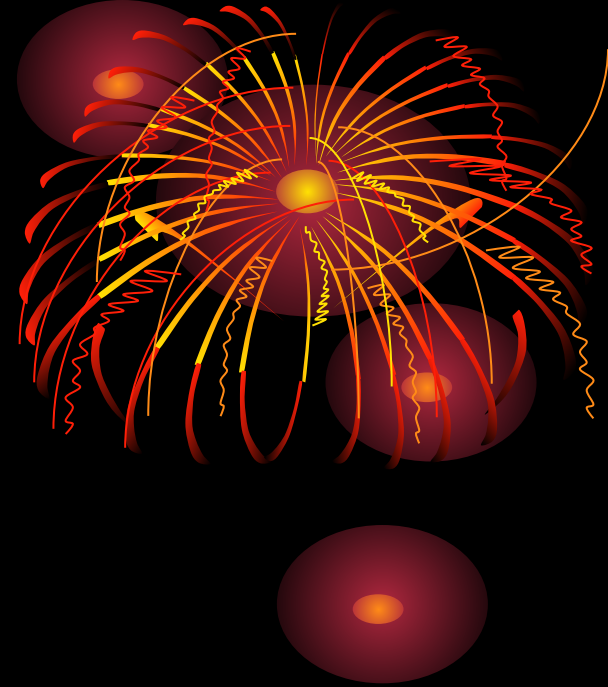

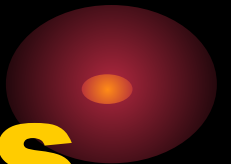
**Golf was first played in

**Traditionally boys from the shops in each town asked for money at Christmas. They went from house to house on December 26<sup>th</sup> & took boxes made of wood with them.**

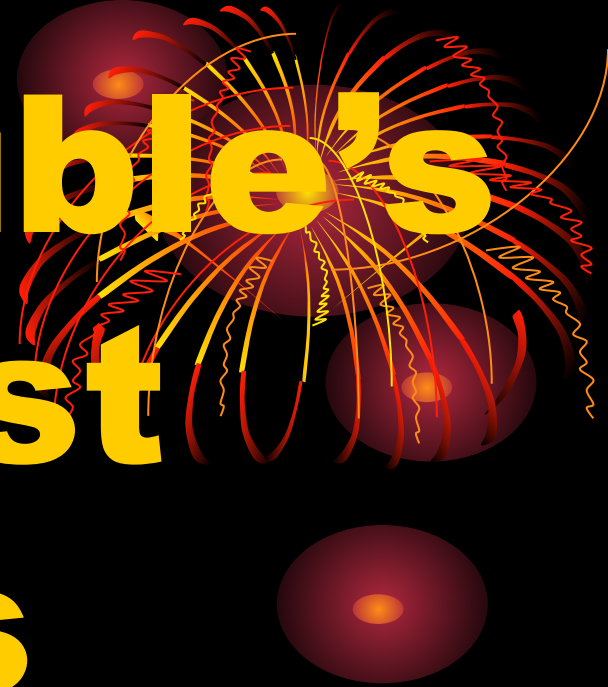


**It is a member of a group of a young people who developed their own style different from others. They usually have white shirts, short jackets & narrow trousers.**

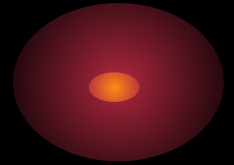
