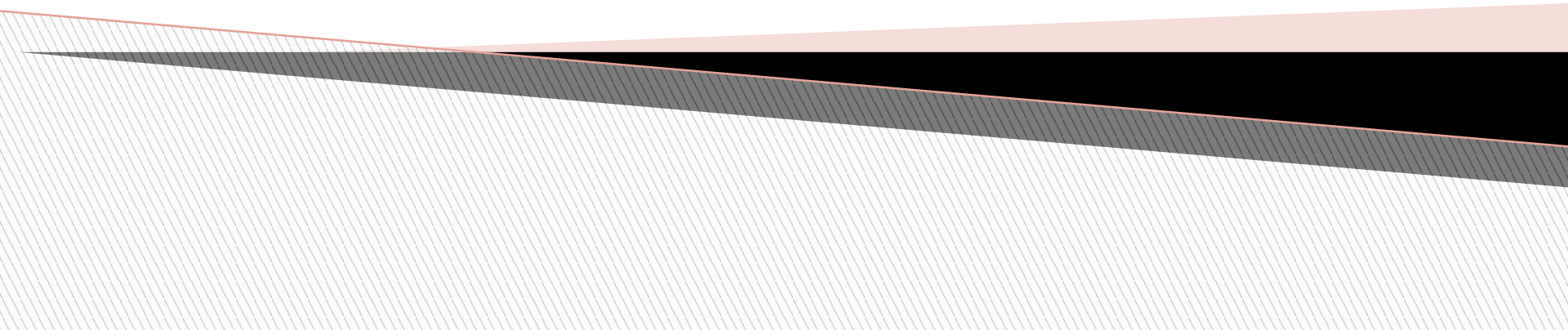




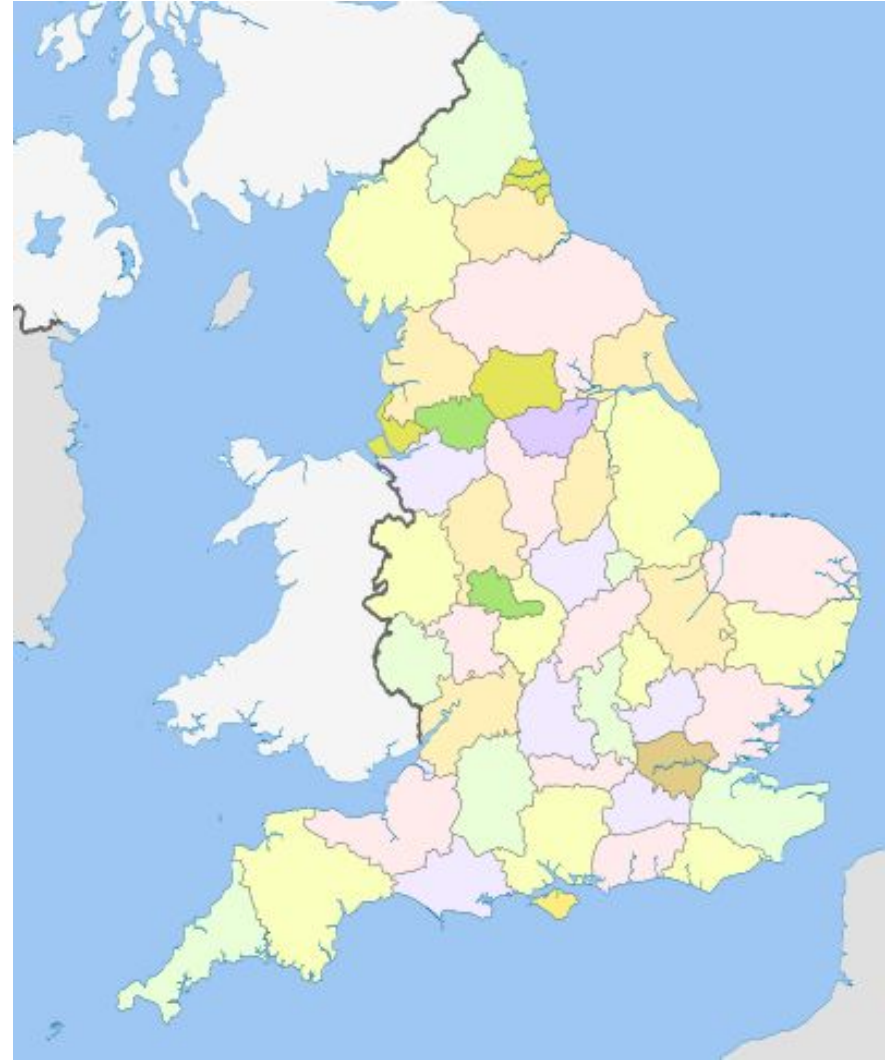
ENGLAND

- The population of England is about 50 million people.

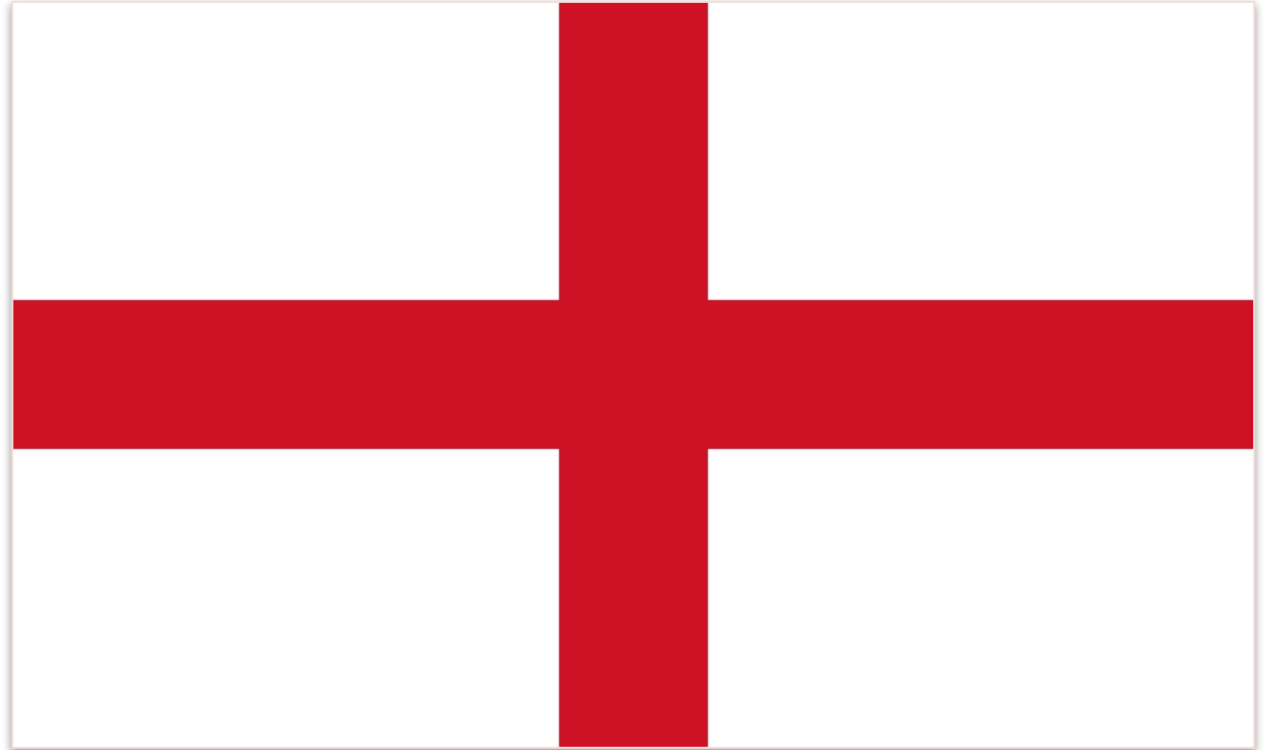


National symbols of England

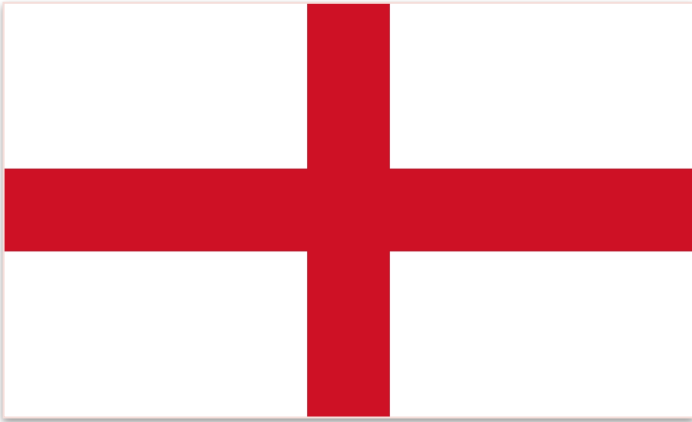
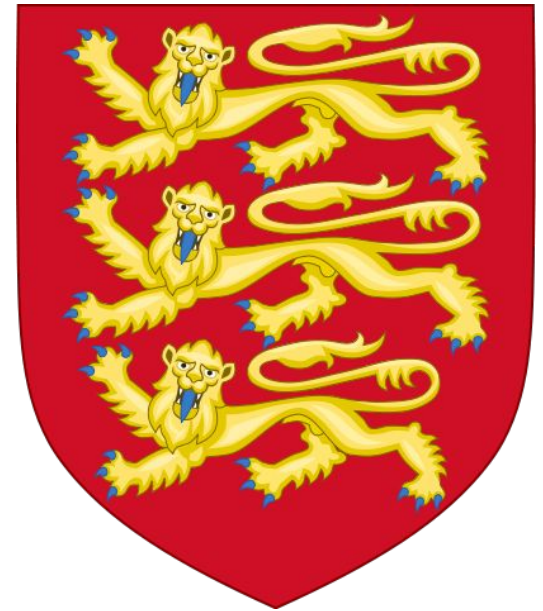
God save our gracious Queen,

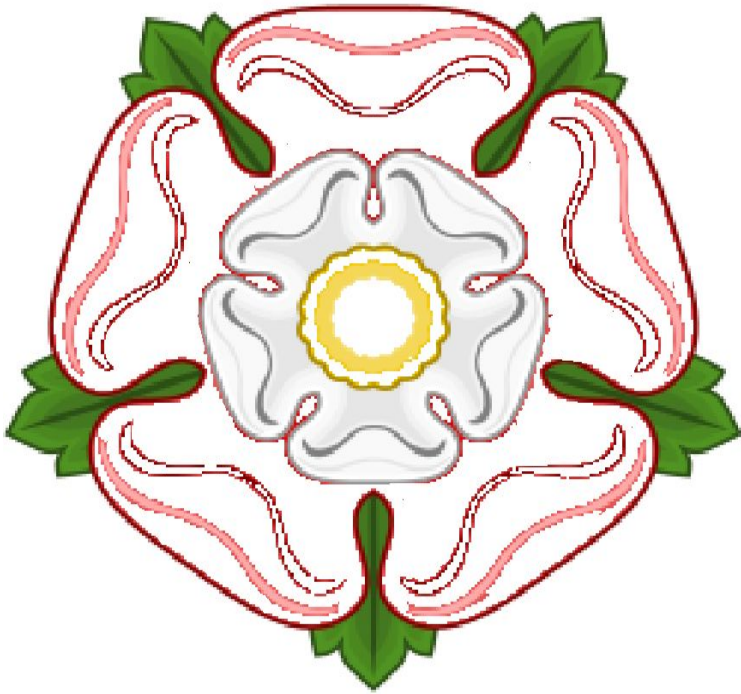
