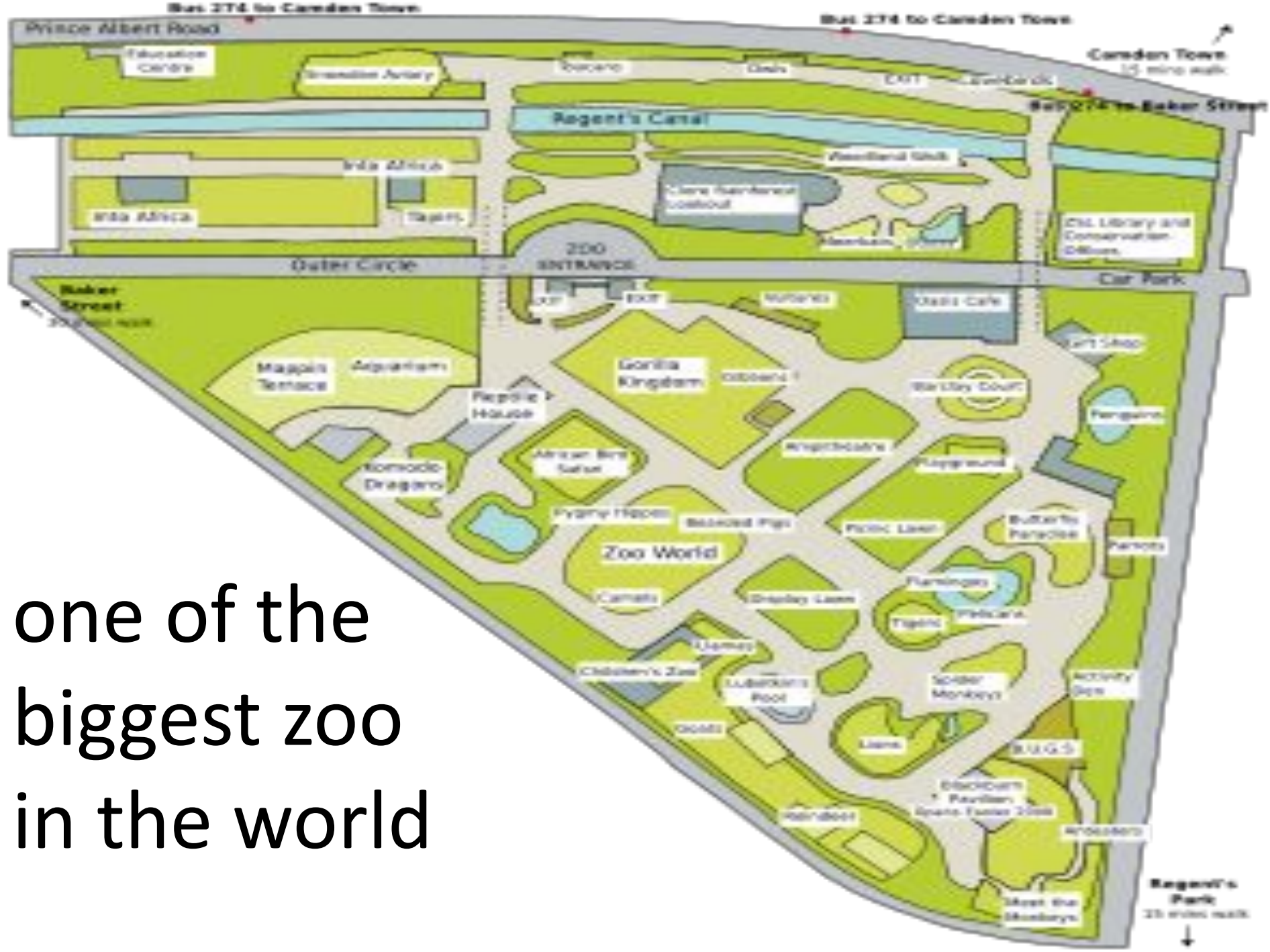

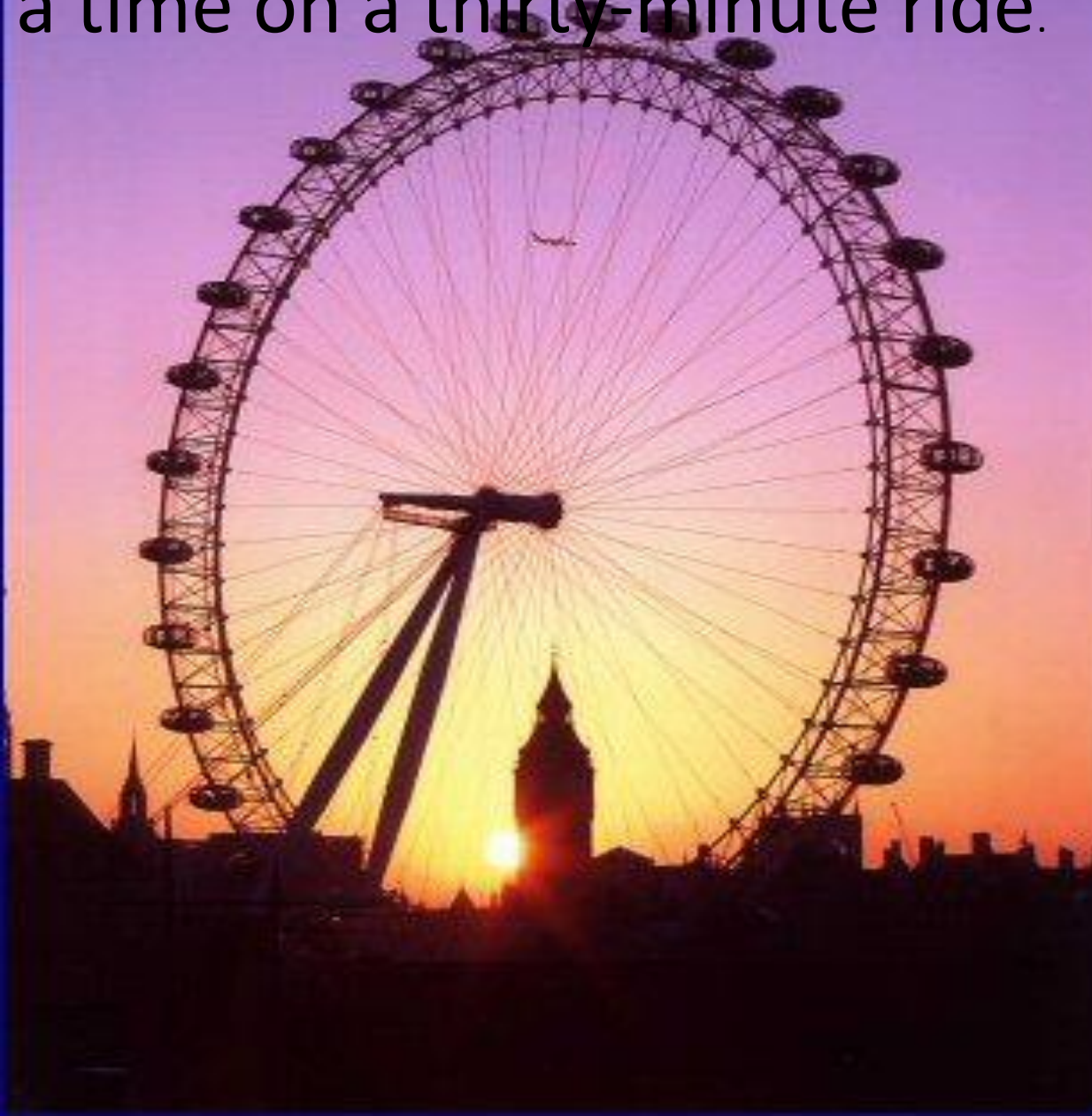




The London Eye is the largest observation wheel in the world.
