

# The Future Perfect Tense

# ● Обозначает

действие, которое  
завершится **раньше**  
определённого  
момента **в будущем.**

# Определённый момент в будущем

**может быть выражен:**

- конкретным временем

*by 5 o'clock*

*by tomorrow*

- другим действием в будущем

*before they go home,*

*by the time you ring me up*

**will have V<sup>ed</sup><sub>3</sub>**

*not*

# Future Perfect: Negative Form

**will**

**have**

**V<sup>ed</sup><sub>3</sub>**

The play *will not have begun*  
*by 7 o'clock.*



# Future Perfect: Interrogative Form



General Question

S

will

have

V<sup>ed</sup><sub>3</sub>

Will

the play

have begun

by

7

o'clock ?

# Future Perfect: Interrogative Form

## Special Question

Wh (s) will have V<sub>3</sub>ed

By what time will the play have begun?

Why will the play have begun by 7 o'clock?



# Future Perfect: Interrogative Form



Special Question (Subject)

**Wh**

**will have V<sup>ed</sup>**

What will have begun

by 7 o'clock tomorrow?



# Use the verb in Future Perfect



(to make)

I hope you  
will have made  
a move by  
tomorrow  
morning.

# Use the verb in Future Perfect

(to finish)

I hope we'll  
have finished  
all this before  
it becomes dark.



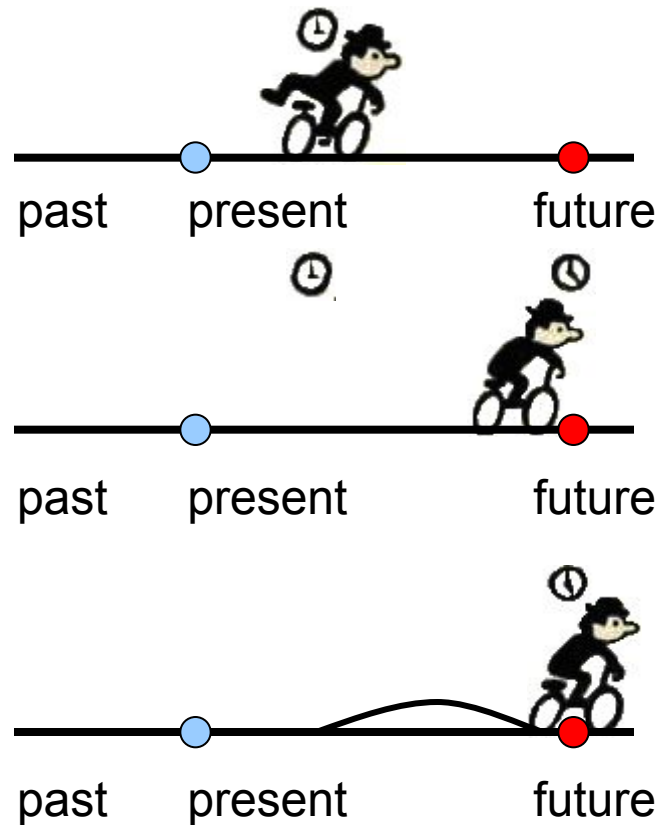
# Future Perfect vs Future Perfect Continuous

Я обозначаю действие, которое начнётся до определённого момента в будущем,



будет продолжаться до этого момента,

и будет длиться в этот момент.



# Use the verb in Future Perfect Continuous

(to ride)



**I'll have been riding**  
a bicycle **for two hours**  
**when I meet** you for the  
second time.

Я **буду кататься** на велосипеде **два**  
**часа**, **когда встречу** Вас во второй раз.
