# COMPARISON OF ADJECTIVES

## Степени сравнения прилагательных.

Eg. big, small, old, new, lovely, etc.

**Три степени сравнения:**

The positive degree -положительная

The comparative degree -сравнительная

The superlative degree -превосходная

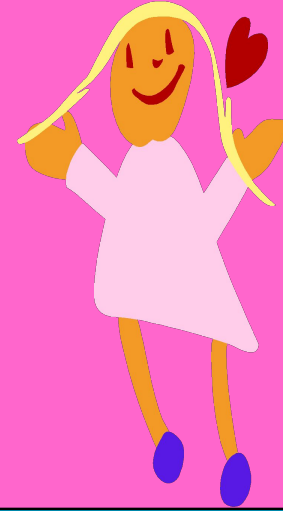
Пре́восходная степень употребляется с артиклем - **the**



# EXAMPLES

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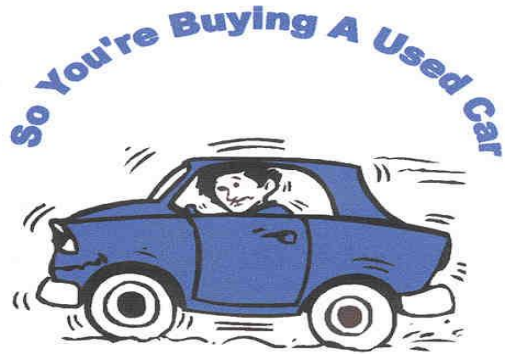
Sally is a **tall** girl.

Nelly is **taller** than Sally.

Kelly is **the tallest** girl in their class.

# OTHER EXAMPLES

This is a **big** blue car.



The white bus is **the biggest**

This van is **bigger** than the blue car



# Compare with **-er** and **-est** .

Suffixes **-er** (comparative degree) and **-est** (superlative degree)

1. One syllable adjective

e.g. tall – taller – the tallest

big – bigger – the biggest

2. Two syllable adjectives ending with **-y,-er,-ow,-le**

e.g. happy – happier – the happiest

simple – simpler – the simplest

e.g. clever – cleverer – the cleverest

narrow – narrower -- the narrowest

# Compare with **more** and **most**.

**more** (больше, более) **most** (наибольший, самый)



My father  
is a  
**famous**  
man.



Mart Laar is **more**  
**famous** than my  
father.



Lennart Meri is **the most**  
**famous** person in Estonia.

## Remember

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
good хороший	better лучший	the best наилучший
bad плохой	worse хуже	the worst наихудший
much many много	more больше	the most наибольший
little маленький	less меньше	the least наименьший

# Use the comparative links:

**Than** – чем

e.g. Tom is older **than** his brother Bob.

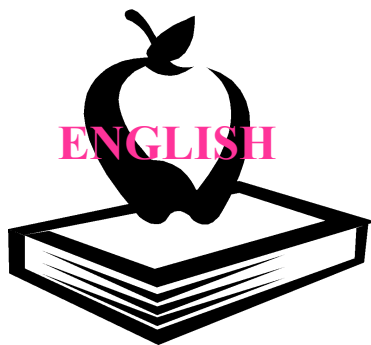
**As.....as** – такой.....как

e.g. The fir is **as** tall **as** the birch.

**Not so.....as** – не такой .....как

**Not as.....as** – не такой.....как

e.g. The English textbook is **not so** thin **as** the Estonian textbook.

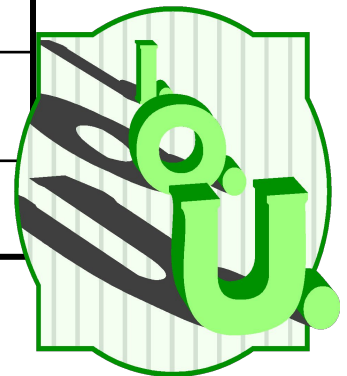
