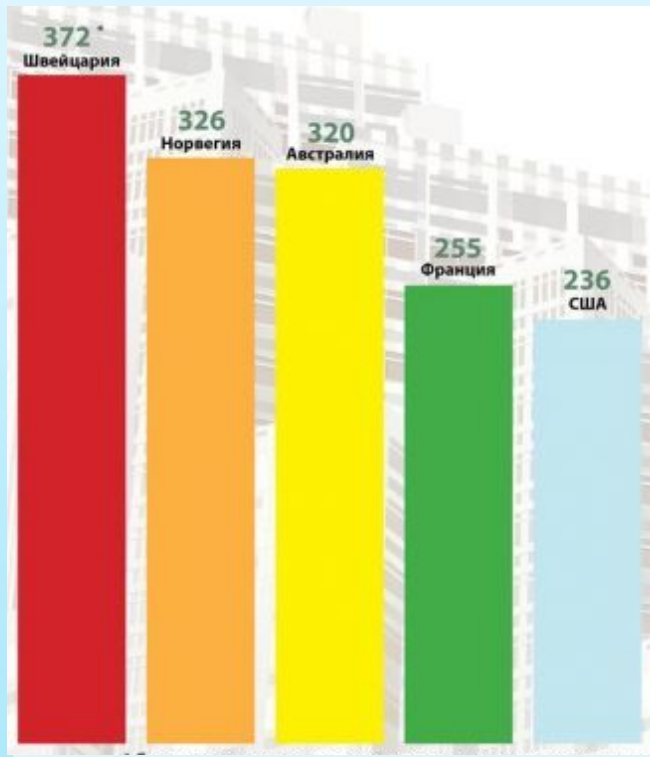

# The position of France among other countries and regions

- France ranks fourth in the list of the richest States in the world.
- This is the largest country in Western Europe.



# Size and length of France

- Area of France including Corsica – 551 000 square kilometers.
- From North to South and from West to East France stretches nearly 1000 km.



# Countries bordering France

- Mainland France is bordered:
  - 1) to the North-East – with Belgium, Luxembourg and Germany
  - 2) to the East – with Switzerland,
  - 3) to the South-East, with the Principality of Monaco and Italy,
  - 4) to the Southwest — with Spain and Andorra.



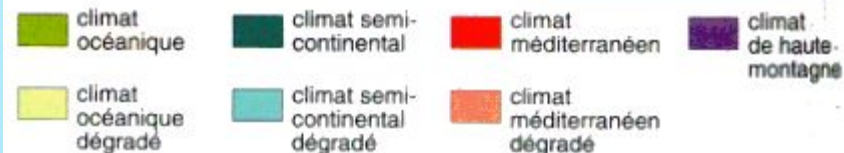
# Maritime boundaries

- In the West and North of the country's territory is washed by the Atlantic Ocean, on the South by the Mediterranean Sea.
- Length of the offshore boundaries is 5500 kilometers.



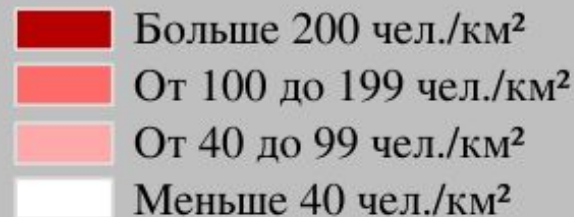
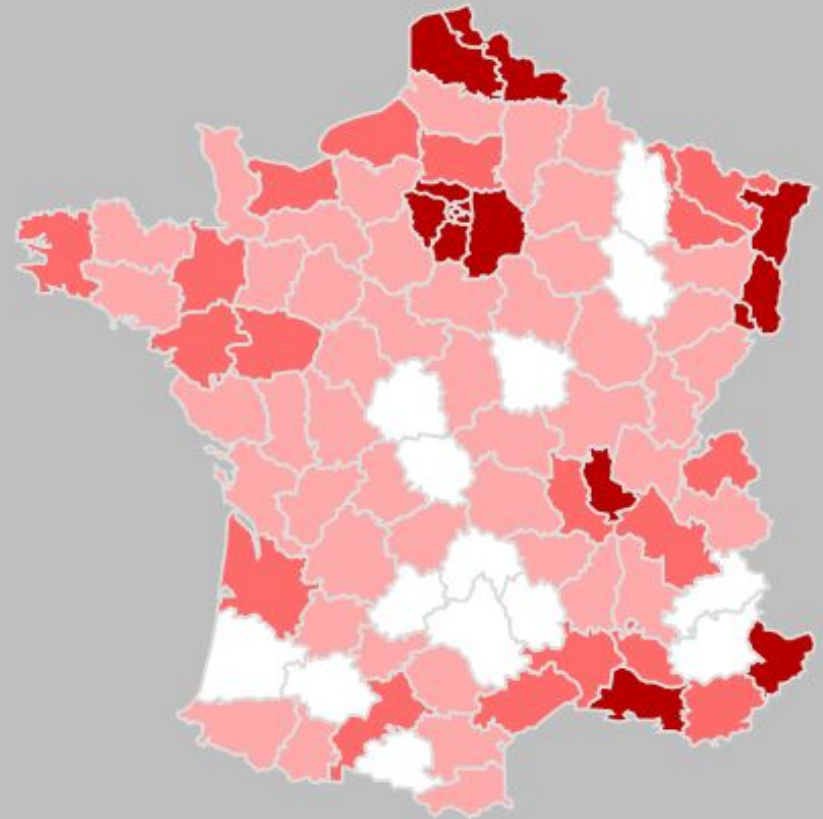
# Climate

- In France a very varied climate:
  - 1) in the North and Northwest is a temperate climate
  - 2) in the South-East a Mediterranean climate
  - 3) in the West is mainly oceanic climate
  - 4) in the Interior is moderately continental climate



# Population

- Population of France-58 million people.
- The average density is just over 100 people per square kilometer.
- A high concentration differs from the Paris region, about 20 percent of all inhabitants of the Republic





# Capital

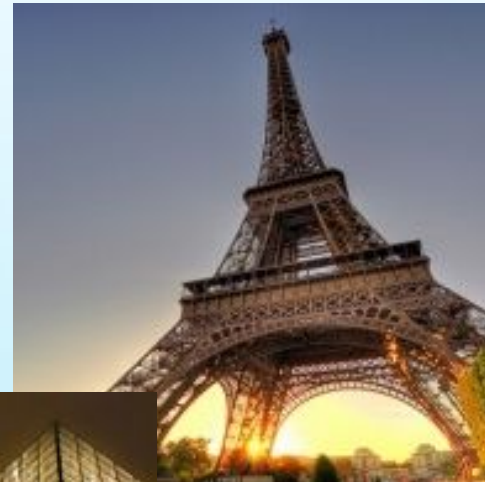
- The capital of France is Paris, which is home to more than 2 million people.
- Together with its suburbs, it forms Greater Paris, which is home to more than 10 million people.



# Points Of Interest

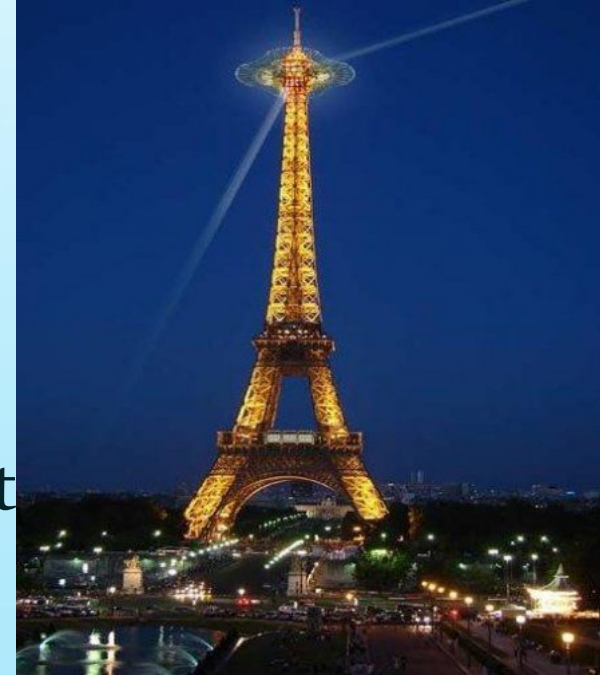
- In France a lot of attractions, of which the most popular:

- 1) the Eiffel Tower
- 2) the Louvre
- 3) Disneyland



# The Eiffel Tower

- The Eiffel Tower is an elegant silhouette of France, conquered hearts around the world.
- The tower is the most visited and most photographed stave attraction in the world.
- The tower is 322 meters.
- The tower is divided into three levels.
- The first two platforms are filled with restaurants and bars.
- The 3 platform is a lighthouse with a dome, is an observation deck at a height of 274 metres: "see Paris and die".





# The Louvre

- The Louvre is one of the largest, oldest and most famous art museums in the world with the richest collection of various exhibits.
- Now in the collection of the Louvre, there are over 300000 pieces from different epochs and civilizations, however only 35000 demonstrates in the halls.
- The most famous exponents of the Louvre: the code of Hammurabi, Samothrace, Venus de Milo, La Gioconda (Mona Lisa) and other works by Leonardo da Vinci, paintings by Rembrandt, Titian, freedom on the barricades by Delacroix.





# Disneyland

- Disneyland Resort Paris - 1943 hectares of the magic atmosphere of world famous fairy tales, ease child trembling soul, an opportunity to make an intergalactic journey to the stars, get hit by a meteor shower, meet with a fire-breathing dragon in sleeping beauty's Castle, and more magic to do.
- In short, the Disney Studios Park is a fantastic entertainment, spectacular views, magical and, at the same time, mad world, which will feel comfortably and adult and child.
