Edinburgh



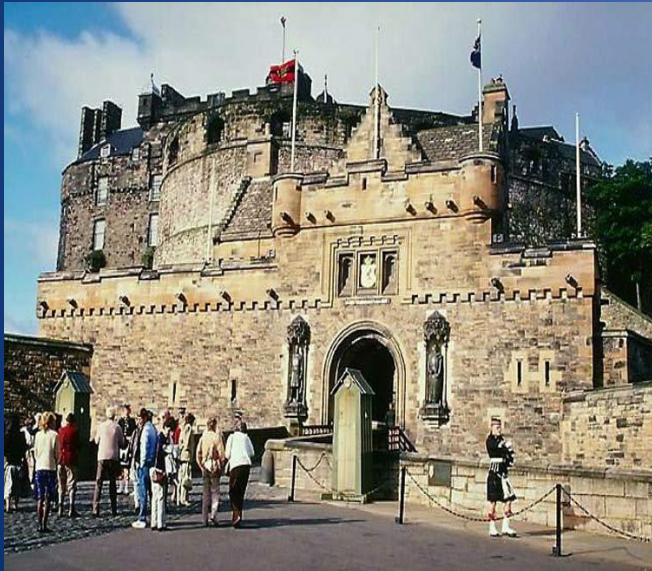
One of the oldest and most beautiful cities in the world. It has a lot of interesting places to see.

- *There is also the National Gallery of Modern Art.*





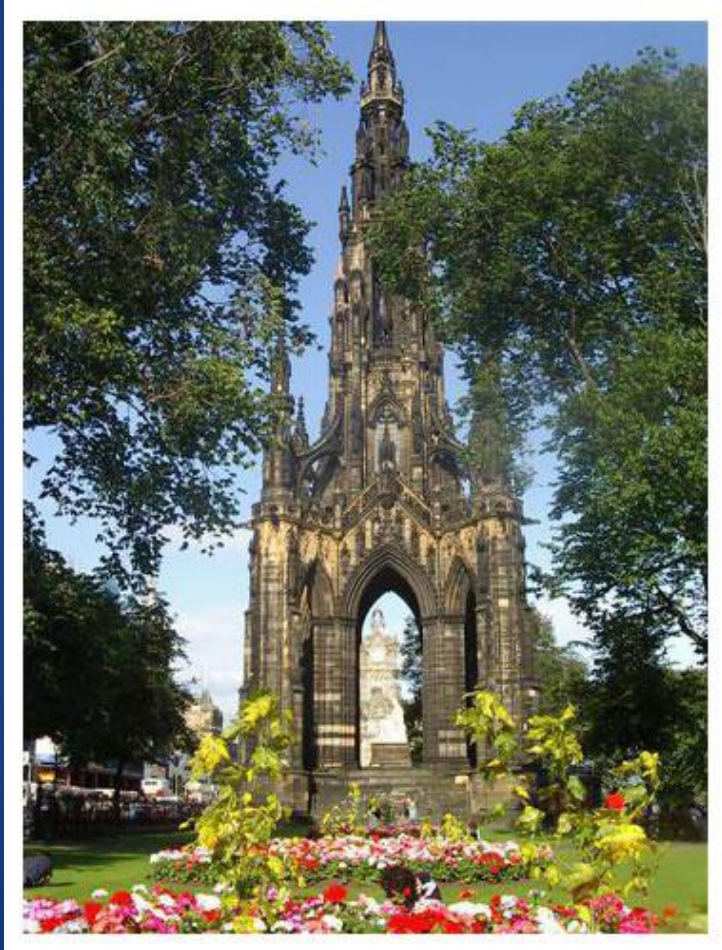
The Royal Museum is interesting with its Science Zone. 1888 year
