Darwin



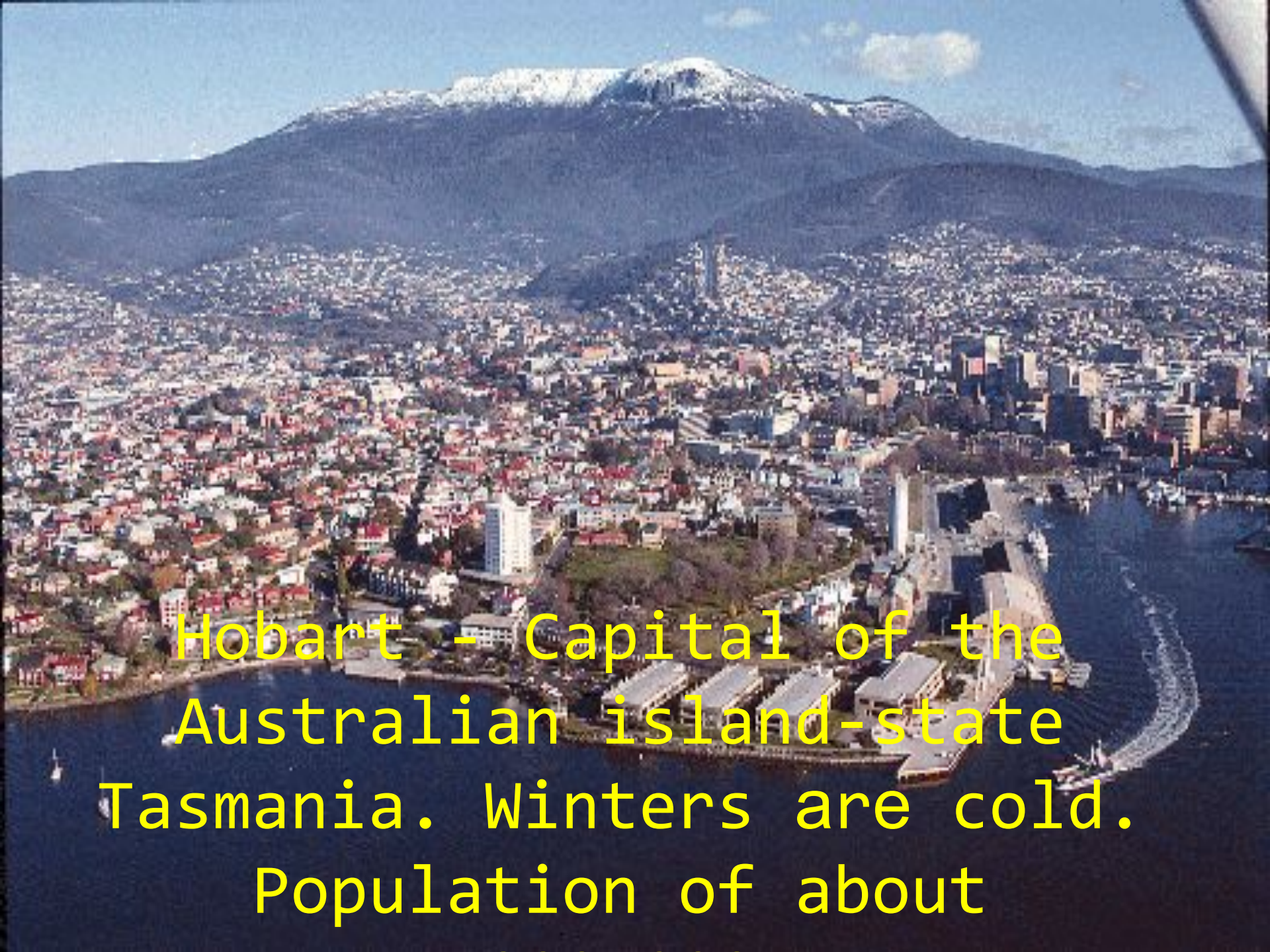
Darwin - Capital and the largest city of the Northern Territory. Tropical climate. Population of about 70,000
