# What is the time zone?



- Greenwich Mean Time (GMT).
- When it's 12 noon in Glasgow, it's 7am in New York, 10pm in Sydney and 1pm in Berlin.

# Which language is spoken?

# What side of the road do I drive on in Glasgow?



If you are driving in Glasgow, remember to:

- Drive on the left hand side of the road.
- Give way to traffic at the right on roundabouts.

# Where can I exchange my travelers' cheques?



It's best to go to

- banks
- larger hotels
- exchange bureaus.

# When are banks open for business?



- ❖ Typically 9.30-16.30 Monday to Friday
- ❖ some open slightly later
- ❖ a few branches may open on Saturday morning until 12.30pm.

# How much money can I bring?



Any amount, in any format

- cash,
- travelers' cheques,
- letters of credit,

the more the merrier!

There are no restrictions on bringing money into the UK.



# What is the emergency telephone number?



**999** for fire, police, ambulance or coastguard services.

Emergency calls are **free from pay**

you will be asked which service you require by the operator who answers.

# When is cheapest time to make a phone call?



Anytime at the weekend: from midnight on Friday to midnight on Sunday. Besides that, on weekdays after 6pm to before 8am is cheaper than during the day, i.e. business hours.

# How do I pay for calls from payphones?



- By inserting coins (10p, 20p, 50p, L1)
- phone card
- credit card

# How many channels can I get on TV?



If you don't include satellite and cable, then there are 5 standard terrestrial channels:

- BBC 1
- BBC 2
- STV (Scottish)
- Channel 4
- Channel 5

# When do the pubs open?



- From 11am to 11pm or midnight during Monday to Saturday
- From 12.30pm to 11pm on Sundays

# Are children allowed in pubs?



Yes, but:

- only in pubs with a Children's Certificate and only during the hours of 11am to 8pm
- Children must be accompanied by someone over 18 at all times while on the licensed premises
- They must not consume alcohol, including wine
