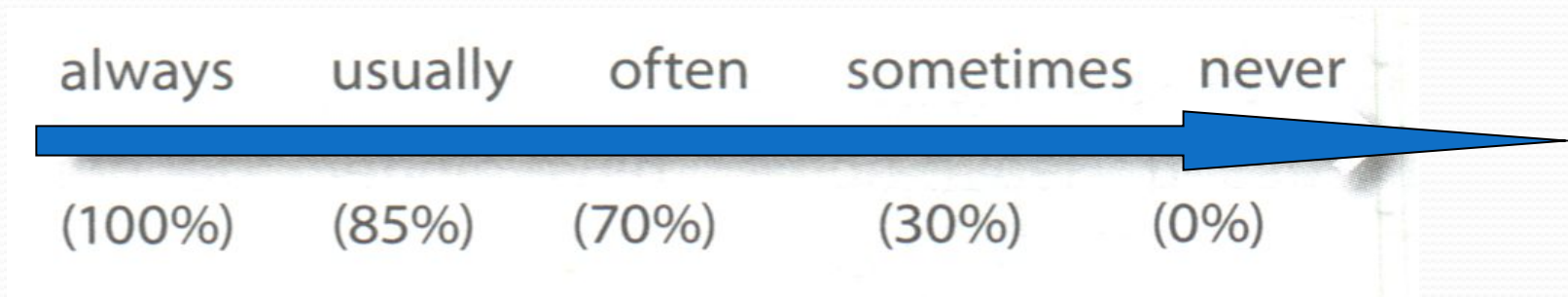
