Video

How to make a good pot of tea.

1. For a perfect cup of tea you should first warm a teapot.
2. You should put the tea – one teaspoon per person and one for the pot.
3. Pour in freshly boiled water and keep it for 4 – 6 minutes.
4. Stir well and serve.
5. You can put some sugar, milk, honey or lemon up to your taste.
6. If you prefer English tea with milk you should first pour in the milk and then the tea.
